Diagnostic Characters:

Male:

G1, palm flat

G2, deeply excavate, palmar process tapered, extending beyond dactyl hinge

Coxa 5 without pigment spot

G2, inner margin of the dactyl sinuous or notched, but lacking a tooth or medial swelling

G1, article 5 subequal to article 6

G2, palm transverse with single tooth

P4, articles 4 and 5 normal, slender

Female:

G1, palm concave or sinuous

Eye large for the genus

G2, palm excavate or sinuous, without palmar tooth

P4, articles 4 and 5 normal, slender




Figure 24. Photis conchicola Alderman & 5.5 mm, Mukkaw Bay at Sooes Pt., Clallam Co., Washington.
