We had a wonderful 2022-2023 school year and our current school year is off to great start! Our school is fully staffed with wonderful teachers, our enrollment continues to grow, and there are many new updates to our instructional programs and school facilities. I would like to thank all of our families, alumni, community partners, and staff members who dedicate time and resources to Wardlaw Academy!

Over the last several years, our enrollment has grown by almost 50 percent with our 2023-2024 enrollment at one of the highest in school history. To continue to meet the needs of our growing enrollment and to maintain our commitment to small class sizes, we have committed, highly qualified teachers in all grades for lower school and subject areas for upper school including specialty areas such as Forensics, Genetics, Biblical Integration, Personal Finance, and Computer Science. We are also working with local colleges and universities to increase our dual enrollment options for students wishing to pursue college and technical career classes while in high school. As we begin the new school year, all students will start the year with current edition textbooks, new curriculum resources, and access to updated technology. School safety continues to be a top priority with all exterior fencing installed, secure front entrance with metal security doors, and our safety officer, Officer Morris, returning as our School Safety Officer for the 2023-2024 school year.

The future is bright and we are excited for all the many ways God will bless this special place as we provide a Christian education for students to be a light in our community now and in their future endeavors.



Academic goals were met from 3K all the way to our Senior class. Our athletes also celebrated successful fall seasons and anticipated great victories for our winter sports.


































SPRING FORWARD


