All the Faithful Departed



Prayers for the dead were an ancient tradition, even in some pagan cultures. In Jewish Scriptures, Judas Maccabeus “made atonement for the dead” (2 Mc 12:46), and early Christians inscribed prayers for their dead in Rome’s catacombs. Local Catholic churches started remembering all the faithful departed in the early Middle Ages, with a Spanish feast from the time of St. Isidore of Seville, who died in 636. The fixed November date is generally attributed to St. Odilio of Cluny, who decreed in 998 that all monasteries under the Cluny rule should sing the Office of the Dead the day after the feast of All Saints. This custom gradually spread throughout Europe and was adopted by Rome in the 13th century.

Todos los Fieles se Fueron

Las oraciones por los difuntos era una antigua tradición incluso entre algunas de las culturas paganas. En las Escrituras judías, Judas Maccabeos hizo una “expiación por los muertos” (2 Mac 12:46), y los primeros cristianos inscribieron oraciones por sus difuntos en las catacumbas de Roma. Las iglesias locales empezaron a recordar a todos los fieles difuntos a principios de la Edad Media con una fiesta española desde el tiempo de san Isidoro de Sevilla, quien falleció en el año 636. Por lo general, la fecha fija de noviembre es atribuida a san Odilón de Cluny, quien en el año 998, decretó que todos los monasterios bajo el régimen de Cluny deberían cantar el Oficio de los Muertos al día siguiente de la fiesta de Todos los Santos. Esta costumbre se difundió gradualmente por toda Europa y fue adoptada por Roma en el siglo XIII.

FEAST DAY—NOVEMBER 1

“God never abandons us. Each time we need it, one of his angels will come to lift us up again and give us comfort; ‘angels,’ at times with a human face and heart because God’s saints are always here, hidden in our midst. This is difficult to understand and also to imagine, but saints are present in our lives.”

—Pope Francis, General Audience, June 21, 2017

All Hallows’ Day, the Solemnity of All Saints, or All Saints’ Day is a celebration of all Catholic saints held on November 1 each year. “On this solemnity, we recall the holy men and women who, having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. These saints, though not canonized, offer us models of abiding faith and love of God and neighbor” (*Essential Guide to Seasons and Saints*, 109).

In the Catholic Church, we are called to imitate and venerate saints because of their heroically virtuous lives, martyrdom, or their offering of life for others. But, what does veneration mean and why do we pray to the saints?

Veneration of the saints fosters our faith in God and does not detract from it. Rather, our faith in God is strengthened by our relationship with our brothers and sisters in the faith who are in heaven. The Church teaches that by imitating the virtues lived by the saints, the saints brings us closer to Christ. When we ask the saints to pray for us, we ask them to join their wills with the will of God and intercede for us



here on earth. This is the Communion of Saints which we profess every Sunday in the Creed. In his homily on the Solemnity of All Saints in 2015, Pope Francis said,

Let us ask the Lord for the grace to be simple and humble people, the grace to be able to weep, the grace to be meek, the grace to work for justice and peace, and above all the grace to let ourselves be forgiven by God so as to become instruments of his mercy.

This is what the Saints did, those who have preceded us to our heavenly home. They accompany us on our earthly pilgrimage, they encourage us to go forward. May their intercession help us to walk on Jesus’ path, and to obtain eternal happiness for our deceased brothers and sisters, for whom we offer this Mass.

The Solemnity of All Saints—November 1—is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Feast Day – November 3

1876-1945

In deference to his father, this German was ordained a diocesan priest first, then entered the Jesuits in 1900. He led parish missions in Germany, Switzerland and the Netherlands, and was wounded as a chaplain in World War I. After the war, he worked in Munich with the poor and unemployed, directed a men's sodality, and spoke out against the rise of Adolf Hitler. The Nazis arrested him three times, imprisoning him at Sachsenhausen and in an abbey. He was freed in May 1945, but had a heart attack while saying Mass Nov. 1.

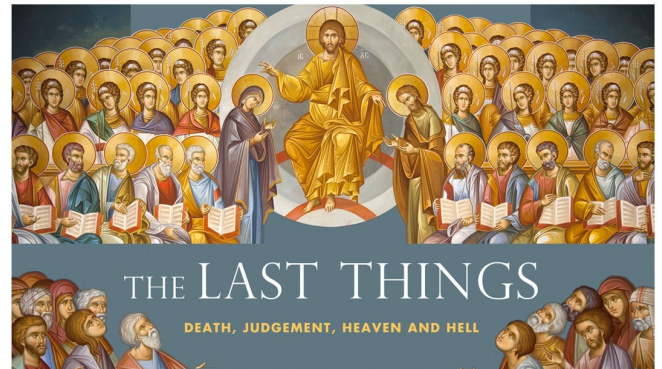

En deferencia a su padre, este alemán fue ordenado sacerdote diocesano primero, luego ingresó a los jesuitas en 1900. Dirigió misiones parroquiales en Alemania, Suiza y los Países Bajos, y fue herido como capellán en la Primera Guerra Mundial. Después de la guerra, trabajó en Munich con los pobres y desempleados, dirigió una asociación de hombres y habló en contra del ascenso de Adolf Hitler. Los nazis lo arrestaron tres veces y lo encarcelaron en Sachsenhausen y en una abadía. Fue liberado en mayo de 1945, pero sufrió un infarto mientras decía misa el 1 de noviembre.

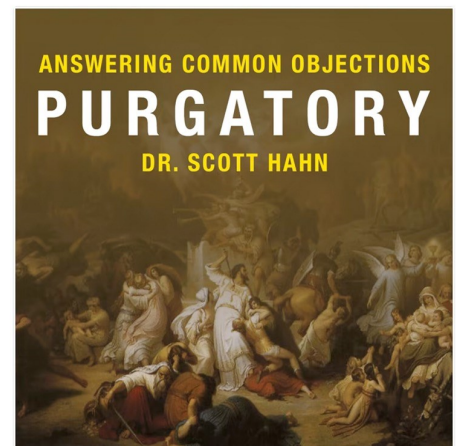

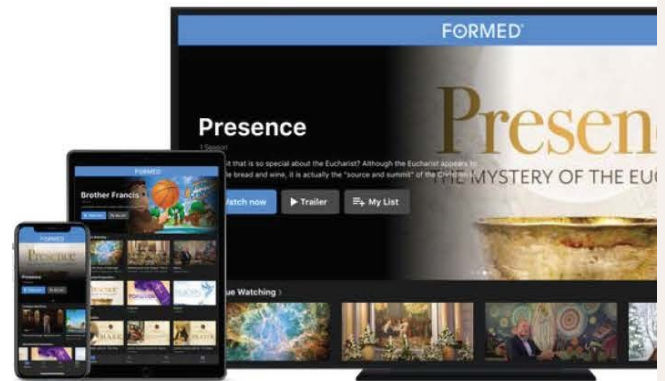

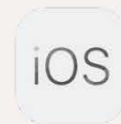
