

Additions and Corrections to the Checklist and Bibliography of Lichens and Lichenicolous Fungi of Insular Laurimacaronesia. III.

Abstract: Additional records of lichens and lichenicolous fungi for either one of the Laurimacaronesian archipelagos (Azores, Madeira group, Canary Islands) or the whole area are listed together with cross references to the original sources. Notes on several previously reported taxa are included. This list is followed by additions to a lichenological bibliography for the area.

Zusammenfassung: In einer Liste werden weitere Nachweise von Flechten und lichenicolen Pilzen für einen der laurimakaronesischen Archipele (Azoren, Madeira, Kanarische Inseln) oder das gesamte Studiengebiet zusammen mit Kurzzitaten zu den Originalquellen zusammengestellt. Eingeschlossen sind Anmerkungen zu einigen früher gemeldeten Taxa. Nachträge zur lichenologischen Bibliographie für das Gebiet bilden den zweiten Teil der Arbeit.

Introduction

Since the publication of a new checklist for the area (HAFELLNER 1995), and two sets of additions and corrections (HAFELLNER 1999, 2002), again many additional records and a number of corrections to previously reported species have been published. These species are listed together with cross references to the original bibliographic sources. Although always complete data sets are given, full references to citations which were already listed in the bibliographies published earlier (HAFELLNER 1995, 1999, 2002), such as 'TAVARES 1952' are not repeated. Further references containing chorological data to taxa previously reported are included in the supplement to the bibliography.

Since the publication of the previous additions 37 additional lichen taxa and 9 further lichenicolous fungi have been added to the list of taxa known in the investigated area 'Insular Laurimacaronesia', and many species have been found on archipelagos on which they were previously unknown. This shows clearly that the compilation of the checklist has fulfilled its purpose to encourage lichenologists to search for additional taxa. Much attention has recently been given to the Azores for which major additions have been published.

A new version of the checklist is planned for the near future which will then make a check more comfortable again.

As in the past colleagues are kindly asked and invited to send copies of hitherto overlooked articles containing data on lichens or lichenicolous fungi from insular Laurimacaronesia to the author.
