## Rev. Webb Goes To Reepsville

The Rev. Ralph F. Webb Jr., for the past 11 years pastor of the Victory Baptist Church, has resigned to become pastor of the Reepsville Baptist Church of Lincoln county.

Under his ministry in the local church there were many evidences of progress, among these being the increase in annual mission gifts from \$1,805 to 1958 to \$14,625 in 1969. Total annual gifts increased from \$28,943 in 1958 to \$60,412 in 1969. There were 228 baptisms and 318 other additions.

Physical improvements at the church included enlarging and completely renovating the auditorium, building a three-story education building, completely air-conditioning the buildings, buying and paving two lots for parking areas, and erection of a modern four-bedroom parsonage which is debt-free.

The Rev. Webb returns for a second pastorate at the Reepsville Baptist Church where he had an outstanding ministry before coming to Victory. Under his earlier ministry the church was recognized by the Baptist State Convention in the Rural Church of the Year Contest. This congregation extended him a unanimous call to return again as pastor.

A native of Gastonia, Webb is married to the former Merlie Shuler of Gastonia, and they have four children. The Webbs have moved to the parsonage at Reepsville Baptist Church, in the Vale community of Lincoln County.
