Aliceara Snowblind 'Sweet Spot'

Synonym: *Beallara* Snowblind 'Sweet Spot'

Parents: *Oncidium* Black Diamond × *Aliceara* Tropic Splendor

CARE LEVEL: Easy

LIGHT: Bright Light, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° in winter, 80° during summer

HUMIDITY: 50% RH

WATERING: Water every 10 days or when media is dry-ish, after flowering wait 2-4 weeks before watering again

FERTILIZING: Once per month

REPOTTING: Re-pot in open, free-draining bark mix



Aliceara Tropic Lily 'Chocolate Drop'

Synonym: *Beallara* Tropic Lily 'Chocolate Drop'

Parents: *Oncidium* Nichirei Lilac × *Aliceara* Tropic Splendor

Originator: J.W. McCully, 2007

CARE LEVEL: Easy

LIGHT: Bright Light, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° in winter, 80° during summer

HUMIDITY: 50% RH

WATERING: Water every 10 days or when media is dry-ish, after flowering wait 2-4 weeks before watering again

FERTILIZING: Once per month

REPOTTING: Re-pot in open, free-draining bark mix



Aliceara Pacific Nova 'Okika'

Parents: *Brassidium* Shooting Star × *Miltonia clowesii*

Originator: Tropical Orchid Farm, 2002

CARE LEVEL: Easy

LIGHT: Bright Light, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° in winter, 80° during summer

HUMIDITY: 50% RH

WATERING: Water every 10 days or when media is dry-ish, after flowering wait 2-4 weeks before watering again

FERTILIZING: Once per month

REPOTTING: Re-pot in open, free-draining bark mix



Brassidium Kenneth Bivin 'Santa Barbara'

Parents: *Oncidium cariniferum* × *Brassia arcuigera*

Originator: D. Bivin, 1982

CARE LEVEL: Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East facing window

TEMPERATURE: 55°- 65°F nights; 65°- 75°F days, keep below 85°F during summer months

HUMIDITY: 50% - 70% RH

WATERING: Water 1 to 2x a week while in active growth, reduce watering when not actively growing

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer weekly, not when in active growth

REPOTTING: Repot yearly in course potting medium consisting of bark, coconut chips, charcoal, or perlite



Brassidium Gilded Urchin

Parents: *Brassia arcuigera* × *Oncidium wentworthianum*

Originator: Ron McClellan, 1971

CARE LEVEL: Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East facing window is best

TEMPERATURE: 55°- 65°F nights; 65°- 75°F days, keep below 85°F during summer months

HUMIDITY: 50% - 70% RH

WATERING: Water 1 to 2x a week while in active growth, reduce watering when not actively growing

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer weekly, not when in active growth

REPOTTING: Repot yearly in course potting medium consisting of bark, coconut chips, charcoal, or perlite



Brassidium Nittany Gold 'Dr. John'

Parents: *Brassia verrucosa* × *Oncidium ghiesbreghtianum*

Originator: Dunkelberger, 1987

CARE LEVEL: Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East facing window is best

TEMPERATURE: 55°- 65°F nights; 65°- 75°F days, keep below 85°F during summer months

HUMIDITY: 50% - 70% RH

WATERING: Water 1 to 2x a week while in active growth, reduce watering when not actively growing

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer weekly, not when in active growth

REPOTTING: Repot yearly in course potting medium consisting of bark, coconut chips, charcoal, or perlite



Cattlianthe Rojo 'Happy Valentine'

Synonym: *Laeliocattleya* Rojo 'Happy Valentine'

Parents: *Guarianthe aurantiaca* × *Cattleya milleri*

Originator: Rod McLellan Co., 1965

CARE LEVEL: Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East, West or South window

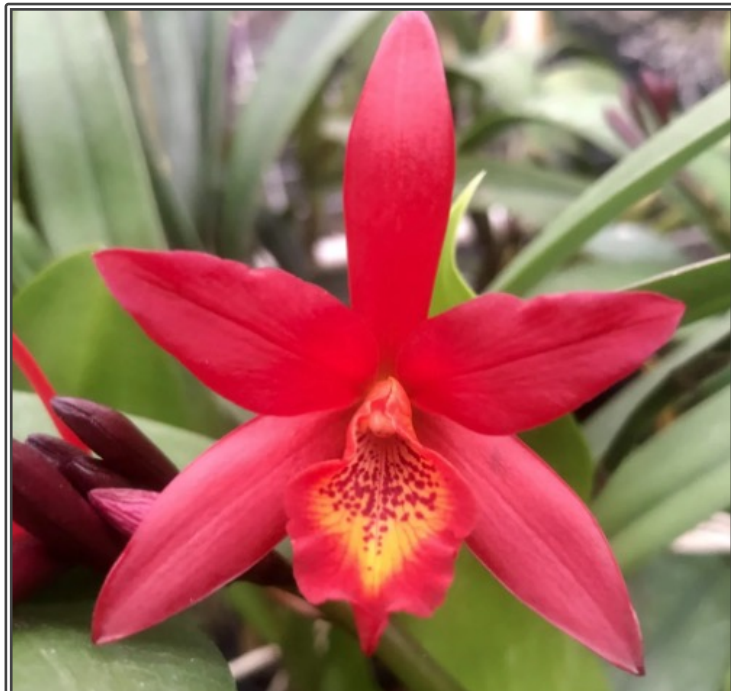
TEMPERATURE: 65°F nights & winter; 70 °F - 85°F days & summer

HUMIDITY: 50% - 80% RH

WATERING: Water 1x a week to every 10 days

FERTILIZING: Fertilize every 2 weeks in summer, once a month in winter

REPOTTING: Repot every 1-2 years in moss/bark mix



Dendrobium Betty Goto × Bicentennial

Parents: *Dendrobium* Brisbane × *Dendrobium* Blanche Aisaka

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, up to 90°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% + RH with good airflow

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through a pot with good drainage

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Prefers small pots. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Chocolate Chip

Parents: *Dendrobium* Micro Chip × *Dendrobium normanbyense*

Originator: H & R Nursery, 2018

CARE LEVEL: Very Easy

CULTURE: Miniature, fragrant, blooms 2-3 times a year

LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days with good ventilation

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes, they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Little Norman

Parents: *Dendrobium* Little Atro × *Dendrobium normanbyense*

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

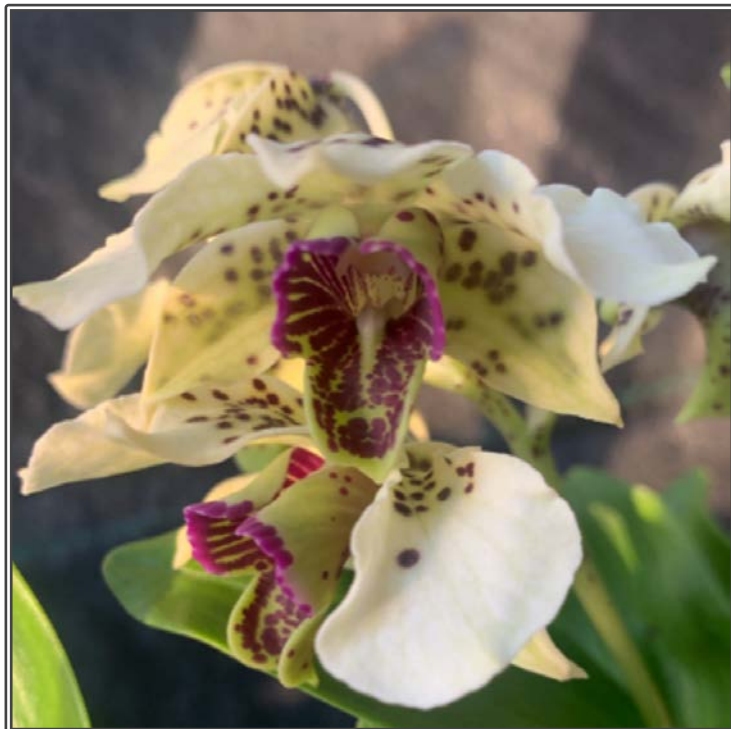
LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days with good ventilation and humidity

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes, they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium johnsoniae × Nida

Seed Parents: *Dendrobium johnsoniae* Species Orchid

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days with good ventilation on and humidity

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Mini Snowflake

Parents: *Dendrobium aberrans* × *Dendrobium johnsoniae*

Originator: H&R, 2005

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days with good ventilation and humidity

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Mini Snowflake × Nida

Parents: *Dendrobium aberrans* × *Dendrobium johnsoniae*

Originator: H&R, 2005

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East window preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days with good ventilation and humidity

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Royal Chip

CARE LEVEL: Very Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 65% + RH, with good airflow

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Waianae Valley × *D. kurashigei*

CARE LEVEL: Moderately Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days

HUMIDITY: 65% + RH, with good airflow

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. DO NOT remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Dendrobium Winter Pixie

Parents: *Dendrobium* Mini Snowflake × *Dendrobium* Micro Chip

CARE LEVEL: Very Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from East preferred

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 90°F days

HUMIDITY: 65% + RH, with good airflow

WATERING: Water once a week by running tepid water through the pot, drain well

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilizer every week

REPOTTING: Small pots and dry feet. **DO NOT** remove bare canes; they provide food, and flower stocks arise from old canes



Leomesezia Lava Burst 'Puanani'

Synonym: *Howeara* Lava Burst 'Puanani'

Parents: *Leomesezia* Mini-Primi × *Rodriguezia lanceolata*

Originator: Puanani, 1993

CARE LEVEL: Moderate to Challenging

LIGHT: Bright light from East, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60°F nights, 72° - 77°F days

HUMIDITY: 70% RH or higher

WATERING: Water every 3-5 days, do not leave in standing water

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilize every 2 months, flush salts weekly

REPOTTING: Repot every several years in medium grade orchid compost

CARE LEVEL: Moderate to Challenging

LIGHT: Bright light from East, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 50° - 55°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 70% RH or higher

WATERING: Water every 3-4 days, do not let roots dry out completely

FERTILIZING: Use weak fertilize every 2 weeks, flush salts weekly

REPOTTING: Repot in the early spring in a tree fern & sphagnum mix

WATERING: Water once or twice a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot in sphagnum moss and bark mix

WATERING: Water once or twice a week, keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot in sphagnum moss and bark mix

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot in sphagnum moss and bark mix



Oncidopsis Crimson Pride

LIGHT: Bright light from East, South, or West window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 80°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 55% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water 2 or 3 times a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month if in sphagnum or weekly in bark mix

REPOTTING: Repot in NZ sphagnum or medium orchid bark



Oncidopsis Living Fire 'Glowing Embers'

Synonym: *Burrageara* Living Fire 'Glowing Embers'

Parents: *Oncidopsis* Edna × *Oncidium maculatum*

CARE LEVEL: Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East, South, or West window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 80°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 55% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water 2 or 3 times a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month if in sphagnum or weekly in bark mix

REPOTTING: Repot in NZ sphagnum or medium orchid bark



Oncostele Eye Candy 'Pinkie'

Synonym: *Wilsonara* or *Burrageara* Eye Candy 'Pinkie'

Parents: *Oncostele* Catatante × *Oncidium* Barossa Delight

CARE LEVEL: Easy to Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 55° - 60°F nights, 75°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water once or twice a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot once a year – keep containers on the small side. Use a rapid draining mix of bark, perlite, charcoal, lava rock and coarse peat



Oncostele Catatante 'Sunny Kalapana'

Synonym: *Odontocidium* Catatante 'Sunny Kalapana'

Parents: *Oncidium* Sphacelatum × *Oncostele* Wildcat

CARE LEVEL: Easy to Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 55° - 65°F nights, 75°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water once or twice a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot once a year – keep containers on the small side. Use a rapid draining mix of bark, perlite, charcoal, lava rock and coarse peat.



Oncostele Wildcat yellow

Synonym: *Odontocidium* Wildcat

Parents: *Oncostele* Rustic Bridge × *Oncidium* Crowborough

Originator: Rod McClellan Co., 1992

CARE LEVEL: Easy to Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 55° - 65°F nights, 75°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water once or twice a week to keep medium slightly moist

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot once a year – keep containers on the small side. Use a rapid draining mix of bark, perlite, charcoal, lava rock and coarse peat.



Paphiopedilum Charly Web

Parents: *Paphiopedilum* Hsinying Rubyweb × *Paphiopedilum charlesworthii*

Originator: J. Fang, 2015

CARE LEVEL: Easy - Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 40% to 70% RH, with good air circulation

WATERING: Water every 5 days in bark or when the top of the sphagnum is dry if in moss. Keep moist, never soggy and never dry.

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot annually in mix of fir bark, coconut chips and sphagnum



Paphiopedilum charlesworthii

Common name: Slipper Orchid

Parentage: Species orchid, parent to many *Paphiopedilum* orchids in the exhibition

Native Range: India, Myanmar, Thailand, South China on deeply shaded western slopes

CARE LEVEL: Easy - Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 40% to 70% RH, with good air circulation

WATERING: Water every 5 days in bark or when the top of the sphagnum is dry if in moss. Keep moist, never soggy and never dry.

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot annually in mix of fir bark, coconut chips and sphagnum



Paphiopedilum Hsinying Citron

Parents: *Paphiopedilum* Gael × *Paphiopedilum* Mishima Citron

Originator: Ching Hua, 2003

CARE LEVEL: Easy - Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 40% to 70% RH, with good air circulation

WATERING: Water every 5 days in bark or when the top of the sphagnum is dry if in moss. Keep moist, never soggy and never dry.

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot annually in mix of fir bark, coconut chips and sphagnum



Paphiopedilum Miaohau Golden Venus × P. Cocoa Jollix Med
Common Name: Slipper Orchids

CARE LEVEL: Easy - Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East window, no direct sun

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 40% to 70% RH, with good air circulation

WATERING: Water every 5 days in bark or when the top of the sphagnum is dry if in moss. Keep moist, never soggy and never dry.

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month

REPOTTING: Repot annually in mix of fir bark, coconut chips and sphagnum



Phalaenopsis (assorted)

CARE LEVEL: Very Easy

LIGHT: Bright light from an East, South or West window

TEMPERATURE: Above 60° at night, 75° - 85° days. Temps below 55° in fall will initiate blooming

HUMIDITY: 50% to 80% RH

WATERING: Water thoroughly but allow to dry between waterings. Water in morning to prevent rot.

FERTILIZING: Fertilize every 2 weeks with high nitrogen fertilizer when in active growth. Use a high phosphorus fertilizer prior to blooming.

REPOTTING: Repot every 1–3 years in a porous mix such as bark.



Rhynchostylis gigantea Red (Species Orchid)

Common name: Foxtail Orchid

Native Range: Myanmar, Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Malaysia

CARE LEVEL: Challenging

LIGHT: Bright light from East, South or West window, needs more light than most orchids

TEMPERATURE: above 55°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 60% to 80% RH

WATERING: Water thoroughly daily

FERTILIZING: Fertilize weekly with a weak fertilizer

REPOTTING: Place in orchid basket with no medium

TEMPERATURE: 60° - 65°F nights, 80° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 55% - 75% RH

WATERING: Water when medium is approaching dryness

FERTILIZING: Fertilize once a month if in sphagnum or weekly in bark mix

REPOTTING: in NZ sphagnum or medium orchid bark mix



Zygonisia Murasakikomachi 'Blue Hawaii'

CARE LEVEL: Moderate

LIGHT: Light from East or West window, tolerates shade

TEMPERATURE: 55° - 65°F nights, 75°- 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% - 80% RH

WATERING: Water thoroughly throughout the year

FERTILIZING: Fertilize at full strength spring, summer, and fall, weakly in the winter

REPOTTING: Repot in coconut chips, bark and perlite anytime but winter. An application of dolomitic limestone can be applied.



Zygopetalum Advance Australia 'H.O.F.'

CARE LEVEL: Easy - Moderate

LIGHT: Bright light from East or West window

TEMPERATURE: 55° - 65°F nights, 75° - 85°F days

HUMIDITY: 50% - 80% RH

WATERING: Water once or twice a week during active growth, less in winter

FERTILIZING: Use a weak fertilizer every two weeks throughout the year

REPOTTING: Repot in coconut chips, bark and perlite anytime but winter. An application of dolomitic limestone can be applied.
