## Garosyrrhoe bigarra

## Diagnostic Characters:

- Rostrum long for female
- Rostrum short for male
- Coxae 4 as long as and slightly broader than 3
- Gnathopodal palms transverse
- Article 6 of gnathopods short
- Eyes large, fused along the midline, heart-shaped from dorsal view
- G2 much more slender than G1 and armed with a large spine forming a claw
- E3 hind margin serrated
- Telson cleft nearly 3/4ths of the way
