Getting Adulterants into the Test

Adulterants include baking soda, salt, soap, and vinegar. Popular ways of adulterating are:

- Under the fingernails
- On the hand or fingers
- Dropper
- Spit or saliva containing adulterant

Adulterating involves adding a substance to a urine sample that prevents a positive test result.

Adding a small amount of an adulterant like baking soda, table salt, lye or ammonia serves to neutralize enzyme activity in the sample, which ensures that the sample has a “no drug content” result.
