

**Statement of Work (SOW)
For Access to National License Plate Recognition (LPR) Database (NVLS)**

1.0 Introduction & Background

The intent of this Statement of Work (SOW) is to describe the operational requirements of the Fugitive Operations Teams in the Dallas Field Office and the San Antonio Field Offices Enforcement and Removal (ERO) to have access to the National License Plate Recognition (LPR) database server.

The LPR database is a law-enforcement database that tracks vehicle license plate numbers that pass through cameras.

LPR is used by Fugitive Operations Teams to assist in the apprehension of absconders and criminal illegal aliens. Our teams can query the LPR database with license plate numbers and determine where and when the vehicle has travelled. This information helps the Fugitive Operations Teams locate absconders and criminal illegal aliens.

Actions to put absconders and criminal illegal aliens are then put detained in ICE Custody and then removal actions are then initiated on persons in the United States who are amenable to deportation.

2.0 Objective

To provide 24 hour, seven days a week access to LPR for the Dallas, Field Office (b)(7) and San Antonio Field Office (b)(7)e Fugitive Operations Teams in Texas and Sub Offices located in, Oklahoma City and Tulsa Oklahoma. We are currently using this service in the Dallas Field Office and Sub Office's.

3.0 Scope

This contract applies only for LPR service to the ICE-ERO Dallas Field Office and the San Antonio Field Office with identified Sub Offices locations below.
