The journey of the Silver Rose begins each year in March and ends on December 12th, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. 

Reflect—In October, the Church in the United States observes Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is Respect Life Sunday. During this Year of St. Joseph, the humble and often hidden carpenter of Nazareth is guiding our reflections on the gift of life.

At the word of an angel, Joseph took Mary into his home, despite the mysterious nature of her pregnancy. He accompanied Mary in her pregnancy, assisted at the birth of the Messiah, presented Jesus in the Temple, fled with his family far from their homeland to protect them, and lovingly raised Jesus as his own son.

Like every other human family, the Holy Family had to confront real and concrete challenges. Yet, “in every situation, Joseph declared his own ‘fiat’” (*Patris corde, 3*). His “yes” to the Lord meant that regardless of the hardship and personal sacrifice to himself, he consistently chose to put the needs of Mary and Jesus before his own.

Joseph’s devotion helps reveal to us our own call to show special care for the lives of those whom God has entrusted to us. Joseph shows us how to say “yes” to life, despite our own fears, frailties, and weaknesses. May his witness of courage and faithful trust in the Lord inspire us to welcome, safeguard, and defend the precious gift of life.

Reflexione: en octubre, la Iglesia de los Estados Unidos celebra el Mes del Respeto a la Vida y el primer domingo de octubre es el Domingo del Respeto a la Vida. Durante este Año de San José, el humilde y muchas veces escondido carpintero de Nazaret está guiando nuestras reflexiones sobre el don de la vida. A la palabra de un ángel, José llevó a María a su casa, a pesar de la naturaleza misteriosa de su embarazo. Acompañó a María en su embarazo, asistió en el nacimiento del Mesías, presentó a Jesús en el Templo, huyó con su familia lejos de su tierra natal para protegerlos y crió a Jesús con amor como su propio hijo.

Como cualquier otra familia humana, la Sagrada Familia tuvo que afrontar desafíos reales y concretos. Sin embargo, "en cada situación, Joseph declaró su propio 'fiat'" (Patris corde, 3). Feast Day – October 20

1694-1775

Paolo Francesco Danei, the oldest son in a poor but noble Italian family, lived austerely even as a teen. After a year in the Venetian army, he returned to a monk-like life of prayer and penance and refused to marry. In a vision in 1720, Our Lady, wearing a black habit with a white cross and bearing Jesus' name, told Paul to start an order to preach Christ's passion. With his bishop's approval, he founded the Discalced Clerks of the Most Holy Cross and Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ, which he led for the rest of his life, and later began a nuns' institute. Passionists were soon doing missions, retreats and spiritual direction throughout Italy. Paul was canonized in 1867.

Fiesta - 20 de octubre

1694-1775

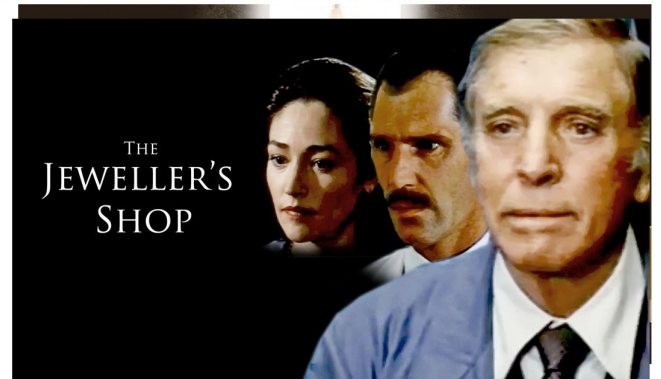
Paolo Francesco Danei, el hijo mayor de una familia italiana pobre, pero noble, vivió austeramente incluso de adolescente. Luego de pasar un año en el ejército veneciano, él retornó a una vida de oración y penitencia, como un monje, y rehusó casarse. En una visión que tuvo en 1720, Nuestra Señora, vistiendo un hábito negro con una cruz blanca y llevando el nombre de Jesús, le pidió a Pablo que iniciara una orden para predicar la pasión de Cristo. Con la aprobación de su obispo, fundó la Congregación de los Clérigos Descalzos de la Santísima Cruz y Pasión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, la cual dirigió por el resto de su vida y, más adelante, inició un instituto para religiosas. Los Pasionistas pronto empezaron a realizar misiones, retiros y a dar orientación espiritual por todo Italia. Pablo fue canonizado en 1867.

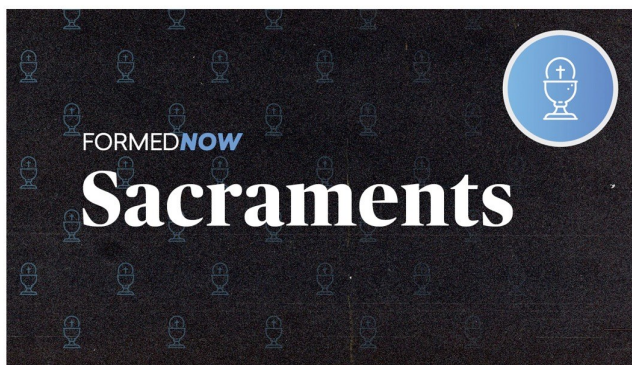
THE JEWELLER'S SHOP: A MODERN MYSTERY BY POPE JOHN PAUL II

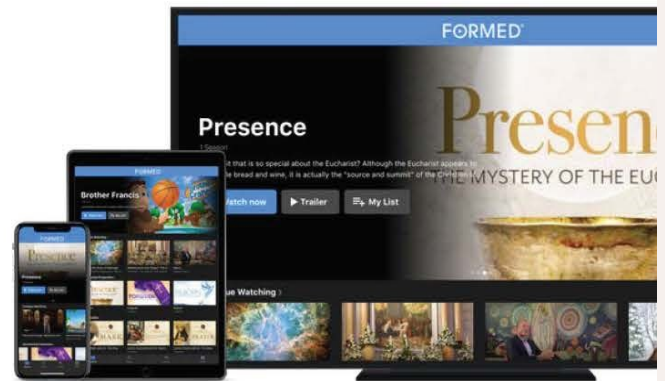

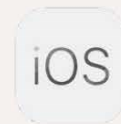
