THE CIVIL PARISH OF KILBARRON

Kilbarron parish, in Lower Ormond, has three separate burial sites. At the village, in Ballyquinlevan Upper townland. ($\frac{1}{2}$ " O.S. Sheet 15/Grid Ref. R845927), is a new cemetery, but since all the Inscriptions are modern they have not been recorded. The adjoining Catholic Church, called, "the Newchapel", has no memorial inscriptions within its precincts.

Kilbarron Church of Ireland Parish Church is situated in Kilbiller townland ($\frac{1}{2}$ " O.S. Sheet 15/Grid Ref. R835925) a little to the south of Coolbawn crossroads. All the pre-1885 Inscriptions in the graveyard and the Memorials within the Church have been recorded.

The most interesting site, historically, is the so called, "Kilbarron Abbey" ($\frac{1}{2}$ " O.S. Sheet 15/Grid Ref. 820918) situated in the townland of the same name. Although it is designated "Abbey" on the 1840 Ordnance Survey 6" Map, the surviving remains are in fact those of the 15th century Parish Church of the once separate Parish of Kilbarron. An ancient graveslab, perhaps as early as the 10th century, located within the Church now, indicates the Early Christian associations of this site. There are a total of 69 inscribed monuments in this graveyard and all of them have been recorded.

Kilbarron now forms part of the Catholic Parish of Terryglass which is in fact an amalgamation of the three ancient Parishes, Terryglass, Finnoe and Kilbarron. The Church of Ireland Church is presently disused and the Parish is now part of the Nenagh Union.

This 19th century Church and Graveyard, are located in the townland of Kilbiller, on the West of the L 152 roadway, a little to the South of Coolbawn crossroads. In the surrounding Graveyard, the majority of the Inscriptions date to the 20th century and these have not been recorded. All the pre- 1885 Inscriptions have however been included.

MINCHIN

1. Sacred to the memory of John Minchin Esq. of Annagh, who departed this life, April 17 1855, aged 64.
2. Sacred to the memory of Frederick F. Reilly Minchin C.B.E. D.S.O., M.C. who perished on the first attempt ever to fly the Atlantic from England to America, together with Capt. Leslie Hamilton M.C. And Princess Anne of Loewenstien, Wertheim, daughter of 4th Earl of Mexborough 2nd Sept. 1922.

PAWGER

3. In loving memory of John George (Jack) Parker, Brookfield, Co. Tipperary Captain Princess Victoria's Royal Irish Fusiliers. Born April 6th 1865. Died at Bhamo, Upper Burma, Feb. 3rd 1896 of enteric fever. This Tablet was erected by his sorrowing Mother and Sister, whom he dearly loved.

LYON

4. (A Memorial inscription on the stained glass window overlooking the Altar reads as follows:-)
"To the glory of God and in loving memory of Rev'd Thomas Lyon and Anne his wife. Given by their affectionate children."
