Hollywood Tale

A major motion picture production company has purchased the story of Breana Carsey and MJB Got Faith.

Breana Carsey celebrated a fairytale victory with her baby MJB Got Faith in last year's Ohio Sires Stakes championship for two-year-old trotting colts.

The story reads like a Disney-esque Hollywood fairytale, only it's real. An 11-year-old girl really does own and manage one of the top horses on the Ohio Sire Stakes circuit, one that has made \$279,600. And the tale really did start when she asked her father to buy her a "mommy horse" for her birthday and that mommy horse, who cost just \$1,700, really did go on to produce the very talented trotter MJB Got Faith, who is now three.

So Hollywood didn't create the story, but now a major studio, not to mention an author, is set to recreate it. Brian Carsey, the father of MJB Got Faith's owner, Breana, said that the family has a signed deal with a major production

company to produce a movie based on the MJB Got Faith story and has also been in contact with authors looking to write a biography of the horse and his daughter. The elder Carsey said he was not at liberty to name the studio but said it is among the biggest names in the industry.

The potential of a book and movie about the incredible story of MJB Got Faith are just two of many new twists to the saga, which was first brought to light last year in an exclusive story in Harness Racing Update.

When she was just eight, Breana dreamt of owning a horse, specifically a "mommy" horse. Her father, a small-time breeder and owner, was prepared to buy her one for her birthday but had a budget of just \$2,000 to spend at the Blooded Horse mixed sale in Delaware, OH. When a few that he was interested in were sold for more than he could afford, he reached out to his daughter and she looked at the catalogue and asked him to buy a mare named Imageofasweetgirl, for no other reason other than she liked the name.

The dam was in foal to Trainforthefuture and in 2013 she delivered MJB Got Faith, The "M" is for her sister McKenzie, the "J" for her brother Jordan and the "B" for Breana. "Got faith," has always been one of Breana's favorite sayings, one she used many a time when her father expressed doubts that the horse would ever amount to anything. As a two-year-old, the trotter went five-for-five and made \$192,500 and was named Ohio two-year-old male trotting champion.

The story was picked up by CBS News and it apparently

caught the attention of someone in Hollywood.

"A movie deal is in the works," said Brian. "She has a confirmed movie deal, a signed contract. The screenwriters will be coming to Cleveland (to watch the horse race at

Northfield Park) and get a vibe for the action. I thought things were moving along slowly, but they tell me that for Hollywood everything is moving very fast."

Breana's parents have never interfered with how their daughter managed the horse, nor have they taken any of the money for themselves. Along with trainer Walter Haynes Jr., she plans the racing schedule and decides who will drive the horse. Last year, she was presented with six-figure offers to sell MJB Got Faith and decided on her own to keep him. Brian Carsey said it's been the same with the movie and book negotiations, that Breana is in charge and has spent dozens of hours on Skype discussing plans with Hollywood figures.

"It's very exciting," Breana said of the movie. "I don't want to say it's scary; it's more nerve-wracking. I want people to like me for the same reasons they like me now. I don't want people to like me just because someone is making a movie about me."

What makes the story even more poignant is that Breana donates a portion of the earnings to charity. This year she has made a donation to her school, St. Gabriel in her hometown of Connersville, IN, and she has donated money to help buy equipment and improve the field conditions for her brother Jordan's high school soccer team. She had plans of

buying a farm so MJB Got Faith would have a suitable place to live after he's done racing, but she has become more focused instead on spending her money on charitable



causes.

"I want to put people first, ahead of my own needs," she said.

"My daughter absolutely has not gotten a big head," Brian Carsey said. "I think it's just her nature and her belief that she is doing good for other people. She's stayed grounded through it all. She's hasn't gotten arrogant or complacent."

On the racetrack, things haven't gone quite as well for MJB Got Faith this year as last. He is five-for-11 as a three-year-old and lost his first three races of the year. But he's put it together of late, winning two of his last three, including an Aug. 12 \$40,000 sire stakes race at Scioto Downs in his last start.

Breana said she missed many of his races last year because she couldn't stay up late at night and be expected to go to school the next day, but has found a way to be present for all 11 starts this year.


"I've loved this year because I've gotten to go to all his races and be around him much more," she said. "I think the bond between us is even stronger. I think he knows me and knows who I am. I've been around him since he was a baby and I think he thinks of me like a mom."

Breana used some of her money this year to add to her stable, buying, for \$20,000, a half interest in another Ohio-bred three-year-old trotter named Triumphant's Chip. She gave two-thirds of her share of that horse to siblings McKenzie, 23, and Jordan, 17, so they, too, could enjoy the thrills of horse ownership. She also adopted from New Vocations a 17-year-old named Noble Cam who made \$505,021 in his career, and gave him a safe place to live out his years on a small farm the family owns.

Though just 11, she soon will speak at a meeting of Altrusa Int., a non-profit organization that focuses on community service, literacy, education and environmental issues.

MJB Got Faith's next race will be in the Ohio Sire Stakes finals Sept. 3 at Northfield, where he will look to take home the winner's share of a \$250,000 purse. That would put another \$125,000 into young Breana's pocket and give the scriptwriters a few more pages that will bring to life the real life fairytale of a little girl, good deeds and a good horse.

The Curmudgeon's Baker's Dozen - greatest female trotters

My list of the greatest North American-bred female trotters I've seen race.

This ranking of what I feel are the baker's dozen of the greatest trotting fillies trotting and mares that I have seen, has been my most difficult of the four categories I have ranked.

There are just so many good ones for whom a case could be made.

As with trotting horses, I am restricting my rankings to North American-bred trotting females. If that were not so, great mares such as **Roquepine**, **Une de Mai** and **Ozo** would be shoe ins for the top 13.

As with all the previous categories, honorable mention needs to go to the following which are listed in alphabetical order: Almost An Angel, Armbro Fling, Armbro Keepsake, Buck I St Pat, Cameron Hall, Casual Breeze, Davidia Hanover, Duenna, Elma, Emily's Pride, Flamboyant, Hannelore Hanover, I'm A Lula, Imperfection, Impish, Japa, Kading, Kerry Way, Keystone Pioneer, Maven, Meadow Bright, Merrie Annabelle, Mystical Sunshine, Noccalula, Pampered Princess, Passionate Glide, Peaceful Way, Proximity, Rae, Scenic Regal, Shake It Cerry, Sprite Rodney, Syrinx Hanover and Windylane Hanover.

I'm sure that there are others deserving of mention who I have inadvertently left out. My apologies go to their connections.

Moni Maker (Wally Hennessey) tops the Curmudgeon's list of greatest female trotters of all time.

Here is my list:

1. Moni Maker — She did it all. She was very good at two and three and arguably the best in the world at four and beyond. She held the all-time earnings title until recently. Winner of numerous classic events throughout the world, including the Prix d'Amerique and the Elitlopp. One of my greatest thrills in a lifetime of Harness Racing was watching the World Record under saddle performance by her and Julie Krone.



Continental victory (Mike Lachance) was a close second, according to the Curmudgeon.

- **2. Continentalvictory** Until the advent of Muscle Hill, I felt that at her best, Continentalvictory was the greatest trotter that I had ever seen. Her Hambletonian win over Lindy Lane was a race for the ages. I'll never forget her flagging her tail in that race, which for most horses mean "I've had it." For her it was a signal to bring it on.
- **3. Fresh Yankee** The \$900 wonder. Purchased as a yearling and developed by Sanders Russell for Duncan MacDonald, she reached stardom with Joe O'Brien. This great filly had and did it all. She was a wonderful filly at two and three. She turned into a great International superstar as an older mare and was winner of the Roosevelt International and the Elitloppet.
- **4. Delmonica Hanover** She cost more than four times as much as Fresh Yankee all of \$4,200. She was a world champion at two, three and four. She was an international superstar at four and beyond. Winner of both the Prix d'Amerique and the Roosevelt International.

Mission Brief (Yannick Gingras) comes in at number six.

- **5. Peace Corps** A truly great filly and mare every single year that she raced. All one would need to say is that she won five Breeders Crowns. But there is more, much more. She was an international superstar, and, in the process, she garnered numerous Classics events.
- **6. Mission Brief** Speed wise, she might be superior to those ranked above her. When she was on her game, she was virtually unbeatable. The only edge that those ranked above her have is that with the exception of Continentalvictory who won the Hambletonian, they all went on to become older international superstars. She may get there yet. But time will decide.

The Curmudgeon ranked Bee A Magician (Brian Sears) seventh.

7. Bee A Magician — A dominant filly and mare every year she raced. Horse of the Year and undefeated at three and one of the best older mares in recent times. On occasion she was able to take on and eat the lunches of the boys.

8. Classical Way —
Together with Nan's Catch,
the dam of Moni Maker
and Helicopter, the dam of
Armbro Flight, the only
ones of this group who,

herself was out of a great filly, being out of star mare Kerry Way. A great filly or international classics winner every year she raced. If one had seen her in training early in her two year old season, there would have been no way that one would have predicted her eventual stardom. She was raised at Gainesway Farm where all her buddies were thoroughbred

fillies. They of course, wouldn't trot. All they would do is canter and run. That's all she ever learned to do. So when she went into training that's all she could do. John Simpson Jr., her trainer, instructed his assistant Glydon Willis to just jog her every day until she hit the trot. After five or so miles of cantering, she eventually did. Eventually she realized she was meant to be a trotter and became one of the greatest ever.

- 9. Armbro Flight A great filly each year that she raced. Her battle in the Hambletonian with Noble Victory, ended up with both of them knocking heads and leaving the door wide open for the race to be won by Egyptian Candor. This was most definitely a Hambletonian where the best horse did not win. She is the only one of these females whose dam was a Hambletonian winner and who herself produced a Hambletonian winner in Armbro Goal. Taking it one step further, she is the only one of these trotters who came close to reproducing herself.
- **10. Fancy Crown** One of two Max Hempt-owned prides and joys on this list. Both she and Stenographer were Horse of the Year. Unfortunately neither of them came close to reproducing themselves in the breeding shed. A top filly at both two and three.
- **11. Elaine Rodney** A great filly at two and three here in the United States. She then became a top international star after being sold to Italian interests. As a broodmare she did have one very good trotter named Top Hanover.
- 12. Stenographer The second of Max Hempt's prides and joys. She won the closest battle ever for Horse of the Year, defeating two-year-old champion Scott Frost by only a vote or two. Here's something for you pedigree buffs. Stenographer's dam Follow Me and the dam of the great pacing mare Dotties Pick, Pick Up were full-sisters. Neither Stenographer nor Dotties Pick came close to being the broodmare that they were race fillies.
- **13.** (dead heat) CR Kay Suzie Admittedly, she is this deep in the rankings because of my being prejudiced against trotters who wear hobbles. She was a truly great filly who set world records at both two and three.
- **13.** (dead heat) Grades Singing A very special filly here in North America at two, three and four. She was then sold to European interests, where she was even better, winning classic races throughout Europe.

Air Strike hits the target in ISS action

Air Strike turned in a gritty performance to find the winner's circle on Thursday (Aug. 25) at Hoosier Park Racing and Casino in the featured event of the evening, the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings. Stopping the timer in 1:52.1, the Dylan Fagan trainee made a clean sweep of the third round of the stakes action after an eye-catching maiden breaking victory in 1:51.4 in his elimination last week at Hoosier Park.

A field of 10 lined up behind the gate to do battle and a battle it was from the word go. The 6-5 post time favorite Rock N Tony was given his marching orders from driver Trace Tetrick as he left alertly from post nine to get the first call. On The Virg and Eric Goodell also left for early position from post seven but settled along the rail in second while Air Strike and driver Ronnie Wrenn Jr. protected their rail position and were following along closely in third.

In what would be the first of many lead changes, Air Strike was up to grab command from Rock N Tony just past the half in :55.1. Just as soon as Air Strike settled in on the point, Goodell had On The Virg out and taking aim at the leader. On The Virg was matching strides with Air Strike at the three-quarter clocking in 1:23.3 and as the field turned for home, the race appeared to be wide open.

On The Virg looked to be up to the task but Air Strike wasn't finished. Wrenn Jr. asked his mount for more late in the lane and Air Strike found a :28.2 final quarter to get the win by a head. Dave and Dennis and Tyler Smith employed an impressive late closing burst to get up for second place honors while Meadowbrook Tiger and LeWayne Miller rounded out the trifecta. As the 5-2 second choice, Air Strike returned \$7.60 to his backers at the betting windows.

"Well, the trip didn't work out quite like I thought," Fagan said after the victory. "He's a grinder and that's a great quality to have especially after a busy mile like that. He's a very nice colt and has done everything right since we've had him in the barn."

Owned by Val D'Or Farms and Theodore Gewertz, the son of Always A Virgin—My Best Girl has now won two of five lifetime starts with only one off the board finish. Air Strike has now earned \$53,200 lifetime.

Tioga raises purses 20 per cent

Tioga Downs officials announced this week a 20 per cent across-the-board purse increase, applied retroactively to races from Aug. 19 and effective through the end of the current meet (Sept. 17).

Top-level open purses increase from \$11,000 to \$13,000, maiden purses have been bumped up from \$4,000 to \$4,800, and similar increases occur across all classes.

Tetrick, Miller team up to sweep ISS events

Hoosier Park Racing and Casino highlighted the Wednesday (Aug. 24 card) with a pair of \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes finals and it was Hoosier Park's leading driver, Trace Tetrick, who teamed up with trainer Erv Miller to sweep both divisions. It was the third round of five \$75,000 preliminary finals offered throughout the stakes season for the freshman fillies.

Hah ChaCha made amends for last week's second place finish in the eliminations to pull the 7-1 upset and score in a new lifetime best of 1:53.3 in the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for two-year-old pacing fillies. Tetrick made his game-winning move down the backside and Hah ChaChaCha did the rest to finish two lengths in front of her next closest competitor.

Leaving from the trailing post 10, Hah ChaChaCha settled along the rail in sixth while Amazing Arya and John DeLong were setting the early tempo. Amazing Arya dictated fractions of :26.4 and :55.2 but Jason Dillander had the heavy post time favorite, Firstup, out and firing.

Firstup grabbed the lead just before the third station in 1:24.3, but her lead would be short-lived as Hah ChaCha made a sweeping move to the lead and never looked back. Always Giggling and Andy Shetler staged a determined rally late in the lane but would have to settle for second place honors while Pretty Image and Dale Hiteman were third. Hah ChaChaCha returned \$16.80 to her backers at the betting windows.

"She had to work hard tonight off of that trip," Tetrick said after the victory. "We made a bridle change after her elimination last week and she responded gamely tonight. There was a head wind and the conditions weren't ideal but she raced great."

With the win, the homebred daughter of Always A Virgin—Miss Atm notched her fifth victory from nine lifetime starts. Owned by Shim Racing LLC, Hah ChaChaCha has now bankrolled \$73,313 for her connections.

Coming off the victory in the pacing filly final, Miller and Tetrick were holding a hot hand in the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for two-year-old trotting fillies and Foxy Swan delivered as the 3-5 post time favorite. Foxy Swan solidified her divisional dominance in the two-year-old trotting filly ranks as she scored an easy two-length victory and second \$75,000 final win on the season.

Driving confidently from the start, Tetrick pulled Foxy Swan just past the half and she maintained a clear advantage all the way to the wire. Stopping the timer in 1:58, Foxy Swan used a :29.2 final quarter to hold off a late charge from Doug Rideout and Ajessia. Donnas Dream and Robert Taylor rounded out the trifecta. As the heavy betting favorite, Foxy Swan returned \$3.80 at the betting windows.

"She raced great," Tetrick said. "She got to sit in for a good portion of the trip and was strong all the way to the wire. Erv (Miller) and his team have been doing a great job keeping them sharp all season."

Owned by the Ervin Miller Stable and Anthony Lombardi, the daughter of Swan For All—Fox Valley Click has now won four of seven lifetime outings. With the win, Foxy Swan sent her seasonal earnings over the \$100,000 mark as she has now amassed \$107,286 lifetime.

Chalk dominates NYSS events at Saratoga

The favorites had their way in the New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) on Wednesday night (Aug. 24) at Saratoga Casino Hotel. Freshman trotting fillies took center stage on the card as three divisions of the \$53,500 stakes were featured.

Barn Bella (Conway Hall—Bravissima) was the evening's fastest freshman filly as she scored a convincing 11-length victory in 1:58.1 for Jeff Gregory. The Steven Pratt-trained Barn Bella was her race's 1-9 betting favorite as she dominated her competition en route to her fourth win of the season and third in a row in Sire Stakes action.

Sam Schillaci's Mamora Bay (Chapter Seven—Giulie Bi) had little difficulty scoring in her NYSS division as she trotted to a decisive eight-and-a-quarter length victory in 1:58.2, highlighted by a final half of :57.4. Schillaci trains and drives

the filly who was the 1-9 betting favorite as she cruised to a first over victory, a win that was her fourth in six career starts as a freshman.

The final division of the \$53,500 Sire Stakes wasn't won by the favorite but rather the public's 2-1 second choice in the wagering as Amber Ella (Chapter Seven-Blushed) came on late to record her second straight win in NYSS competition. Hall of Famer John Campbell piloted Amber Ella for trainer Linda Toscano as the freshman filly took advantage of a break by the race's big favorite, Mighty Surf, and trotted past the rest in the stretch to stop the timer in 1:59.4.

Finishing touches to an extensive harness track renovation project at the Shenandoah County Fairgrounds in Woodstock, Virginia are now complete. In recent days, pylons have been placed on the track, safety fencing has been added around the outer perimeter of the half-mile oval and camera towers are now in place.

Several horses tested out the new oval at Shenandoah Downs for the first time Wednesday morning (Aug. 24) and the initial feedback bodes well for the upcoming fair races and the pari-mutuel meet.

"We were pleasantly surprised," said track supervisor J.D. Thomas, who oversaw the \$700,000 renovation along with consultant Greg Coon. "I didn't think it would be as tight as it is. We'll get a couple more horses on the track again tomorrow but overall, I'm very pleased."

Locally-based trainers Betsy Brown and Alvin Lineweaver guided Irish Blessing and Pistol Pete's Dragon respectively during the morning test. "It's exciting to see these improvements," said Brown, who has been competing at the Shenandoah County Fair races since 1990. "The horses could get hold of the track very easily. The surface was great; it wasn't too soft and it wasn't too hard."

Brown said she went two miles in 2:00 or better with two different horses including a trotter named Calcutta, who unofficially covered a mile in 1:59.1. "I've raced at a lot of tracks around the country and this is as nice a half mile track as I've been on."

The 99th Shenandoah County Fair races will be held Aug. 31 – Sept. 3 at 1 pm each afternoon. The inaugural pari-mutuel meet, known as Shenandoah Downs, begins

Four sophomore divisional championships will go to post on Saturday while a four-pack of freshmen title events will be held Sunday. Both opening weekend days will feature free admission, a food truck festival, plus the first 500 fans each day 18 and older will receive a free \$2 betting voucher.


