## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1973**

*Made*           -   -   -           26th January 1973  
*Coming into Operation*           1st February 1973

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a), and now vested in him(b), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1973.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(d), as amended (e), shall have effect as if after paragraph (iii) of Article 5(1)(f) there were inserted the following:—

“and

- (iv) goods falling within the description of manuscripts, documents, archives and photographic positives and negatives, which is set out in the said Group 9,”.
