# Melanoplus billyharrisi, a replacement name for the junior homonym Melanoplus harrisi (Orthoptera: Acrididae: Melanoplinae)

### **ABSTRACT**

A new name, *Melanoplus billyharrisi*, is suggested as a replacement name for *Melanoplus harrisi* Hill 2014.

Key words: Melanoplus harrisi, replacement name, Melanoplinae.

The name *Melanoplus harrisii* was given by Morse (1909) to a new species based on a single specimen collected in Needham, Massachusetts. Morse and Hebard (1915) used the variant spelling "*M. harrisi*" with no mention of an intended change. Five years later, Blatchley (1920) synonymized *M. harrisi* with *Phoetaliotes nebrascensis* (Thomas 1872).

Hill (2014) described a new species of Melanoplus from Decatur County, Tennessee under the name *M. harrisi*. According to the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature Article 58.14, *M. harrisii* and *M. harrisi* are homonyms, and though *M. harrisii* (Morse) is currently in synonomy, Article 53.3 indicates that *M. harrisi* Hill is a junior homonym. Here the new name *Melanoplus billyharrisi* is proposed as a replacement name for *M. harrisi* Hill 2014 to satisfy the Code and to maintain the intended honor of the name.
