We both add and discontinue between 25-50 cultivars annually in order to try our very best to stay on the “cutting edge” in the world of daylilies and to be able to offer you new selections each year.

We continue to solicit and to also share daylily hardiness information, by USDA climate zone, as it becomes available. Please let us know if you disagree with any of the recommendations which we offer as this is the only way which we have been able to develop these recommendations. It includes a secured easy to use shopping cart for online ordering and automatically totals your order, including shipping, from anywhere in the world.

We give a 20% gift in daylilies of our choice on orders having a plant total value of \$50.00 or more with the exceptions of 2007 introductions, seedlings, or specials regardless of which method you choose to order-- web site, phone, or mail. Please list your hardiness zone to assist us in selecting your gift.

You may subscribe (or unsubscribe) to our email newsletter by filling in your email address at the “Roycroft Daylily Nursery Newsletter” location on the left-hand side of our web site and be notified of any specials which we may offer throughout the year. We normally email the newsletter to members 4-6 times per year.

We hope you will visit our nursery and American Hemerocallis Society National Daylily Display Garden in coastal South Carolina. You will be able to view and purchase container-grown daylilies while browsing under 55% shade cloth which we install for your comfort during the summer months. Several of our 24 display beds are nestled under large Longleaf Pine trees which provide natural shading. Our web site’s “Nursery Photo Gallery” will give you a flavor of what you might expect to see at our nursery and we encourage you to visit it!

June is our absolute peak bloom month; however, we have a lot of bloom from May through October. The map on the back of this catalog denotes two 10' x 36' billboards on US Hwy. 17 to remind you that you are approaching the turnoff on Whitehall Avenue which leads to our nursery. Whitehall Avenue is located 5 miles south of historic Georgetown, SC.

Please note that the mail-order prices found in this catalog pertain only to bare-rooted mail-order purchases, not to container purchases. Prices vary between our catalog prices and our potted price list which you will be given upon arrival at our nursery. Gift plants are not given with potted purchases.

We strive to attain the best photos possible but sometimes, despite our efforts, they are not completely accurate. Accordingly, please read the written descriptions rather than just ordering from our photos. We take pride in supplying quality daylilies and strive to only ship plants which we would be delighted to receive ourselves! We hope that you enjoy our catalog and web site, and, will give us the opportunity to serve you in 2007 and 2008!

A LADY OF CLASS

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-133-AR. (*Angel Rodgers x unknown*) – 23", EM-VL, RE, SEV, 5½". Up to 4-way branching; 26 buds. The name says it all! A beautiful pleated-ruffled coral flower with a rose eye and gold throat. A unique flower which will not be confused with any other. Fertile both ways. Reblooms into the very late bloom season for us. **single fan \$80.00**



BELLE ISLE LADY

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-156-AR. (*Angel Rodgers x unknown*) – 33", ML-VL, RE, SEV, 6½" to 7½". Up to 5-way branching; 24 buds. A stunning rose flower with looping ruffles, a darker eye and veining, and a chartreuse throat. Fertile both ways. Reblooms into the very late bloom season for us. Many have inquired about purchasing this cultivar over the past two years in both our evaluation and lineout beds. Very special; beauty personified! **single fan \$100.00**



BELLE ISLE MIST

(Roycroft, 2006) dip seedling 00-2-SSxGS. (*Sabra Salina x Gentle Shepherd*) – 22", EM-ML, RE, SEV, 5¾". 3-way branching; up to 14 buds. A sibling of ALICE'S GHOST. A light lavender flower with a darker etched band and a chartreuse throat. This cultivar seems to catch everyone's eye! I was not planning to register it due to low bud count, but, changed my mind since many customers have wanted to purchase it. It is a stunning flower and an excellent rebloomer into the late midseason. Also, it is a fast increaser and we have a good inventory; thus the unbelievably low introductory prices! **single fan \$20.00; double fan \$30.00**



GEORGETOWN CUTIE

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-179-SH. (*Susan's Honor x unknown*) – 24", ML-VL, RE, SEV, 4¼". Up to 3-way branching; 16 buds. A heavy blooming peachy cream flower with a burgundy eye and a chartreuse throat. Fertile both ways. The form of every flower is perfect! It is so cute and puts on an impressive display of blooms through the very late bloom season for us! **single fan \$30.00; double fan \$45.00**



JUST FOR GLORIA

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-120-AR. (*Angel Rodgers x unknown*) – 22", M-VL, RE, SEV, FR, 5¼". This extremely heavy bloomer is one of my best diploid introductions ever! Named in memory of my dear sister, Gloria Roycroft Fletcher, who was loved by her family and all who knew her. This fabulous cultivar has up to 4-way branching; 33 budcount. The beautiful flower is an orange sherbet cream with a bold deep rose eye and a glowing green throat. It is also diamond dusted! Very ruffled; one of our heaviest bloomers ever! Fertile both ways. Late and very late reblooms sometimes have extra segments which leads me to believe that it may be an excellent parent for doubles. **single fan \$70.00; double fan \$105.00**



WINYAH FANTASY

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-134-AR. (Angel Rodgers x unknown) – 28", M-L, RE, SEV, 6½". Up to 4-way branching; 19 buds. A stunning light lavender flower with darker veining, a large bold grape eye, and a chartreuse throat. The eye and throat significantly spill over to the sepal. A distinctive white midrib extends from the throat through the end of the petals. Fertile both ways. A real eye catching beauty which reblooms through the late bloom season for us. **single fan \$90.00**



WINYAH INTRIGUE

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-136-AR x FPW. (Angel Rodgers x Forsyth Purple Wave) – 27", M-L, RE, SEV, 6". Up to 3-way branching; 15 buds. Distinctive; a real eye catcher! A lavender flower with darker veining, a grape eye, and a bold yellow to chartreuse throat which spills onto the sepals. Nice. Fertile both ways. Reblooms through the late bloom season for us. **single fan \$60.00**



WINYAH PRESENCE

(Roycroft, 2005) dip seedling 01-114-AR. (Angel Rodgers x unknown) – 27", M-L, RE, SEV, 5½". Up to 3-way branching (each branch is "Y" branched); 21 buds. Unique and a favorite of our nursery visitors for the past three years! A light cream flower with a light pink to orchid blush, a dark bold grape-purple eye, and a chartreuse throat. Extremely pod fertile (sets pods the size of golf balls) but is pollen sterile. Produces large fans and strong scapes with fabulous flowers, but, it a slow increaser for us. Reblooms through the late bloom season for us. **single fan \$100.00**

BOB'S RED TARGET

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-94-FM. (Fooled Me x unknown) – 24", EM-ML, RE, DOR, 6". 3-way branching; up to 13 buds. An electric orange flower with a large red eye and yellow throat which spills over onto the sepals. I was not planning to register this cultivar due to low bud count, but, we did test sell at the nursery for the last two years. It is a huge seller because it is a stunning flower and an excellent rebloomer into the late midseason. It is a fast increaser and we have a good inventory; thus the unbelievably low introductory prices! **single fan \$20.00; double fan \$30.00**



GEORGETOWN GOLD

(Roycroft, 2005) tet seedling 01-166-gold seedling. (parentage unknown) – 37", ML-VL, RE, SEV, 7". Up to 5-way branching; 30 buds. Tall! A stunning gold self flower with a jade green heart. Reblooms well into the very late season for us. I had not planned to register this cultivar as it looks similar to the famous award-winning MARY'S GOLD. However, that changed when we realized that GEORGETOWN GOLD is just getting started with blooms when MARY'S GOLD is on its last rebloom scapes for the year. GEORGETOWN GOLD reblooms through the very late bloom season for us! **single fan \$80.00; double fan \$120.00**



LEMONADE SUMMERS

(Cribb, 2006) tet seedling C-00-13. (Ever Delightful x Clothed In Glory) – 20", EM-L, RE, SEV, 5". 3-way branching; up to 18 buds. This 5" lemon yellow flower reminds me of long sun filled summer days and cool lemonade. It has been admired by many nursery visitors and will be a great garden flower for you! . **single fan \$30.00; double fan \$45.00**



WHITEHALL BEAUTY

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-178-FM. (Fooled Me x unknown) – 30", EM-ML, RE, EV,VFR, 6½". Up to 4-way branching; 19 buds. Everyone who sees this outstanding cultivar comments on its beauty! A cranberry flower with a lighter chalky halo and a yellow throat. A heavy proliferator. Fertile both ways. **single fan \$60.00**

BUCKEYE SCARLET

(Roycroft, 2006) dip seedling 01-155-LBB. (Lavender Blue Baby x unknown) – 23", EM-ML, RE, SEV, FR, 5¼". Up to 3-way branching; 20 buds. A glowing neon rose flower with a lighter halo and a small chartreuse throat. It is unusual for a daylily flower to actually glow but this one does! Its blooms draw people to it like a magnet! Fertile both ways.

FORSYTH CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

(LeFever 2006) dip. seedling. (Parentage unknown) – 30", RE, M, SEV, Fr, 6". 3-way branching; up to 18 buds. Unique! A brilliant red flower with a huge green throat that covers half of the flower. In addition it throws some polytepal flowers, some with so many segments that the flowers look to be computer generated. It also produces some fans that have a white stripe in the middle of the fan. This would be a brilliant and unusual addition to your garden. Fertile.

FORSYTH PRINCESS LEAH

(LeFever 2006) Dip. Seedling # 01-299-1. (Glenn Fletcher Memorial x Forsyth Ace Of Hearts) – 30", RE, M, EV, Fr, 7-8". 3-way branching; 14 buds. Named for our beautiful little granddaughter who is a princess! An impressive large plant with very large wide open flowers framed by pleated ruffles. The color is light beige with a large light grape eye and wide green throat. This one is a great candidate for conversion to tetraploid. Visitors always comment on this cultivar. Very fertile.

WINYAH SPIRIT

(Roycroft, 2006) dip seedling 01-174-LBB. (Lavender Blue Baby x unknown) – 24", EM-ML, RE, SEV, FR, 5". Up to 6-way branching; 26 buds. A very heavy bloomer. A lavender flower with a purple eye, chartreuse throat, and lighter to near-white edge. Extremely fertile both ways; a seed producing machine! ..

ADORNED WITH JEWELS

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-175-BP&L. (parentage unknown) – 27", E-ML, RE, EV, FR, 5". 3-way branching; up to 16 buds. (This cultivar had the nursery name of Bob's Peach and Lavender.) A beautiful light peach flower with a lavender eye, gold throat, and lavender edge adorned with light peach to light golden jewel-like knobs. Puts up an abundance of original and rebloom scapes over a 2½ to 3 month period! Very impressive! Extremely fertile both ways.

AT FIRST SIGHT

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 02-196-WL. (Winyah Legacy x unknown) – 28", EM-ML, RE, SEV, 5¾". 3-way branching; up to 16 buds. An impressive mauve colored flower with a large bold dark mahogany to near black eye and same colored broad edge, and, a green throat. Fertile both ways. A fast increaser which has allowed these very low introductory prices.

BELLE ISLE INTRIGUE

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 03-199-EBxFl. (Ed Brown x Foreign Intrigue) – 30", EM-L, RE, EV, FR, 5". Up to 5-way branching; 34 buds. A cranberry colored flower with a darker eye, sparkling gold edge, and yellow to chartreuse throat. A beautiful and extremely vigorous grower which produces enormous amounts of blooms into the late bloom season for us. Fertile both ways. **single fan \$60.00; double fan \$90.00**



CANARY TANGO

(Cribb, 2006) tet seedling C-00-15. (Ever Delightful x Clothed In Glory) – 16", ML, RE, DOR, 5½". 3-way branching; up to 14 buds. An unusual canary gold colored flower and an image of a ruffled skirt tossed about in a tango inspired the name. Short in stature but a "Wow!" for any gardener! A real eyecatcher! **single fan \$40.00**



CAROLINA BELLE

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-190-EB. (Ed Brown x unknown) – 24", EM-ML, RE, EV, FR, 6". Up to 4-way branching; 23 buds. A fabulous and very heavy blooming coral pink with a glittering gold braid and yellow throat. Extremely fertile both ways; another seed producing machine! **single fan \$60.00; double fan \$90.00**



CAROLINA PHANTOM

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 01-198-MOT. (Mask OfTime x unknown) – 32", E-M, RE, EV, 6". 3-way branching; up to 18 buds. A striking mauve to purple colored flower with a darker eye and a chartreuse throat. Its numerous scapes put on a massive show of blooms beginning in the early season. Extremely fertile both ways; a heavy producer of seed. A fast increaser which has allowed these very low introductory prices. **single fan \$40.00; double fan \$60.00**



EARLY SHOWOFF

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 02-194-ASLxVWL. (A Special Lady x Winyah Legacy) – 33", E-ML, RE, EV, FR, 6". 3-way branching; up to 17 buds. A stunning lavender flower with a dark purple eye, chartreuse throat, and a dark purple edge topped with a yellow-gold picotee. Puts on a great show beginning in the early season! Fertile both ways. A heavy proliferator and fast increaser which has allowed these very low introductory prices. **single fan \$30.00; double fan \$45.00**



FORSYTH FIRE IN THE HOLE

(LeFever 2006) Tet. Seedling # 03-26-1. (Adorable Tiger x Forsyth Dazzler) – 26", RE, ML, SEV, Fr, 5". 3-way branching; up to 20 buds. An offspring of two outstanding cultivars! I have been interested in breeding for red eyes for some time now and this cultivar has the most intense red eye that I have yet seen. The eye covers two thirds of the yellow flower and there is a red edge. This is a good performer with a long bloom season and will be a truly striking addition to the garden! Fertile both ways. **single fan \$200.00**



FORSYTH PINK SURPRISE

(LeFever 2006) tet. seedling. (Parentage unknown) – 30", RE, M, SEV, Fr, 6". 3-way branching; up to 18 buds. This cultivar appeared in a row of lavender seedlings and after evaluating it for the summer I decided that this may be one of my very best pinks to date. The color is a beautiful lavender-pink with a heavy gold edge and a small yellow-green throat. This flower has a pristine look about it and I have never seen a bad flower. A good performer and increaser. Fertile both ways. **single fan \$150.00**



FORSYTH TRANSFUSION

(LeFever 2006) Tet. Seedling # 03-51-4. (Tetra Forsyth Ace Of Hearts x Dragon Prince) – 24", RE, M, SEV, Fr, 4½". Up to 4-way branching; 30 buds. When viewing this daylily the color of blood comes to mind; hence the name. This is probably my best red eyed one to date. It seems to have everything; an intense brilliant red eye and edge with a bitter green throat. At times the eye covers most of the flower whose base color is a creamy pink with a yellow cast. The well branched and budded scape is in perfect proportion to the plant. It is a good increaser and will be a stunning addition to your garden. Pollen fertile. (I am delighted to have added my conversion of Forsyth Ace Of Hearts, through this offspring, to the tetraploid gene pool!) **single fan \$200.00**



KAY'S FAITH

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 01-186-SSF. (Samar Star Fire x unknown) – 26", M-L, RE, SEV, 7". 3-way branching; up to 23 buds. Chosen and named by Kay Whitehurst who is a great customer and friend, and, who is also a great judge of daylilies! This outstanding cultivar has a large, clear, and brilliant scarlet red flower with a huge yellow throat which significantly spills onto the sepals. A garden standout which blooms into the late bloom season for us. Fertile both ways. **single fan \$50.00; double fan \$75.00**



LOFTY TREASURE

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 03-205-TC. (Tyler's Cove x unknown) – 43", EM-L, RE, SEV, FR, 7". Widely branched with up to 4-way branching; 29 buds. Tall and large flowered. A diamond dusted peach flower with a red eye and veining, and, a chartreuse throat. An outstanding performer which blooms through the late season for us. And, this is one of the most vigorous cultivars that I have ever seen! One observer said that it looked like a daylily on steroids! Admired by many garden visitors. Fertile both ways. A fast increaser which has allowed these low introductory prices. **single fan \$60.00; double fan \$90.00**



PRINCE CHARMING'S DANCE

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 01-188-CIG. (Clothed In Glory x unknown) – 24", EM-ML, RE, DOR, 5½". Up to 4-way branching; 26 buds. A beautiful lavender flower with a darker halo, yellow throat, and silver picotee. The colors go very well with my previous introduction, CINDERELLA'S DANCE, thus the name. I couldn't keep my eyes off of this beauty last Summer! A great performer; multitudes of scapes; a blooming machine! Fertile both ways but difficult to set pods. **single fan \$60.00; double fan \$90.00**



STATELY BEAUTY

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 03-197-EB. (Ed Brown x unknown) – 34", M-L, RE, EV, FR, 6½". Up to 4-way branching; 29 buds. Tall and stately! A beautiful buttery yellow flower with some sculpting and a pie crusted ruffled edge. Blooms through the late bloom season for us. This outstanding cultivar grabs the attention of everyone — even from a distance! Extremely fertile both ways; a heavy producer of large seed. . . . **single fan \$80.00; double fan \$120.00**



WHITEHALL SPECIAL

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-84-CE. (Classic Edge x unknown) – 25", EM-ML, RE, EV, 5¾". 3-way branching; up to 14 buds. A sibling of WINYAH JEWEL. A cream colored flower with a mahogany eye, chartreuse throat, and mahogany edge bordered by a silver picotee. Puts on a mass of scapes and blooms when blooming at clump strength. Test sales were made on this cultivar at nursery and it was an overwhelming success! **single fan \$60.00**



WINYAH JEWEL

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 00-128-CE. (Classic Edge x unknown) – 26", EM-ML, RE, EV, 5¾". Up To 4-way branching; 19 buds. A sibling of WHITEHALL SPECIAL. A lavender-pink to orchid colored flower with a mahogany eye, chartreuse throat, and a mahogany edge bordered by a silver picotee. Puts on a mass of scapes and blooms when blooming at clump strength. Test sales were also made on this cultivar at nursery and it was an overwhelming success! **single fan \$60.00; double fan \$90.00**



WINYAH LADY

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 02-193-ASL. (A Special Lady x unknown) – 30", EM-ML, RE, SEV, 5". Up to 5-way branching; 25 buds. A recurved peachy pink flower with a bold grape eye and edge, and, a chartreuse throat. Showy and a great performer which produces masses of very pretty flowers! Fertile both ways.

WINYAH STORM

(Roycroft, 2006) tet seedling 01-191-EOD. (Edge Of Darkness x unknown) – 25", EM-ML, RE, EV, 6½". 3-way branching; up to 16 buds. A mauve to purple flower with a silky black eye and a yellow to chartreuse throat. The purple color bleeds into the top of the throat. Many visitors have commented on the beauty and uniqueness of this flower. Fertile both ways.....

(LeFever/LeFever conversion) 36", M, RE, DOR, Fr, 7". Up to 5-way branching; 30 buds. UFO. A stunning and very large flowered pink cultivar having tall and sturdy scapes! The yellow-green throat is huge at 4½". I am delighted to add this Forsyth Pink Flying Dragon conversion to the tetraploid gene pool! This is the first time that it has been offered for sale. I expect to see some unusual formed cultivars introduced out of it, by me and others, in the future! Pollen fertile.....

SELECT SEEDLINGS *Fall Shipment – Will begin shipping on September 4, 2007*

We are again offering our modern hybrid Roycroft SELECT unnamed SEEDLINGS – the best crop ever!

Our pots of 1st year blooming seedlings are always the best sellers at our nursery! People are thrilled to be able to purchase these modern hybrids – each unique – at such low prices! Approximately 75% of these are large-flowered tetraploid seedlings which first bloomed in 2006. Most would have been introduced 1-5 years ago. But now they are too similar to other newer and costly introductions, from me and others, to register. The majority of the parents used in these crosses perform well from zones 3-9!

All of the seedlings represented in the photo of the display centerpiece will be sold as well as some others of equal quality which we just did not have time to display and photograph. These long-blooming SELECT SEEDLINGS will all be of blooming size.

SELECT SEEDLING prices Single fans, \$6.00 each; Double fans, \$9.00 each



You may order from one to ten Select Seedlings or Super Giant Seedlings and each will be different; more than ten may incur duplications.

SUPER GIANT SEEDLINGS

These blooming sized seedlings are the very best that we bloomed and grew out of the crosses of the SUPER RED seedlings with other tall and large flowered cultivars. (SUPER REDS are offspring from TOM WISE X POINT OF VIEW. SUPER REDS will not be offered again as the SUPER GIANT seedlings are even superior to them!)

Nursery visitors will recall that these seedlings were located in three gallon pots behind the nursery building and were loaded with seed pods. Everyone who saw them could not believe how robust and stunning they were and wanted to know if and when they would be for sale. One customer suggested that we call them “SUPER GIANTS”, thus the name.

These seedlings are large flowered and tall with primarily various shades of red colored flowers which hold up very well even in full sun! Most are spider variants or unusual forms. The pots are unlabeled so we cannot pick specific colors to ship to you. But, you can be assured that each



seedling will be vigorous, large flowered, and tall. Each is extremely fertile, both ways, and I think that you’ll find them to be excellent parents for tall and large flowered tetraploid spiders, spider variants, and unusual forms!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

“When should I plant daylilies?”

You will need to make sure that you specify a shipping date in Spring after the danger of frost so that the plants may begin immediate growth after you plant.

We also recommend that your Fall plantings occur at least 1½ months before your first frost so that roots may become firmly established before the arrival of cold weather. Hot climates, especially, should not plant in periods of extremely high temperatures.

“What is a fan?”

When looking at our price list, “1 FAN” is a single fan (one plant) growing on a root system. “2 FANS” is a double fan (two plants) growing on the same root system.

“What is a diploid and a tetraploid?”

Basically, a diploid has 22 chromosomes and a tetraploid has 44 chromosomes. Hybridizers cross diploids with diploids, and, tetraploids with tetraploids in order to produce seed.

“What is a rebloomer?”

Rebloomers put up more than one set of scapes, or bloom stalks, each year. One set may be followed by other sets; or, they may follow after rest period.

“What do I do with the foliage during the fall and winter months?”

Nothing! Dormant foliage types will die down on their own. Evergreens will stay above ground during the winter months and may appear burned (brown) after freezing temperatures. You can trim the “burned” foliage for aesthetic purposes but it’s not necessary.

“Last year I became a Roycroft customer and while I was concerned about planting later in the growing season I am pleased to say all your plants have survived winter here in the western suburb of Boston. Cinderella's Dance and my bonus (gift) plant... were only covered with cut Christmas tree branches in mid January; Forsyth Golden Gift and Forsyth Pawnee had no protection at all.

I am especially pleased that all three fans of Cinderella's Dance have returned and are already several inches tall, and I so look forward to the first blooms of my newest daylily additions.

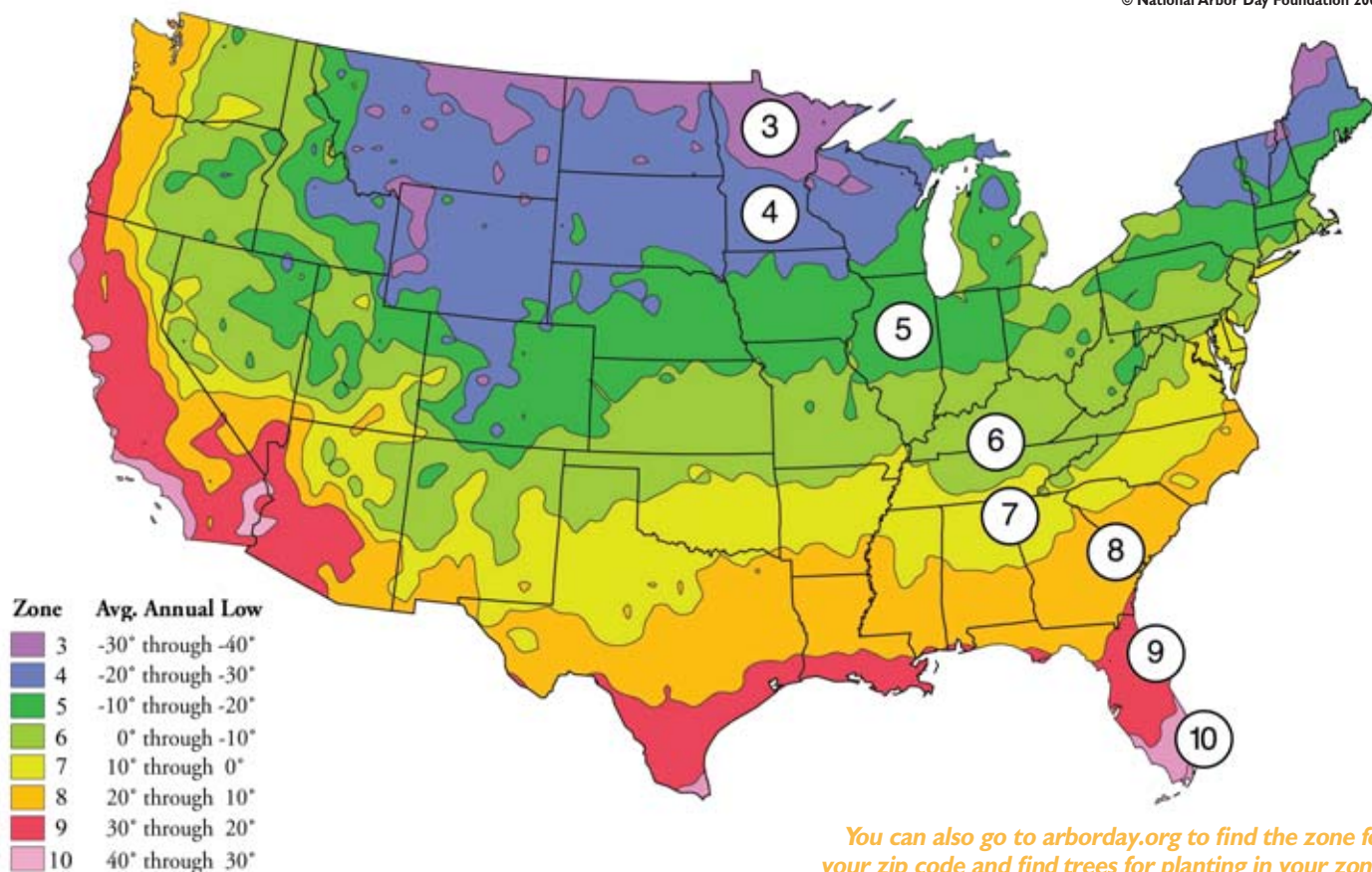

We have compiled information over the years as to how cultivars have performed in different climate zones. A massive amount of information was sent in by members of the Daylily E-mail Robin. We thank a multitude of you for providing this information which should help many! The gathering of this information is ongoing and we solicit your input in the future!

The left-hand column of the *GENERAL LISTING* in this catalog gives the recommended zones in which you should expect a given cultivar to perform well. *Those from zones 7 and 8 are blessed in that all cultivars listed in this catalog should perform well for you!*

DEFINITIONS

?<5-8? Means that thus far evidence is strong that a given cultivar will perform well in zones 5-8; but, more information is needed as to how it performs outside of these boundaries. We are positive that some of the newer and/or lesser known cultivars will later prove to have wider zone ranges. **Any information which you can supply will be appreciated!**

6-8? Means that evidence is strong that a given cultivar will not perform well in climates colder than zone 6; but, more information is needed as to how it performs in zone 9. **Any information which you can supply will be appreciated!**

4-8 Means that evidence is strong that these are the zone limits to which one might expect a given cultivar to perform well. You are still encouraged to let us know should you disagree.

Est 4-8 Means that these are the estimated zone ranges for newer cultivars for which we only have limited zone information. **Any information which you can supply on these cultivars will be appreciated.**

Our zone ratings are conservative. For example, if there was a “mixed bag” reporting of the performance of a given cultivar from both zones 3 and 4 and zone 5’s were consistently good then we rated it a zone 5 for the colder portion of the zone rating. (It is obvious that consistent winter snow cover and heavy mulching made a significant difference in colder climates and these were discounted in favor of a more stark environment.)

Conversely if there was a “mixed bag” rating of a cultivar in zone 9 then we backed down the warmer recommended range to a zone 8.


