New Business:

Ken Bryant discussed a new requirement by International TD for liability insurance for all TD communities. He has made arrangements for that coverage and has given Carol Dorr, Mechuwana Administrator, a copy of the policy.

Beverley Hayward suggested that a pamphlet about TD be mailed to secretaries of various churches to raise interest in attendance at weekends. Because pastors receive so much similar information, she felt that secretaries would be more apt to actually read them and suggest to the pastor that he/she might be interested.

Elisa Sousa has accepted the need to help Brad Van Damm, Website Administrator, with the website.
