CHAPTER 1: JOURNALS

Objectives

The objectives are:

- Creating separate G/L vouchers according to document dates and types

Introduction

In Turkish Accounting Principles, different type of documents have to be numbered separately and have to be printed in the legal reports separately. In order to prevent misuse of document numbering prior to posting control mechanism has been added into journals and Post to G/L functions.

Scenario

Scenario for this chapter mainly consists of filling in a journal and posting it. Starting, filling in the lines, posting the journal and seeing the voucher report will be enough for understanding the changes made at scope of localization.

Topic 1: Creating Different G/L Register Records According to Document Type and Document Date

In Turkey, since the companies have a lot of transactions in a day, a development is needed. Thus, it is thought that different documents with same date are collected in one voucher. This development caused less number of pages in year-end reporting.

In order to apply this functionality, you should first put a check mark into the “New G/L Reg. for per Document” field in “TR SETUP” form.

Scenario – Document Numbering in Journals

Create a journal with no data entries (prior to posting). In order to understand the subject better, create more than one document with different document numbers in journal.

Demonstration – Document Numbering Controls in Journals

At the beginning, please make sure that at least one general journal template and one batch attached to it exist in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.

Steps

In our example, let's enter transactions by using G/L Accounts (with allow direct posting options) in journal.

Scenario for “New G/L Reg. for per Document” field usage;

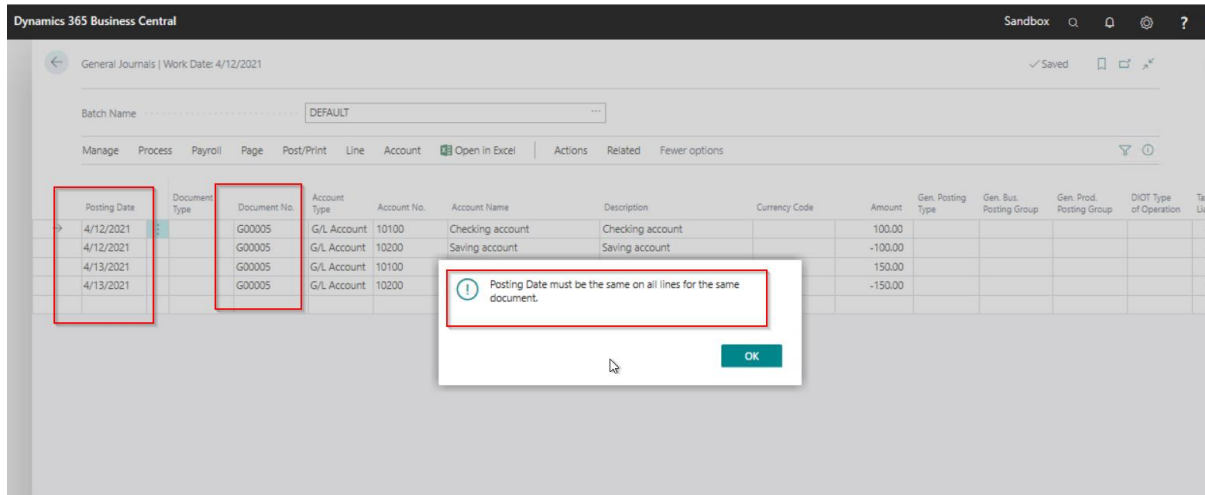
There are 2 separate document entries at the General Journals with same posting date are given below.

G/L registers are being done by using these Document No values after posting of the journal. Added to this, Posting Date, Voucher No and Article Nos fields are also added into G/L Registers list accordingly. Article No. field can be filled in with renumbering functionality at the month end activities.

An error message may be occurred and posting may be blocked by the system if there are more than 1 line at the journals with same document numbers but at different posting dates.



Test Your Knowledge

Test the same example above with using different currencies. Meantly, create totally four different documents concerning two different dates. For one of the document, enter four lines. But, let it the document has two different currencies. Post the documents. Now, how many journal vouchers created? Again 4 or much more vouchers? Why?

Job Aid

This document will help shortening the number of the pages of some formal documents. And also, this development is beneficial for regularity. Accountants can see the all day transactions in a single document. Please don't forget that this functionality can just be applied to journals, not to other (sales, purchase, inventory etc...) documents.

CHAPTER 2: GENERAL LEDGER

Objectives

The objectives are:

- Identify major changes in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central Turkish version
- Defining Year End Closing Activities
- Identifying TR Setup

Introduction

Although Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central has out-of-box functionality for General Ledger Management, some modifications had to be done to adapt Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central functionality into Turkish Unified Chart of Accounts System, Legal and Market Requirements. In this chapter, localization coverage of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central for Turkey will be explained.

Scenario

Scenario for this chapter mainly consists of setting up General Ledger, year end closing activities and several localization features in accordance with Turkish legal requirements.

Topic 1: Year End Closing Activities

The year end closing transaction steps are as described below.

- Accounting Periods Closing
- Post Reflection Accounts
- Year End Closing Voucher
- Close Income Statement
- Close Balance Sheet Accounts

Note: Before the year end activities it is strongly recommended that you back-up the database.

Year End Closing Activities are the mandatory operations to be done at the each fiscal period end and opening a new fiscal period.

Preliminary determinations have to be done at the “Year-End Closing Setup” form prior to fiscal year transactions.

Dimension codes to be used for closing/opening transactions, journals to be used for year end closing transactions and reason codes have to be determined on this setup.

Prior to closing transactions, reflection accounts have to be determined for the Expense Accounts (in Turkish Accounting Principles; 7XX accounts are expense accounts and reflection accounts have to be determined on these accounts prior to year-end transactions)

Note : Reflection accounts have to be determined for each used expenditure accounts. Alternatively, system may throw an error message to complete the missing reflection account to proceed.

Period and Posting Date fields have to be determined at request form of the report. If it's requested to make this reflection by dimensions, related accounts have to be chosen from the Dimension (Values) selection field. In this case, reflection transactions will be posted by account/by dimension value combinations.

Users may check accounts without reflection accounts prior to reflection by using checking reflection Acc. Filter field at the request form.

Finally, the user may determine Posting Description by request form and may choose "Post," option enabled to generate reflection transactions.

Transactions as like as given below form can be generated by the system after posting.

When the system posts the reflection voucher, it marks the Posted Reflection field on the Ledger entries that are subject to reflection. If the one is posted incorrectly, it does not the reflection field that it has previously put. To remove it, an update is performed with Update G/L entry Reflection report. There are two options in the resulting report for updating. If the Document No filter is selected in the first option, the document number of the reflection voucher is selected and the reflection of entries matching this document number is unmarked. The other option is the account number and date filter. If the user wants , he/she can also remove this mark with this filter.

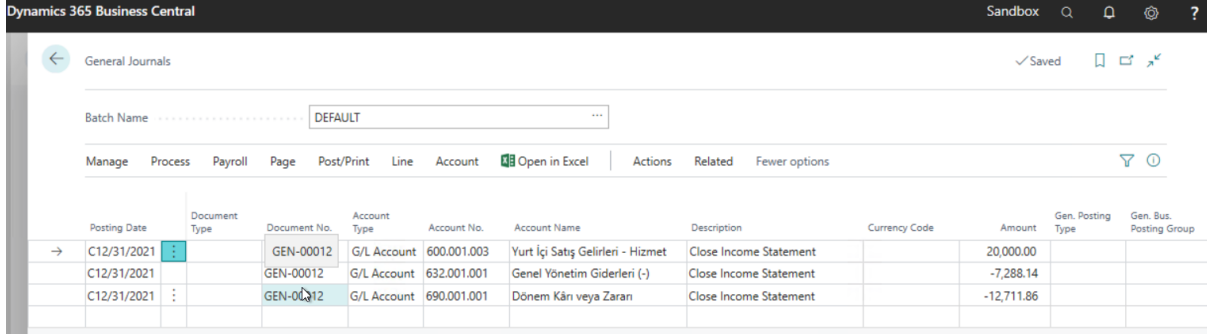

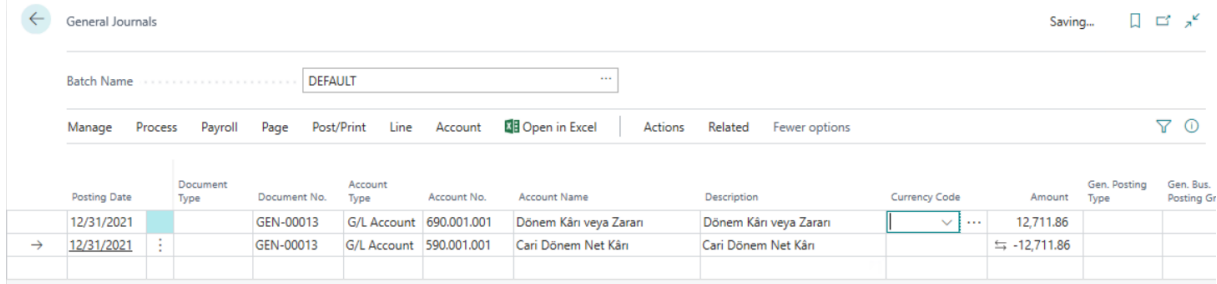

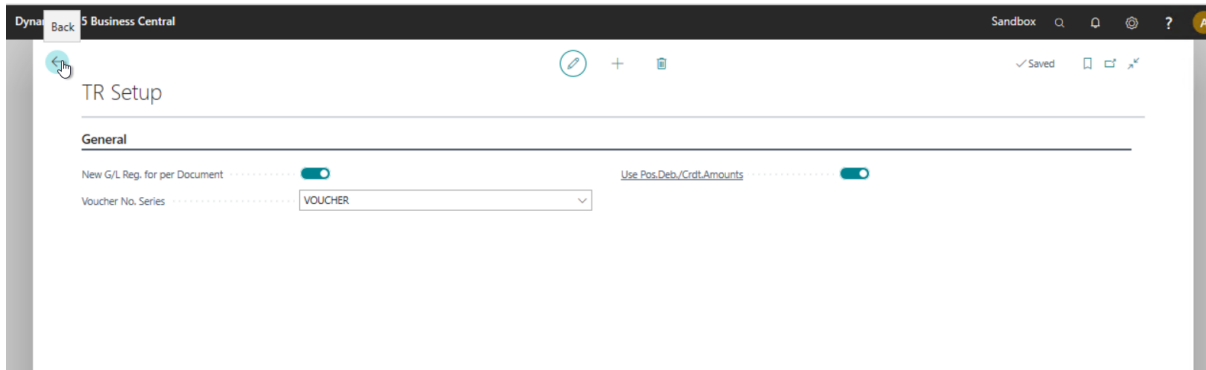

Topic 3: TR Setup

Turkish Localization for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central App has several setup forms in order to define general parameters for each business processes. In addition to these forms,

TR Setup form has been added into Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central TR version in order to define general parameters for Turkey. Although all parameters have been introduced in related chapters of this user guide, it will be shown below in order to clarify main logic underlying at TR Setup form.

Detailed Steps

Fields of the TR Setup Form are;

1. In the **Search** box, enter “TR. Setup” and click the related link
2. Click **New**.
3. On the first line, enter the following fields:

- a. **New G/L Reg. for per Document;**

“New G/L Reg. per Documents” as an option field can be checked as a general parameter if a new G/L Register will be required for each document consequently.

- b. **Voucher No. Series;**

“Voucher No. Series” (mentioned at related Chapter) can be selected at “General Tab” of the TR Setup Form.

A Voucher No. has been given for the posted documents in accordance with Turkish Accounting Principles and they will be shown in G/L Registers and G/L Entries.

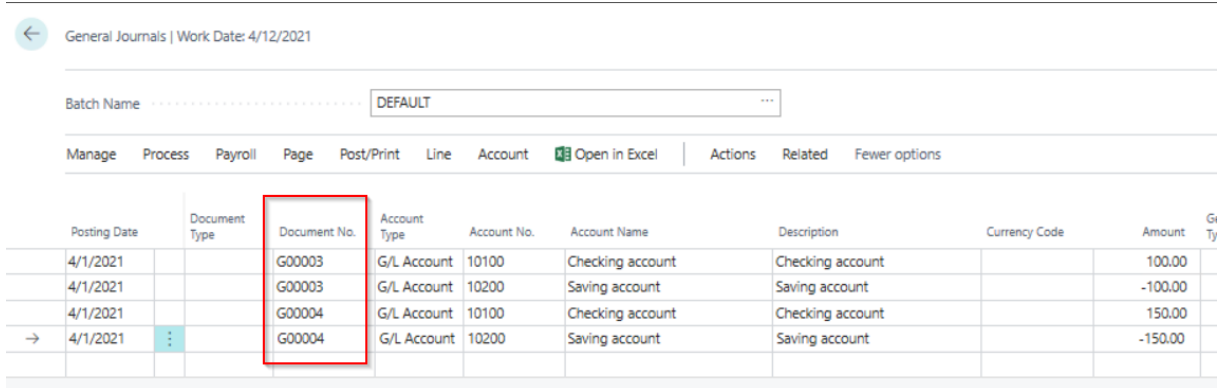
c. Use Pos. Deb./Crdt. Amounts;

Both Debit and Credit transactions have to be shown at the ledgers and legal reports in Turkish Accounting Principles. By clicking this field at TR Setup Form; System may automatically record amounts of the posted transactions into proper fields (debit or credit amount columns) automatically.

CHAPTER 3: BIG PURCHASES / BIG SALES (BA/BS) REPORTS

Ba-Bs Regulation

Ba-Bs Regulation Development

The e-documents received and issued by the company in the new structure will not be reported to Turkish Revenue Administration in BA/BS notification. If the general limit of 5,000 TL has been exceeded, the number and amount of paper invoices received, as well as the number and amount of paper invoices issued will be reported.

In case of purchase of the e-invoice solution from Pargesoftware, it can be determined whether the incoming and issued documents are e-invoices or paper invoices. However, for companies that do not purchase the e-invoice solution, some information must be entered by the company in the fields of current cards and installation.

In order to use Ba-Bs Regulation Development, installations must first be completed in the Ba-BS Setup table.

Ba-BS Regulation Field Descriptions

- BA-BS- Limit: This is the area where the limit down figure specified by the TRA is defined for the calculation of the BA-BS figure.
- Ba-Bs Calculation Type: The area in which to specify whether the document created in the BA-BS calculation will be calculated according to the posting date or the document date.
- BA-BS Document Limit: The area where the document limit is defined, including VAT, entered to determine whether the incoming invoice is a paper invoice or an e-document.

- Country Region code: Only invoices from Turkey can be E-Document in Ba-BS notifications. In order for the system to separate foreign invoices as E-documents during calculation according to the amount, this field must be defined as the country code selected on the current cards.
- Ba-Bs E-Platform Start Date: If the company has not purchased the E-invoice module from Parge, the company must enter the e-invoice start date in this field. Invoices issued will be checked according to this date whether they are e-documents or paper invoices.

Required areas for description of companies that do not purchase e-invoice solutions

The e-invoice transition date of the company must be written on the Vendor and Customer Cards.

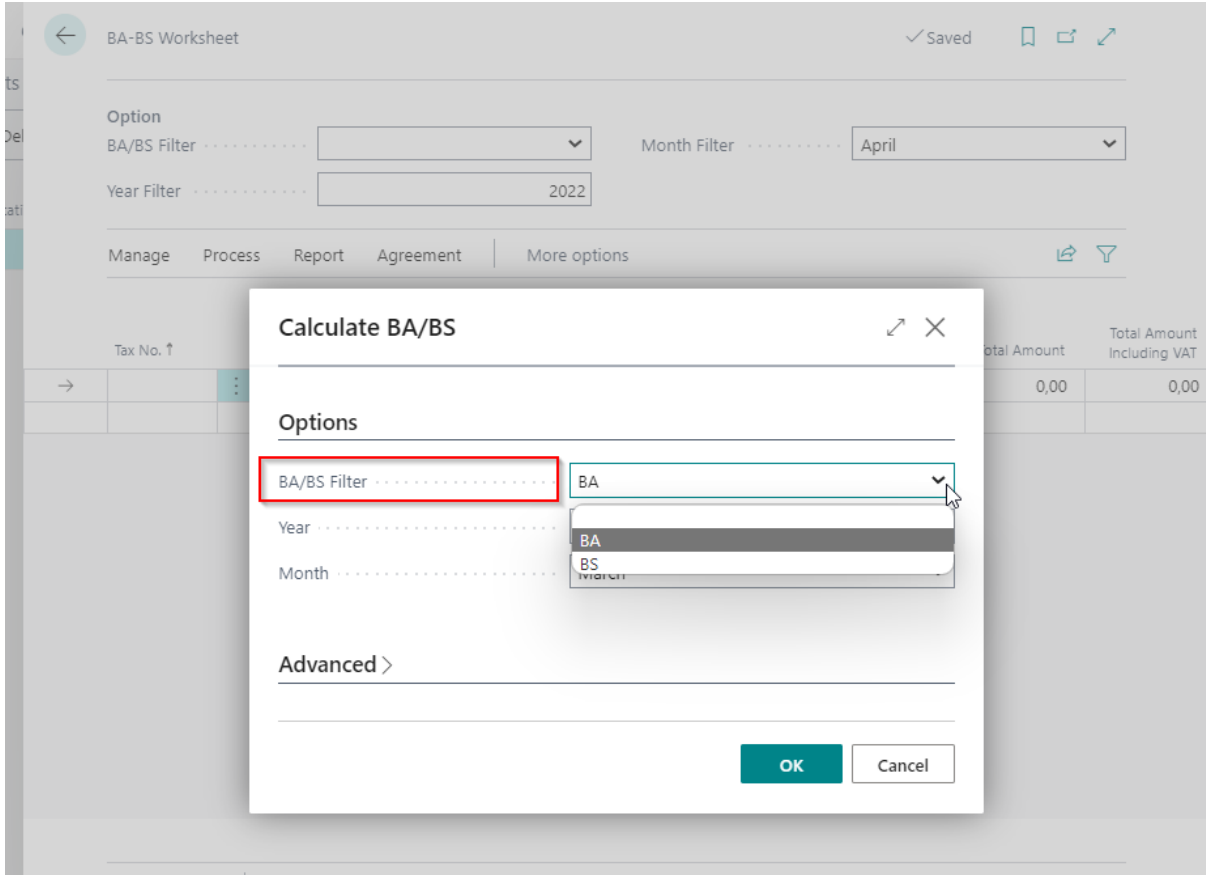

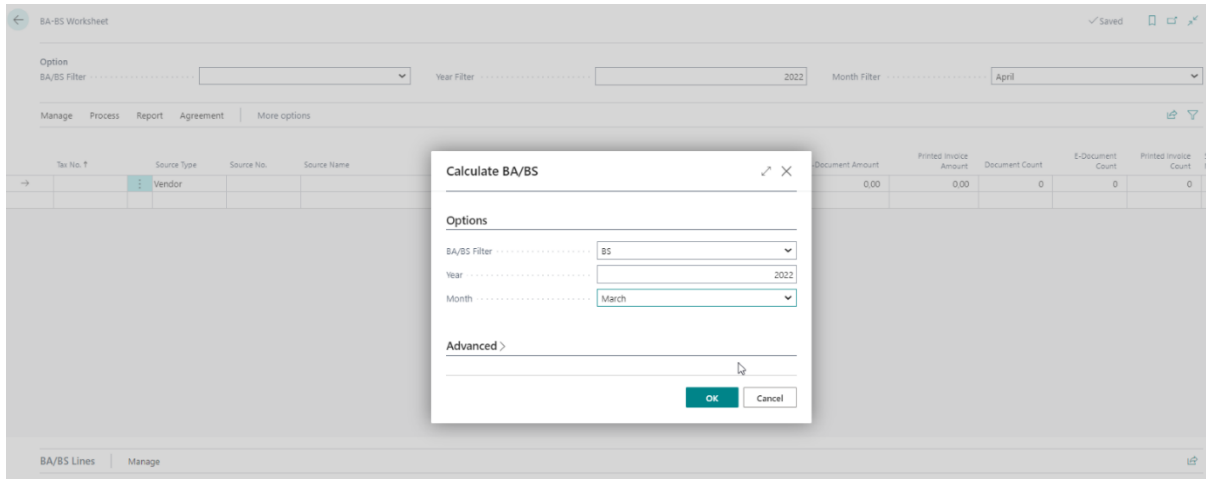

BS Worksheet Usage

Bs figures will be calculated for the period related to the Calculate Bs report for the Bs report. Unlike BA, the system will look at whether the company is an E-invoice taxpayer when calculating BS. If the company has purchased the E-invoice module, all invoices to the BS worksheet will be marked as e-documents. If the company is not covered by the e-invoice, only invoices issued under 2,000 TL will be marked as printed invoices. As invoices issued above 2,000 TL by law will be issued as e-archives, these invoices will not appear in BS form. However, if the document type is selected in the sales document, the type selected in the document will be valid.



The following calculation is made for the scenario covered by the e-invoice.

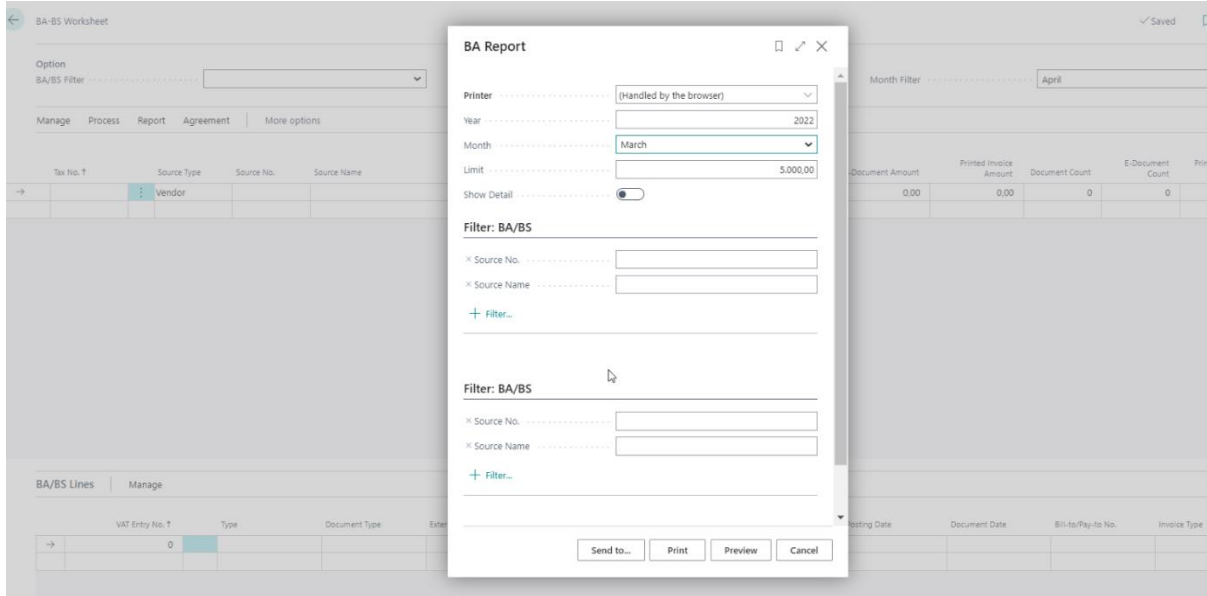

Change a Document Type in a BS-BA Worksheet

Vendor who are not covered by the e-invoice can deduct the invoices they have issued under 2.000.00 TL as E-Archive on request. As a rule, it is not possible for the system, which is an optional invoice, to perceive these invoices as e-documents according to a rule. Invoices issued in this way must be changed by the taxpayer from the BA-BS worksheet. The following buttons must be used to change the type in order to make this change.

CHAPTER 4: EXCHANGE NOTE DEFINITION

Cheques or promissory notes are important among the payment methods used in commercial life. The cheque, which is considered valuable documents, is issued, and used according to the promissory note legislation. The ones that come to the business must be registered according to the rules.

Exchange Note Development Features

1. Identifying and tracking customer cheques and promissory notes in the program,
2. Sending customer cheques and promissory notes to the bank for collection,
3. Collection of cheques and promissory notes sent to the bank,
4. Negotiate of customer cheques to vendors,
5. To follow up on bounced cheques and promissory notes,
6. The company arranges its own cheques
7. Issuing edited cheques to vendors
8. Collection of cheques issued to vendors

Exchange Note Setup

It is necessary to set up Exchange Note before trading on exchange Note Setup. In order to setup, the following actions must be taken.

Steps to Follow

- The search field is typed Exchange Notes Setup and the relevant setup page is accessed.
- If no other installation has been done before, a new page opens. If it has already been installed, the page is accessed by clicking edit.

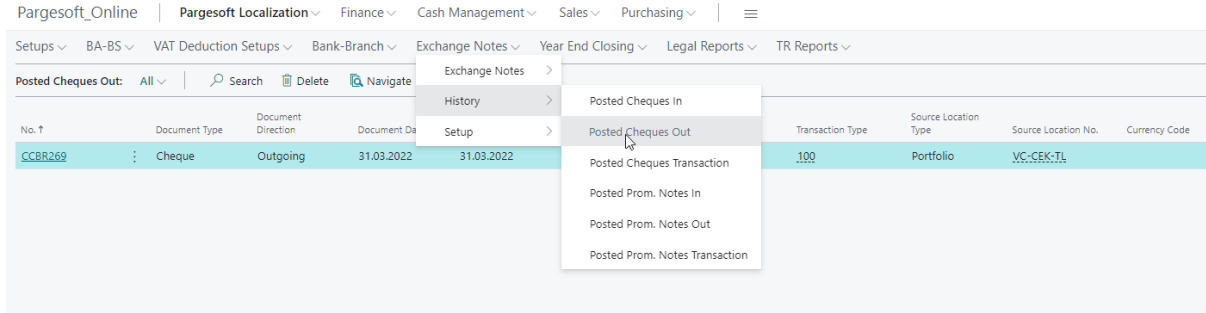

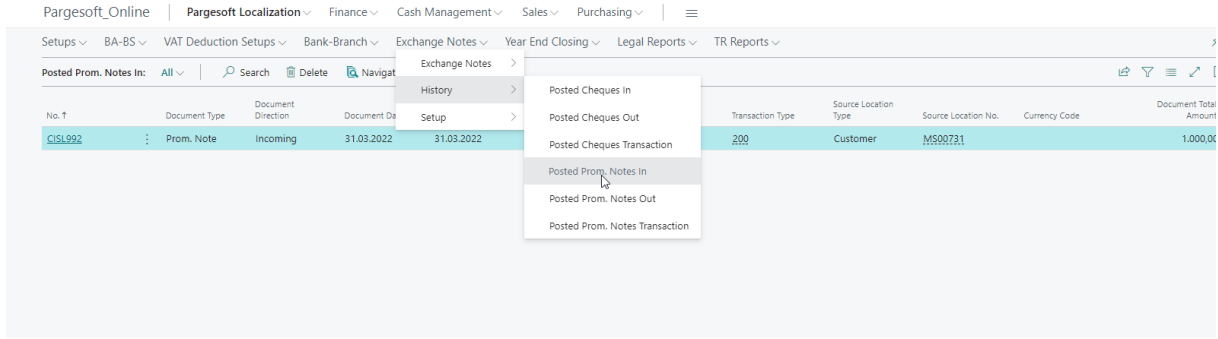

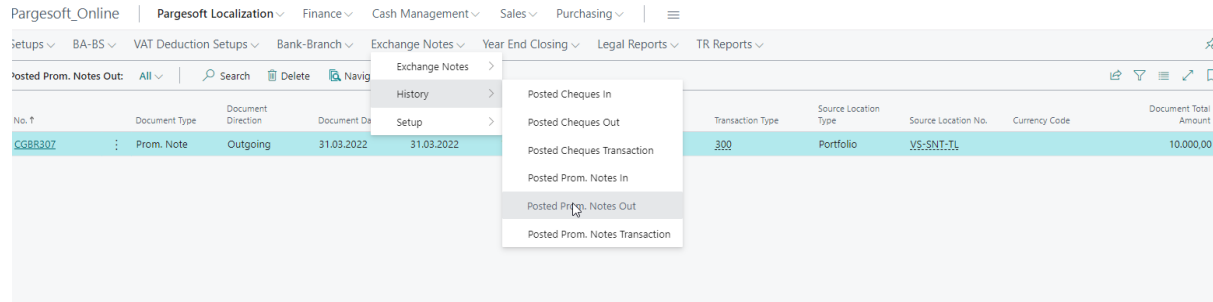

CHAPTER 5: DEDUCTION

Definition of Deduction

In the article on the 8th of VATA, it is determined who are VAT payers using the counting method.

- Those involved in the delivery of goods and the performance of services,
- Importers of goods and services on import,
- Those who are subject to customs or passage transaction in transit transportation.
- Etc.

In the absence of the taxpayer's residence, workplace, legal center and business center within Turkey, and,

- ministry of finance, where necessary,
- in order to secure the tax receivable,
- it may hold parties to taxable transactions liable for the payment of tax.

VAT Deduction is not a arbitrary application, but it is mandatory to be deduction by buyers in transactions covered by the Ministry of Finance's application. On the other hand, it is not possible to be deduction by buyers in transactions not covered by Deduction by the Ministry of Finance.

The Deduction Officer must declare the VAT he/she has deduction with VAT Declaration No. 2.

Deduction Features

1. To be able to post Sales Invoice with more than one Deduction rate within the same document,
2. To be able to post Purchase Invoice with more than one Deduction rate in the same document,
3. To be able to post Sales Invoice with more than one VAT Product Group within the same document,
4. To be able to post Purchase Invoice with more than one VAT Product Group in the same document,
5. To be able to post a Sales Invoice with and without Deduction in the same document,
6. To be able to post a Purchase Invoice with and without Deduction in the same document,

7. To be able to post multiple VAT products and multiple Deduction rates different Sales Invoices in the same document,
8. To be able to post multiple VAT products and multiple Deduction rates different Purchase Invoices in the same document,

Deduction Installation & Deduction Applications

If Deduction is to be applied in sales and purchase documents for the company, the Deduction parameter must be activated within the Core Setup.

Steps to Follow

1. Core Setup is written in the Search Field and the relevant setup page is accessed.
2. If no other installation has been done before, a new page opens. If it has already been installed, the page is accessed by saying edit.

CHAPTER 6: CURRENCY DEVELOPMENT

Definition of Exchange Rates

The Central Bank takes the necessary measures with the government to protect the internal and external value of the Turkish lira and determines the exchange rate regime towards making firm the value of the one against foreign currencies and gold.

The Central Bank; within the framework of the monetary policy, which it implements, it can realize the buying and selling of currency and effectives with term and non-term in order to determine value of the Turkish lira against foreign currencies. Within the extent of the same purpose, the Bank; it can make transactions such as exchange of currencies with Turkish lira by predetermining the conditions.

The general framework of foreign exchange and effective markets has been determined by subparagraphs (b) and (g) of the first paragraph of Article 4 of the Central Bank Law and article 39 and article 53 (a).

How are Indicative Rates Defined?

As of January 2, 2015, the Central Bank determines the exchange rate of the Turkish lira for 1 US dollar as follows.

First of all, between 10.00-15.00 every hour, it receives the buying and selling price average of the banks that quotation * the Turkish lira for 1 USD in the interbank foreign exchange market. It determines a “medium value” by taking the average of all 6 value that have arisen.

It determines the buying and selling rates by applying discount and bonus to the medium value.

What are The Calculation Hours of Exchange Averages?

- 10.00: 1st Average
- 11.00: 2nd Average
- 12.00: 3rd Average
- 13.00: 4th Average
- 14.00: 5th Average
- 15.00: 6th Average

Similarly, for other exchange rates, the arithmetic average of the 6 values of cross rates in international markets between 10.00-15.00 is applied to the middle value of the US dollar and medium values are calculated for other exchange rates and The foreign exchange buying and foreign exchange selling values of the relevant exchange rates are determined by applying discount and bonus to the middle values determined for each exchange rate.

When are Indicative Rates Announced?

The average and medium values for the hours in the table above, as well as the US dollar/euro cross rates, will be announced on the Central Bank's Market Data page the next business day.

The Central Bank's indicative exchange and effective buying and selling rates, which are determined on each working day, are announced on its website at 15.30 on the same day and published in the Official Gazette the next day.

These published exchange rates are; although it does not bind any individuals or institutions, it can be used by the Central Bank for pay desks and some accounting transactions one business day after the day they are determined. In transactions between real and legal persons other than the Central Bank, they decide for themselves which rate to apply.

Besides, indicative exchange rate is not determined on public holidays, weekends and half-day working days.

In this context, exchange buying and selling, effective buying and selling rates are published for the above exchange types in Turkey. This development has been made in order to be able to trade at the desired exchange rate for each type of currency in the program.

Exchange Development Features

1. Automatic downloading of rates according to currency types defined in the automatic program on a daily basis,
2. Manually downloading rates in the currency types defined in the program,
3. Ability to Select the Default Currency Type in the Customer Card,
4. Ability to Select the Default Currency Type in the Vendor Card,
5. Ability to select the type of currency in the Sales Documents (order, return order, invoice, and return invoice),
6. Ability to select the type of currency in the Purchase Documents (order, return order, invoice, and return invoice),
7. Automatically receiving Currency Code Type from current card when customer and vendor are selected for transactions made from the journal,
8. The arrival of the exchange rate automatically selected from the currency type in the journal,
9. Formation of an Amount LCY on a check card according to the type of currency selected on check cards,
10. Ability to enter the product price in currency by selecting the Currency and Currency Type in the Line for Sale Documents (order, invoice, return order and return invoice) that do not select the Currency Type in the Sale header,
11. Ability to enter the product price in currency by selecting the Currency and Currency Type in the Line for Purchase Documents (order, invoice, return order and return invoice) that do not select the Currency Type in the Purchase header.

Exchange Rate Download

In order to set up automatic download of exchange rates in the System, it is necessary to determine the type of Currency code that the company will use by default. According to the type of currency code specified, the system determines the type of currency code that it will use during the period-end exchange rate adjustment and debit credit matching operations. In addition, in order for the exchange rates to come down, public holidays must be defined in the system.

This description should be made from the place specified below.

Steps to Follow

1. Core Setup is written in the Search Field and the relevant setup page is accessed.
2. If no other installation has been done before, a new page opens. If it has already been installed, the page is accessed by saying edit.
3. The default Currency Type is selected in the Default Currency Type field.
4. The default Currency Type is selected in the Adj. Default Currency Type field.
5. The corresponding page is closed.

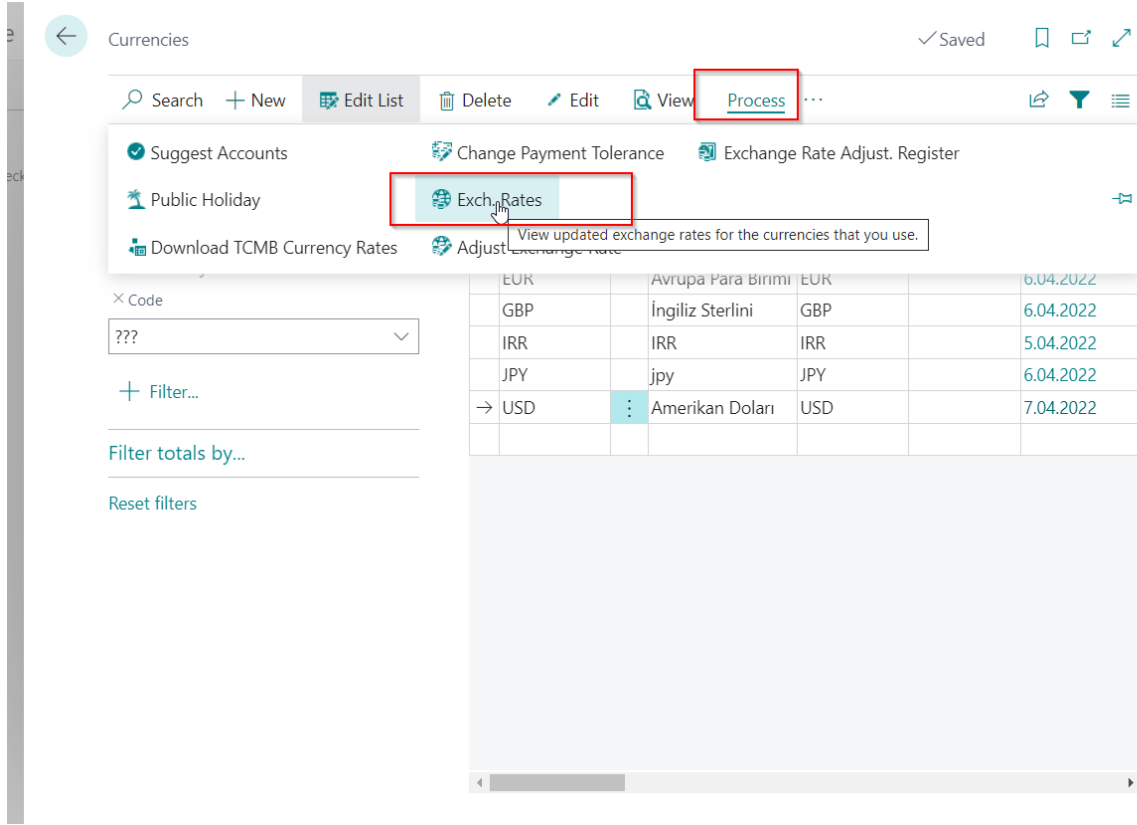

- On the Currencies Page, the Download TCMB Currency Rates button is pressed from the Process Menu to bring down exchange rates.

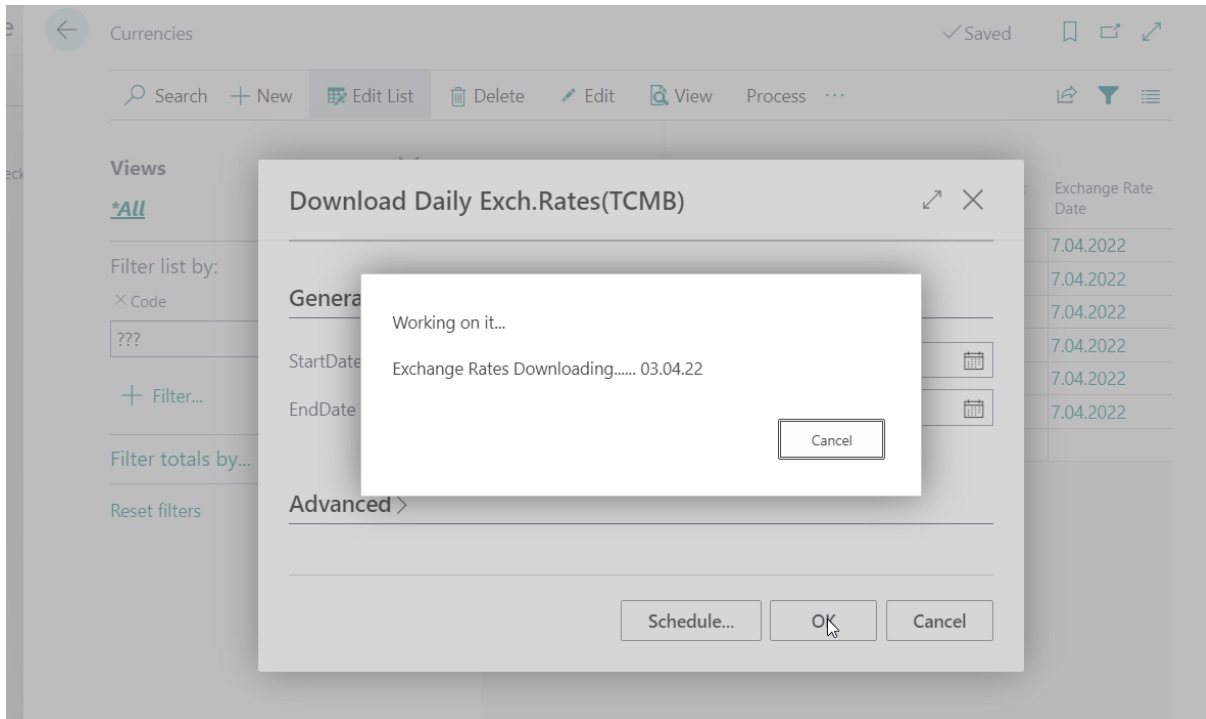

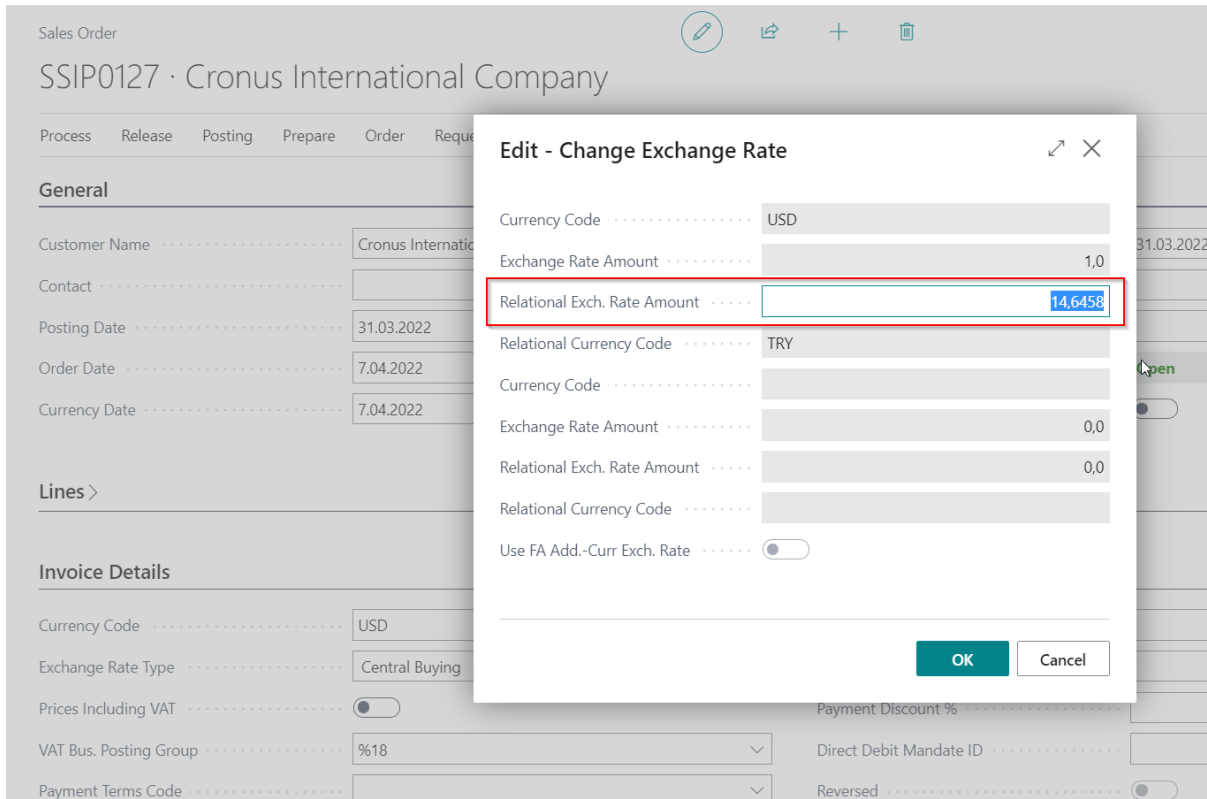

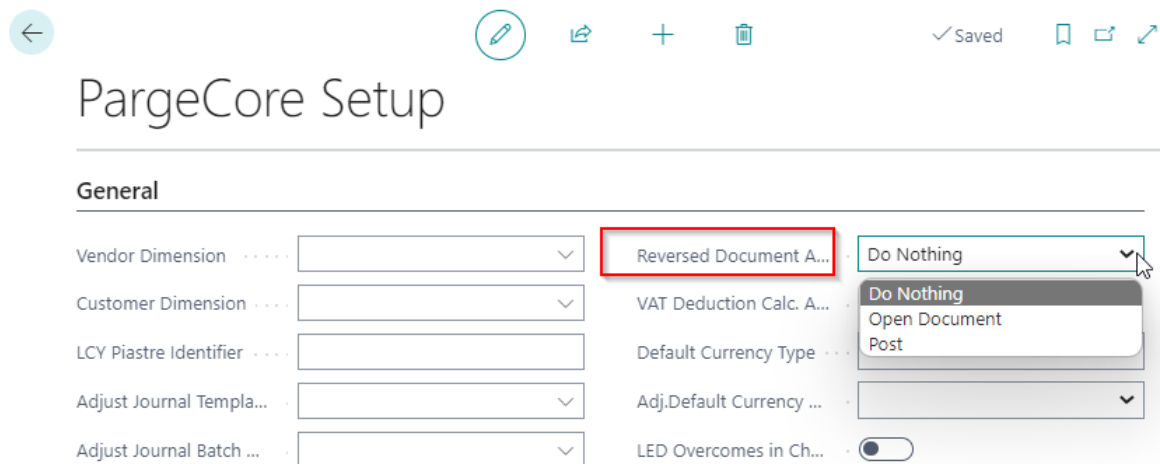

3. Create a Reverse document from a posted Purchase Invoice,

Parge Core Setup

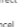
