NOTIFICATION

Whereas "United Democratic Party, Manipur', a recognised State Party, VIDE Commission's notification No 56/84-XXIII, dated 25th June, 1986, in the State of Manipur has intimated to the Commission that the said Party has been dissolved as a consequence of its merger with the Indian National Congress, a recognised National Party;

And whereas the Election Commission of India, on the basis of records available, is satisfied that "United Democratic Party, Manipur" has ceased to exist as a separate political party and that its name should be deleted from the list of recognised State Parties;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clauses (b) and (d) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, the Commission hereby makes the following amendments in its notification No. 56/84-I dated the 13th November, 1984, published as O.N. 124(E), in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, section 3 (iii), dated the 16th November, 1984, and as subsequently amended from time to time, namely:

In Table 2 of the said notification, against item "Manipur" the entries in columns 2&3, "3. United Democratic Party, Manipur Elephant" shall be delected; and

In table 4 of the above notification, against item "12. Manipur" the entry under Column 2, after '4-Eangle about to fly', the following shall be added:—

5-Elephant. The remaining entries 5 to 15 shall be renumbered as 6 to 16.
