He witnessed extraordinary faith, a desire to work hard, a commitment to family and a sense of community. Currently working with the Franciscan Ministry of the Word, he preaches at missions and retreats. Through his blog, The Wandering Friar, he chronicles his travels, reflects on current events, and speaks about the poor by challenging his readers with the question, "Have you ever walked in their shoes?"

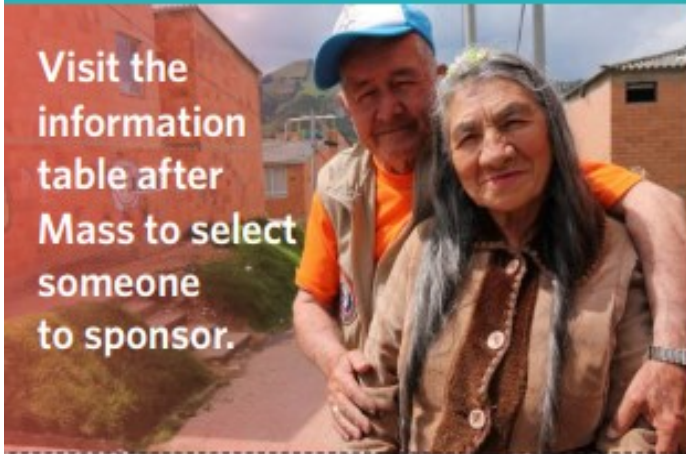
RVDO. JOHN ANGLIN, O.F.M.

Actualmente trabaja con el Ministerio Franciscano de la Palabra y hace presentaciones en misiones y retiros. A través de su blog, “El Fraile Errante” (The Wandering Fray), hace una crónica de sus viajes, reflexiona sobre los acontecimientos actuales y habla de los pobres al desafiar a sus lectores con la pregunta: “¿Ha caminado alguna vez en sus zapatos?”

Growing up in Troyes, France, Marguerite formed a special relationship with Our Lady. She was turned away by two religious communities, but met the founder of Montreal, Canada, when he returned to France to visit his sister. He invited Marguerite to open a school in the New World; she went, despite misgivings, after praying to Mary. From that first school in an abandoned stable, her ministry grew to include teaching women crafts and founding the Sisters of the Congregation of Notre Dame. She managed to keep her sisters uncloistered, despite opposition from the bishop, and served as superior for many years. When Pope John Paul II canonized her in 1982, she became Canada's first woman saint.

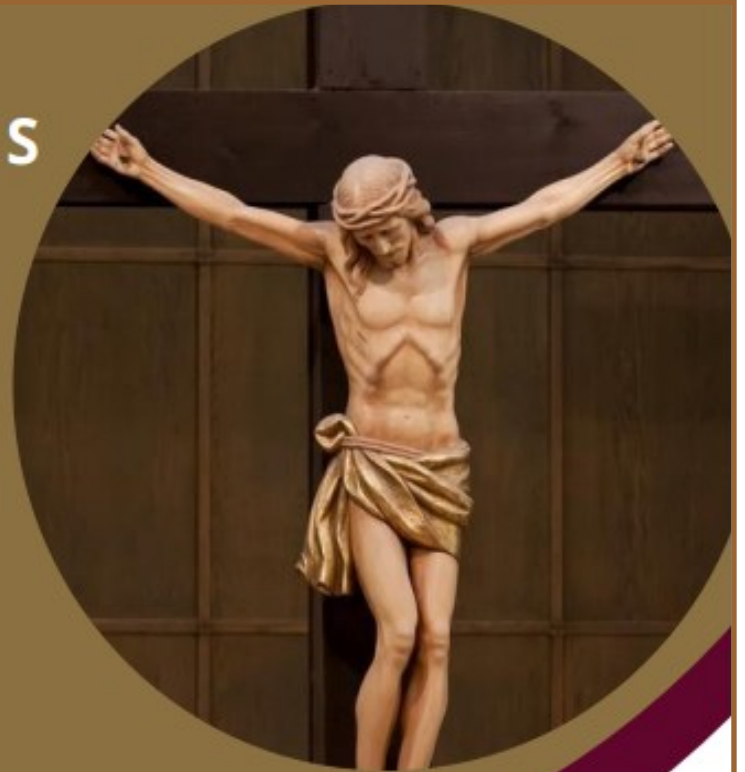

Al crecer en Troyes, Francia, Marguerite formó una relación especial con Nuestra Señora. Dos comunidades religiosas la rechazaron, pero conoció al fundador de Montreal, Canadá, cuando regresó a Francia para visitar a su hermana. Invitó a Marguerite a abrir una escuela en el Nuevo Mundo; ella fue, a pesar de sus recelos, después de rezarle a María. Desde esa primera escuela en un establo abandonado, su ministerio creció hasta incluir la enseñanza de manualidades a las mujeres y la fundación de las Hermanas de la Congregación de Notre Dame. Se las arregló para mantener a sus hermanas sin enclaustrar, a pesar de la oposición del obispo, y sirvió como superiora durante muchos años. Cuando el Papa Juan Pablo II la canonizó en 1982, se convirtió en la primera mujer santa de Canadá.

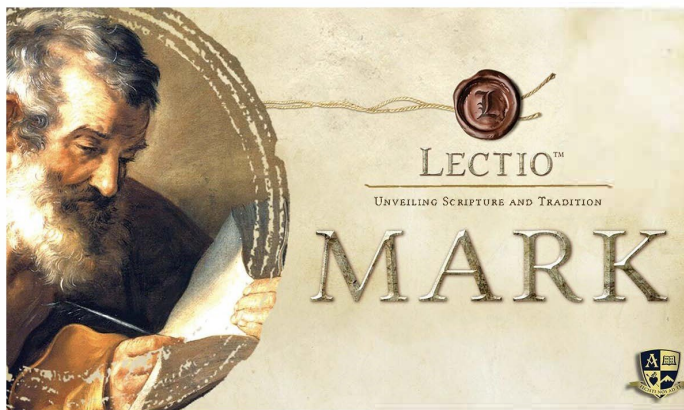

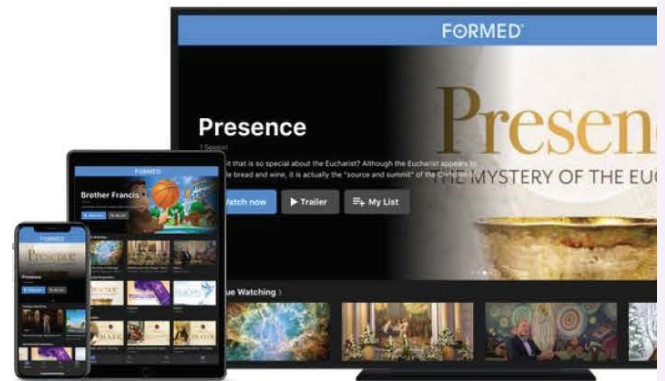

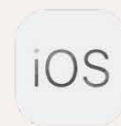
