to deliver to the Orphan's when he comes of age such and so many of any kind as he is possessed with when he gives his account to the next orphan's Court. Succeeded in the publication of this Act

4thly

That all plate money Rings & Jewells be preserved and delivered in kind according to the weight and quantity and that other household stuff and Sum-ber be appraised in money and the value thereof paid by the guardian to the orphan when he comes to age either in money Sterling according to appraisment or in Tobacco at the then price sumant and in case any difference shall arise what shall be the then price sumant that the Judges of the County Court where the orphan's Estate doth lye determine what shall be the then price sumant

5thly

That every Male orphan shall be accounted to be of full age at the years of one & twenty and at that age to receive his Estate from the Guardian but in case any person by his last will and testament doe appoint any person to be Executor that is full seven years of age that person so appointed shall be adjudged of sufficient age to administer as Executor And if such Executor happen to be under the age of seven years the administration to be granted to such other person as the Judge in Testamentary business shall approve of till such Executor accomplish the full age of seven years and that such administration be granted to the use and profit of the infant Executor & not otherwise nor in any other manner

6thly

That every female Orphan shall be accounted of full age to receive her Estate at the age of sixteen years or day of Marriage which shall first happen provided she be above sixteen years of age at the day she is married

7thly

That all Negroes and other Slaves shall be after the transmitting of the Estate to the County Court as aforesaid appraised to the administrators and Guardians & be preserved by them and employed to the said Administrators
