Characters:


- Prostomium with 8 9 annulations
- Uniramous anterior parapodia with long dorsal and ventral cirri. The dorsal lobe has a sub-distal notch (a).
- Third and fourth row of large papillae in area II of the proboscis have thick bases and are not bifid (b).
- Medial parapodia (those close to the mid-line of the body) are clearly biramous. The notopodia are much smaller than the neuropodia, which have a rounded presetal lobe with a medial extension and a shorter, broadly triangular postsetal lobe.
- Proboscis without any large papillae on the ventral side (area V) (c).
- About 16 terminal papillae (micrognaths and macrognaths) on proboscis, a pair of large ventral macrognaths, with a short, ventral arc of 0-8 micrognaths (d).




DISTRIBUTION:

Related Species:

Glycinde sp. SF1 - has strongly bifid proboscidal organs with narrow bases in area II and has no ventral micrognaths.

Comments:

G. picta juveniles smaller than 8 mm with underdeveloped micrognaths are indisguishable from *Glycinde* sp. SF1 and should be identified as *Glycinde* spp.

Larger (< 8 mm) *Glycinde* specimens without micrognaths must be examined for the differences in proboscidal papillae. Dissection and examination of the proboscis under the compound microscope is necessary when the proboscis is not everted.
