NOTICE TO AUTHORS

Manuscripts from all parts of the world are welcome, and may be sent to the Editor in confidence. They must be typewritten on one side of the paper, and must be double-spaced. Illustrations should be clearly and simply included. Illustrations should be sent on separate sheets.

Manuscripts should be sent to the Editor in duplicate either to present or to the Editor Emeritus, as indicated on the cover.

Latin names should, unless there is good reason to the contrary, follow the spelling of the latest editions of the maps published by the Ordnance Survey. Localities should follow the spelling in *The Times Atlas of the World*.

Lists of references should be based on the *International Code of Botanical Nomenclature*, 1969, 73-75.

Periodicals should be abbreviated as in the latest edition of the *World List of Periodicals*. Titles of books should be given in full at the end of papers but may be abbreviated in lists of synonyms. Editions other than the first should be indicated.

Examples:

by Watson (1932), (Watson, 1932), or Watson (1932, p. 292).

in list at end of paper: Watson, W. (1932). The bryophytes and lichens of Newland. *ibid.* 20: 284-313.

in a book: Crombie, J. M. (1894). *A Monograph of Lichens Found in Britain*. London.

in a list of synonyms: *Candelariella xanthostigma* (Ach.) Led. in *Hutchings* 23: 196 (1912).

in a book: *Pyrenopeziza lutea* Leight., *British Species of Ascomycotina Lichens*: 65, tab. 1 (1931).
