



- Particularities of Japanese sacred architecture genesis through the examples of selected Buddhist culture monuments in the Aizu region
- Unique constructions which measurably deviate from the mainstream architectural traditions
  - Keiryuji temple (Tachiki Kannon)
  - Sazaedo tower
  - Aizu-mura complex
- Polytheistic traditions in Japan
- Pervasion of Buddhism to Japan from China and Korea since at least 552 AD
  - 607 Horyuji Foundation in Nara & 6 Nara Schools of Buddhism (Jöjitsu, Hossö, Kusha, Rishu, Kegon, Sanron)
  - Shinto started further development in active coexistence with Buddhism and with mutual influence
  - Some competition with Confucian traditions favored by the powerful Fujiwara clan














