charge of it and farther sayeth not

George Courtreigne Sworne & declares th^t he was at the house of
John Mould and th^t he there Saw John Harvy and that then John
Harvy asked th^e said John Mould if his Cittern was mended, & th^e
said Mould answered him th^t it was not, and th^e Deponent farther
Sayeth not,

Whereupon the Comishoners ordred th^t th^e Def^t pay unto th^e
Playntiff one hundred pound of to^b wth Costs;
