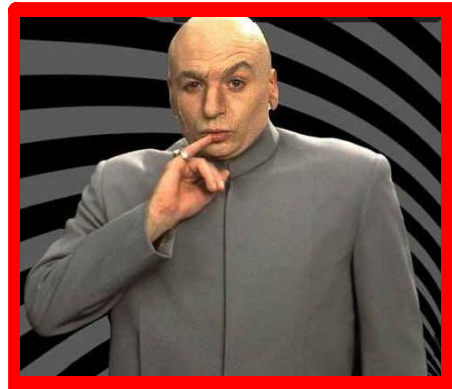

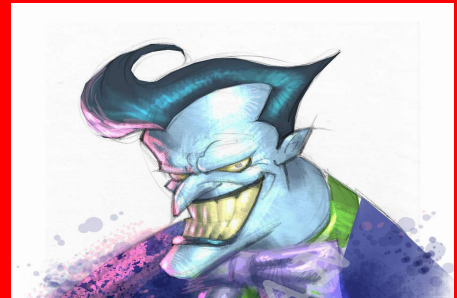

When Eliza Harris encouraged George to be more Christian, he told her he would try to follow her example.

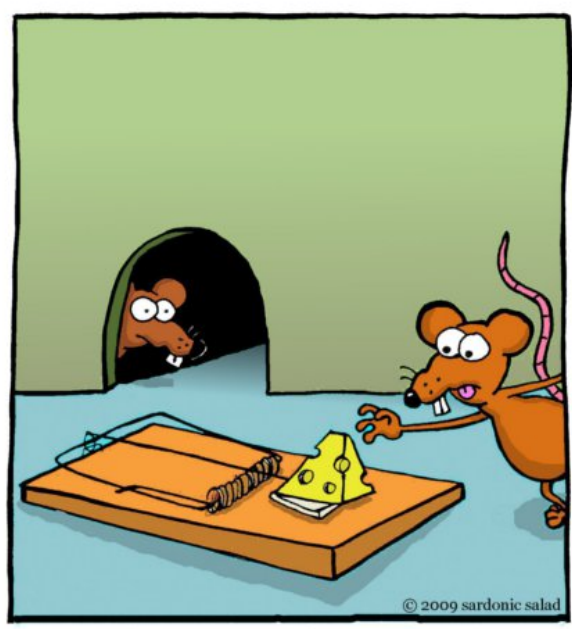


Example
