Letter from the President and Executive Vice President

For nearly 40 years, the Jewish Communal Fund (JCF) has been helping our donors achieve their philanthropic and tax-saving goals simply and efficiently, with flexibility, full confidentiality and maximum choice. In the past decade alone, we have distributed over \$2 billion to thousands of public charities at the recommendation of our donors.


What many may not know is that beyond facilitating our donors' philanthropy, JCF is charitable in its own right. Every year, JCF makes a substantial annual Community Gift that supports nonprofit programs and institutions in the local and global Jewish community. Our Community Gift consists of two parts: grants to specific projects from our Special Gifts Fund and an unrestricted contribution to the Annual Campaign of UJA-Federation of New York.

Our Special Gifts Fund, which the JCF Board established in 1999, gives us the opportunity to support vital services and programs identified by UJA-Federation of New York. To date, the Special Gifts Fund has awarded more than \$8 million to over a dozen nonprofits, including Jewish community centers on Long Island, Staten Island, Brooklyn and Manhattan, the Plaza Jewish Community Chapel and Ramapo for Children. And in their hours of need, we have provided emergency grants to Jewish communities in Argentina and Israel.


In the past ten years, JCF has also made annual contributions of at least \$2 million to UJA-Federation's Annual Campaign. Overview

DONOR CONTRIBUTIONS

An initial tax-deductible contribution of \$5,000 or more in cash and/or marketable securities is required to establish a donor-advised fund. A Children’s Giving Fund and NextGen Giving Fund (18-30) may be established with a gift of \$1,800. Memorial Funds and Wedding Funds may be established with a gift of \$5,000. A donor may make additional contributions to the fund at any time in any amount. Contributions may be made by friends, family, private foundations, and corporations, or in conjunction with assorted estate planning tools such as Charitable Remainder Trusts, Charitable Lead Trusts, bequests and retirement plan assets.

GRANT MAKING

Donors at the Jewish Communal Fund enjoy the privilege of recommending distribution of principal and income of the assets in their fund to sectarian and nonsectarian institutions that are recognized by the IRS as tax-exempt, publicly supported charities that are eligible to receive grants from donor-advised funds. All grants are for charitable purposes. Donors also have the opportunity to extend this privilege to others whom they so designate. All recommendations are subject to evaluation by our staff for adherence to JCF’s policies and procedures. We consider donor recommendations to be of profound importance and therefore, give them careful consideration and respect in our grant determinations.

FEES AND EXPENSES

Each fund is assessed a monthly fee for services based on the average daily net asset balance. The sliding fee schedule, per annum, operates as follows:

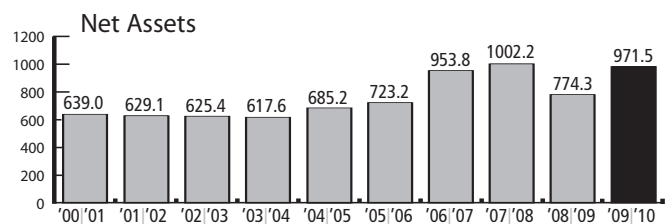
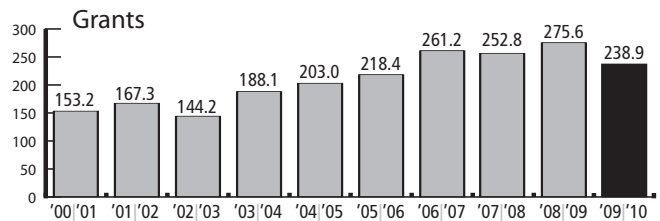
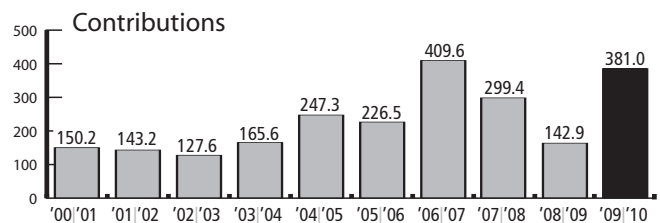
In addition, funds are subject to commissions and fees incurred in connection with the sale of contributed property, as well as management expenses associated with each investment portfolio.

INVESTMENTS

In consultation with its investment advisors, the Investment Committee of the Jewish Communal Fund periodically reviews investments and establishes investment policies. These policies are designed to:

- (1) ensure that donor contributions and fund assets are continuously invested;
- (2) maximize investment returns in relation to risk;
- (3) maintain varied investment alternatives that are suitable for various philanthropic plans;
- (4) ensure that operating expenses are minimal and competitive;
- (5) ensure that funds are readily available for grant-making.

When a donor-advised fund is established, the first \$5,000 (or such lesser amount for funds with a lower threshold) must be invested in one or both of our primary investments: an institutional money market fund or a short-term bond fund, both managed by BlackRock. Donors may request to have the proceeds in excess of the first \$5,000 invested in our investment alternatives, subject to the minimums required for each alternative. Donors may exercise this privilege each time a contribution is made and may recommend a reallocation of the assets in the fund four times each calendar year.

We have audited the accompanying consolidated statements of financial position of the Jewish Communal Fund (an entity of a sole member) ("JCF") as of June 30, 2010 and 2009, and the related consolidated statements of activities and cash flows for the years then ended. These financial statements are the responsibility of JCF's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audits.

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. Notes to Consolidated Financial Statements

June 30, 2010 and 2009

NOTE A - THE ORGANIZATION AND ITS SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

[1] Organization:

The Jewish Communal Fund ("JCF") was organized in 1972 as an independent, public charity (not a private foundation) under the not-for-profit corporation law of the State of New York. Through donor-advised funds, JCF offers individuals and families a way to simplify their charitable giving and to plan their philanthropy over time. JCF extends to donors or their successors the privilege of recommending grants from their funds to the qualified charities of their choice. The United Jewish Appeal - Federation of Jewish Philanthropies of New York, Inc. ("UJA") is the sole member of JCF.

JCF is, in turn, the sole member of Jewish Communal Fund Holdings LLC (the "LLC"). The LLC is a not-for-profit corporation organized in September 2001 and established to hold certain donations from time-to-time as JCF deems necessary. At June 30, 2010 and 2009, there were no net assets of the LLC. The financial statements of the LLC have been included in the accompanying consolidated financial statements, with all inter-organizational transactions eliminated in the consolidation process.

JCF is exempt from income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") and is classified as a publicly supported organization under Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Code. Additionally, JCF is exempt from state and local income taxes under comparable laws. Donors are entitled to the maximum income tax benefits for their donations that are permitted under present federal and state laws.

[2] Basis of accounting:

The consolidated financial statements of JCF have been prepared using the accrual basis of accounting and conform to accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America as applicable to not-for-profit organizations.

[3] Functional allocation of expenses:

The costs of providing JCF's various grant and supporting services have been summarized on a functional basis in the accompanying consolidated statements of activities. Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated among the program and supporting services in reasonable ratios determined by management.

[4] Use of estimates:

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

[5] Cash and cash equivalents:

Cash and cash equivalents primarily include money-market funds at various financial institutions. All highly liquid financial instruments with an original maturity of three months or less are considered to be cash equivalents.

[6] Investments:

Investments in equity securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are reported at their fair values in the accompanying consolidated statements of financial position, with realized and unrealized gains and losses included in the accompanying consolidated statements of activities. JCF's bond and equity mutual funds are also reported at their fair values, as determined by the related investment manager or advisor. Donated securities are recorded at their fair values, as determined by the proceeds received on the date of sale or net asset value as determined by the fund manager.

NOTE A - THE ORGANIZATION AND ITS SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)**[6] Investments: (continued)**

JCF has investments in certain not-readily-marketable securities which are ownership interests in private equity securities and certain limited partnerships for which market values are not readily obtainable. Because of the inherent uncertainty of the valuation of these investments, JCF and its various investment managers monitor their positions to reduce the risk of potential losses due to changes in fair values or the failure of counterparties to perform. The estimated values provided by these managers may differ from actual values had a ready market for these investments existed.

With respect to equity securities received from donors which, for example, are (i) not readily marketable, (ii) the securities of private companies, and (iii) the securities of companies in liquidation, JCF's policy is to record such items at a nominal value in the absence of readily determinable fair values, although such assets may have significant value.

Investment transactions are recorded on a trade-date basis. Realized gains or losses on investments are determined by comparison of the average cost of acquisition to proceeds at the time of disposition. The earnings from dividends and interest are recognized when earned.

Investment expenses include the services of bank trustees, investment managers and custodians. The balances of investment management fees disclosed in Note B are those specific fees charged by JCF's various investment managers in each fiscal year; however, they do not include those fees that are embedded in various other investment accounts and transactions.

[7] Accrued vacation:

Based on their tenure, employees are entitled to be paid for unused vacation time if they leave JCF. The accrued vacation obligation was approximately \$89,000 and \$86,000 at fiscal-years 2010 and 2009, respectively, and was reported as part of accounts payable and accrued operating expenses in the accompanying consolidated statements of financial position. Employees may accrue up to one year of their vacation time.

[8] Income tax uncertainties:

JCF is subject to the provisions of Accounting Standards Codification ("ASC") 740-10-05 relating to the accounting and reporting for uncertainty in income taxes. Because of JCF's general-tax exempt status, ASC 740-10-05 has not had, and is not expected to have, a material impact on JCF's consolidated financial statements.

[9] Fair-value measurements:

As further described in Note B, JCF reports a fair-value measurement of all applicable financial assets and liabilities, including investments, accounts receivable and short-term payables.

[10] Net assets:

JCF's net assets, which are classified as unrestricted, represent those resources available for current operations as there are no donor restrictions on the use of the underlying assets.

JCF has established four distinct types of unrestricted philanthropic funds:

- Undesignated funds, where the privilege of grant recommendation is given to the donor (and his or her designees) and the distribution of principal and income is governed by JCF grant guidelines. Grant-making is subject to the approval of JCF's Board of Trustees and its Charitable Distribution Committee.

[10] Net assets: (continued)

- Designated funds, where the beneficiaries and the schedule of distributions are established at the time of the gift and are approved by the Charitable Distribution Committee before JCF accepts the gift.
- Semi-designated funds, where the field of grant is limited to one or more functional areas and places the responsibility on JCF (through its Board of Trustees or the Charitable Distribution Committee) for designating the specific grant beneficiaries and scheduling such grants.
- Endowment funds, where the Board of Trustees and the Special Gifts Fund Committee have the responsibility for grant-making. The income and principal have been authorized by JCF to be available to meet the needs of the Jewish community, at home and abroad, at the recommendation of UJA and upon the approval of the Board of Trustees.

[11] Endowment funds:

JCF reports all applicable disclosures for its board-designated funds treated as endowment (see Note G).

[12] Support and revenue:

Revenues are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets unless the use of the related assets is limited by donor-imposed restrictions. Gains and losses on investments and other assets or liabilities are reported as increases or decreases in unrestricted net assets unless their use is restricted by explicit donor stipulations or law. Expenses are reported as decreases in unrestricted net assets.

[13] Contributions:

Contributions are recorded as revenue when received unconditionally, at their fair values.

[14] Grants:

Grants made to others are recorded as an expense when they become unconditional promises to give by JCF, based on guidelines promulgated by the Board of Trustees. Multi-year grants that are payable in installments beyond one year are discounted at an interest rate commensurate with the risk involved.

[15] Subsequent events:

JCF considers all accounting treatments, and the related disclosures in the current fiscal-year's consolidated financial statements, that may be required as the result of all events or transactions that occur after the fiscal year-end through the date of the independent auditors' report.

[16] Reclassifications:

Certain amounts in the prior-year's consolidated financial statements have been reclassified to conform to the current year's presentation.

As described above, JCF has certain funds invested in fixed-income securities (the "Portfolio") which consist of agency mortgage-backed securities ("AMBS"), commercial mortgage-backed securities ("CMBS"), asset-backed securities ("ABS") and investment-grade corporate bonds. In addition, the Portfolio may also purchase U.S. Treasury futures for the purpose of managing duration and yield-curve exposure. A maximum of 30% of the total fair value of the Portfolio may be invested in ABS, CMBS and AMBS, and a maximum of 10% of the total fair value of the Portfolio may be invested in investment grade-corporate bonds; however, bonds with explicit government guarantees are not subject to this limitation. The Portfolio must maintain an overall portfolio credit quality of AA or better. The average effective duration of the Portfolio may not exceed 3 years.

NOTE B - INVESTMENTS (CONTINUED)

ASC 820-10-05 establishes a three-level valuation hierarchy of fair-value measurements. These valuation techniques are based upon observable and unobservable inputs. Observable inputs reflect market data obtained from independent sources, while unobservable inputs reflect market assumptions. These two types of inputs create the following fair-value hierarchy:

- Level 1: Valuations are based on observable inputs that reflect quoted market prices in active markets for identical assets and liabilities at the reporting date. The types of investments and other assets included in Level 1 consist of exchange-traded equity securities and debt, short-term money market funds, and actively traded obligations issued by the U.S. government and government agencies.
- Level 2: Valuations are based on (i) quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets, or (ii) quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in markets that are not active or (iii) pricing inputs other than quoted prices that are directly or indirectly observable at the reporting date. Level 2 assets include U.S. government and agency securities and corporate debt securities, that are redeemable at or near the balance sheet date and for which a model was derived for valuation.
- Level 3: Fair value is determined based on pricing inputs that are unobservable and includes situations where there is little, if any, market activity for the asset or liability. Level 3 assets included securities in privately held companies, secured notes, private corporate bonds, and limited partnerships, the underlying investments of which could not be independently valued, or cannot be immediately redeemed at or near the fiscal year-end.

Most investments classified in Levels 2 and 3 consist of shares or units in investment funds as opposed to direct interests in the funds' underlying holdings, which may be marketable. Because the net asset value reported by each fund is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value of JCF's interest therein, its classification in Level 2 or 3 is based on JCF's ability to redeem its interest at or near June 30, 2010. If the interest can be redeemed in the near term, the investment is classified as Level 2. The classification of investments in the fair value hierarchy is not necessarily an indication of the risks, liquidity, or degree of difficulty in estimating the fair value of each investment's underlying assets and liabilities.

NOTE C - MANAGEMENT FEE ALLOCATION

To pay its operating expenses, JCF charges an administrative fee to all donor-advised funds as described below, with amounts exceeding \$5,000,000 eligible for a reduced sliding scale fee structure. For the five months ending November 30, 2009, fees were calculated on average daily balances as follows:

The administrative fee is charged monthly, and it reduces the value of the donor-advised funds and increases the value of JCF's operating fund. Administrative fees and interest income in excess of operating expenses up to \$2,000,000 are granted out to UJA. Administrative fees and interest income in excess of operating expenses greater than \$2,000,000 are split between grants to UJA and increases to JCF's Special Gifts Fund. The fee was \$5,260,510 and \$5,188,815 for fiscal-years 2010 and 2009, respectively.

NOTE D - EMPLOYEE BENEFIT PLANS**[1] Defined-contribution plan:**

UJA sponsors a defined-contribution 403(b) plan, for which JCF employees may participate, in compliance with the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"). Plan participants are required to make contributions in the form of payroll deductions and may contribute up to the maximum allowed by federal law. JCF does not contribute to the plan.

[2] Defined-benefit plan:

JCF employees may participate in the Retirement Plan for Employees of the United Jewish Appeal - Federation of Jewish Philanthropies of New York, Inc. and Affiliated Institutions and Agencies, a defined-benefit pension plan sponsored by UJA. Eligible employees of JCF participate automatically in this plan on a noncontributory basis and are fully vested after five years of service. The plan is subject to the provisions of ERISA. Total expenses for fiscal-years 2010 and 2009 for this plan were \$147,756 and \$53,116, respectively. Included in fiscal-year 2010 are catch-up contributions, as permissible under ERISA.

[3] Deferred-compensation plan:

JCF contributes to a deferred-compensation plan for one of its key employees. Annual contributions to the plan are based upon the maximum amount allowed by the Code. There were no contributions for fiscal-year 2010. Total expenses for fiscal-year 2009 for this plan were \$16,000.

NOTE E - RELATED-PARTY TRANSACTIONS

UJA is the sole member of JCF and provides JCF with various management services, such as payroll and related processing, and insurance coverage, for which JCF reimburses UJA. For fiscal-years 2010 and 2009, respectively, JCF reimbursed UJA in the amount of \$1,770,999 and \$1,712,268 for these costs. For fiscal-year 2010, JCF awarded grants to UJA totaling \$13,508,567, of which \$2,000,000 was from the operating fund, \$401,800 was from the Special Gifts Fund, and \$11,106,767 was from donor-advised funds. For fiscal-year 2009, JCF awarded grants to UJA totaling \$13,179,083, of which \$2,000,000 was from the operating fund, \$560,000 was from the Special Gifts Fund, and \$10,619,083 was from donor-advised funds.

NOTE F - LEASE COMMITMENT

For its New York City office, JCF is obligated under a noncancelable operating lease that expires in 2014. As of June 30, 2010, minimum future lease payments under the lease agreement are as follows:

[1] Board-designated endowment:

[2] Return objectives and risk parameters:

JCF has adopted investment and spending policies for endowment assets that attempt to provide a predictable stream of funding to programs that meet the needs of the Jewish community at home and abroad while seeking to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment assets. Under this policy, as approved by the Board of Trustees, the endowment assets are invested in a manner that is intended to produce results that exceed the price and yield results of the S&P 500 index while assuming a moderate level of investment risk.

[3] Strategies employed for achieving objectives:

To satisfy its long-term rate-of-return objectives, JCF relies on a total-return strategy in which investment returns are achieved through both capital appreciation (realized and unrealized) and current yield (interest and dividends). JCF targets a diversified asset allocation within prudent risk constraints.

[4] Spending policy and related objectives:

JCF has a policy of appropriating for distribution each year 7% of its endowment fund's average fair value over the prior 12 quarters through the calendar year-end preceding the fiscal year in which the distribution is planned. In establishing this policy, JCF considered the long-term expected return on its endowment. Accordingly, over the long term, JCF expects the current spending policy to allow its endowment to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment net assets, as well as to provide additional real growth through investment returns.

NOTE H - CREDIT RISK

Financial instruments that potentially subject JCF to concentrations of credit risk consist principally of cash and cash-equivalent accounts that are deposited in financial institutions in amounts which, from time to time, may exceed federal insurance limits. However, management believes that JCF does not face a significant risk of loss on these accounts related to failure of these financial institutions.
