


Adolf Henryk Silberschein was a Polish-Jewish lawyer, activist of the World Jewish Congress, Zionist, member of the Polish Sejm (1922–27). During the Holocaust he was a member of the Ładoś Group an informal group of Jewish organizations and Polish diplomats who forged and smuggled illegal Latin American passports to occupied Poland, saving their holders and their families from immediate deportation to German Nazi death camps.

By the end of WWII there were about 30,000 Jewish refugees in Shanghai many of them saved by an extraordinary Japanese diplomat Chiune Sugihara who issued Japanese visas for many Jewish people trying to escape the Nazis. While in Japan the refugees needed Hebrew books and during the period 1943 to 1946 about 80 Hebrew books were printed in Shanghai.

Original wrappers, 24.5cm, 12 pp. 2 holes punched for filing not affecting text, one black smudge near spine. Cmd. 6019. The "infamous White Paper" in which the British Government declared that "it was not part of British policy that Palestine should become a Jewish State."

Sir Winston Churchill delivered one of the greatest speeches of his long parliamentary career against this White Paper. The White Paper imposed severe immigration restrictions. During the next five years Jewish immigration would be limited to 75,000, bringing the Jewish population up to approximately one-third of the total population of Palestine.

After the end of the five-year period no further Jewish immigration



would be permitted "unless the Arabs of Palestine are prepared to acquiesce in it," and the government "will not be under any obligation to facilitate the further development of the Jewish National Home by immigration regardless of the wishes of the Arab population." This White Paper was regarded by the Zionist movement and many outside it as a final betrayal of Britain's obligations to the Jewish people under the Balfour Declaration and the Mandate. The announcement of this policy at the outset of the Jewish mass flight from Europe became the starting point for the active struggle of the Yishuv against the Mandatory regime in Palestine. 




Documents related to J.M. Shaftesly's trip to Germany on 14-21 November 1948. Shaftesley, who worked for the Jewish Chronicle visited Germany as a part of the delegation of the Central British Fund for Jewish Relief in Europe. Among the documents are:

- 2. Notes for delegates going on trip to Germany with the itinerary.
- 3. Correspondence with the Central British Fund for Jewish Relief prior to the departure.

- 5. A typed copy of a letter addressed to General Lucius Clay complaining of his treatment by the Foreign Office and American authorities. That he not being offered the courtesies that press were usually offered and intimating that there was an attempt to sabotage his visit.
- 6. Business cards of 2 members of the Jewish Relief Unit.
- 7. A handwritten letter from Rose Henriques.

This is a complete set of this very important contemporary record of the Holocaust, written and published by Jewish DPs themselves to document crimes and survival in the Holocaust.

Israel Kaplan, the editor (1902 - 2003) was one of the originators of the systematic collecting of testimonies about the Holocaust and the documentation of the grim folklore of the Jews in ghettos and camps. As early as August 1941, with the sealing off of the ghetto in Kaunas (Kovno), Kaplan undertook the assignment to surreptitiously record the goings - on in the ghetto.

Directly following the liberation, he began recording the testimonies of survivors and the collecting of documentation of the Holocaust. Together with M.Y. Feigenbaum, he was among the founders of the "Tsentraler Historisher Komisye" [Central Historical Commission] that operated in conjunction with the "Central Committee of the Liberated Jews in the American Zone" of postwar Germany. Kaplan served as historiographer for the committee. He edited this journal, "Fun Letztn Khurbm" that represented the first gathering of Holocaust material from diverse places, which summed these up in an academic manner. [most of this information is from Ghetto House Fighters Archive]

In the early years of Nazi rule in Germany, the Gestapo would on occasion return to loved ones the cremated remains of family members who had been summarily arrested and then murdered in concentration camps. The Gestapo sardonically forced the bereaved families to pay the financial costs for the duration the

murdered individual was "housed and fed" before death and only then would they return the body. (It was of course impossible to know whether the ashes were indeed those of the specific family member or not).

Throughout history, Orthodox Judaism has taken a very negative view of cremation and is loath to accord honours to the deceased should the remains have been cremated. This stance was by necessity challenged, due to the shocking circumstances surrounding the forced cremation of Jews by the Nazis. In the present pamphlet, Chief Rabbi Kirschbaum ruled that given the circumstances, the German Burial Societies are to place the cremated remains into a coffin together with a talith and tachrichin (shrouds) as if the body were fully intact, in order to affirm the traditional Jewish belief in the Resurrection of the Dead. In paragraph 3, Kirschbaum invoked a letter by R. Markus Horovitz of Frankfurt (author Responsa Mateh Levi) "to our Kehillah," dated 22nd June 1893, expressing leniency toward those unwillingly cremated. R. Kirschbaum reasoned therefore, that such leniency is certainly called for in the present horrific circumstances.

See Y. Rubinstein, Tziyun LeMenachem (1965) for a biography and appreciation of Rabbi Kirschbaum's writings. According to Rubinstein, since Hebrew printing was no longer permitted by the Nazis, the pamphlet was published by the author's brother in Cracow (Poland) with the intention to subsequently distribute it in Germany itself.
