Our commercial/industrial rates are for non-residential use. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on a commercial rate, if qualified.

02 General (G-1)

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that is greater than 10 kW for three consecutive billing months but not greater than 100 kilowatts in each of 12 consecutive billing months.

06 General Non-Demand (G-0)

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that does not exceed 10 kW in any three consecutive billing months.

51 Optional General Time of Use - Non-Demand (G-6)

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that is less than 10 kW for any three consecutive billing months. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

52 Optional General Time of Use (G-4)

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that is less than 100 kW in each of 12 consecutive billing months. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

62 Large General Time of Use - Secondary Service (G-2)

This rate is for customers with a load that is greater than 100 kW for at least 12 consecutive billing months.

70 Large General Time of Use - 13.8 kV Service (G-3)

This rate is for customers with a load that is greater than 100 kW for at least 12 consecutive billing months. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

Residential RATES

Our residential rates are for domestic use in single private dwellings, individual apartments or in a residential condominium. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on residential rates or any lower commercial rate, if qualified.

01/48 Residential (R-1)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

05 Residential Assistance (R-2)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment. To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill mount.

04/10 Residential Space Heating (R-3)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

07 Residential Space Heating Assistance (R-4)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment. To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.
