CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 9) Order 1985

Made - - - - - 16th January 1985
Coming into Operation 16th January 1985

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 9) Order 1985.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1981(c) shall be further amended as follows:

- (i) in Article 2A, after the words "Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 2874/82"(d), there shall be inserted "or Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 61/85"(e);
- (ii) in Group C of Part I of Schedule 1, there shall be added at the end thereof the goods described in the Schedule hereto, which also specifies the relevant tariff headings of the Common Customs Tariff of the European Economic Community and gives, for information, the corresponding NIMEXE Codes(f).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1981. It implements Council Regulation (EEC) No. 60/85 of 9th January 1985 (on the restriction of exports of steel tubes and pipes to the United States of America) and Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 61/85 on 9th January 1985 (of the monitoring by the Community of exports of steel tubes and pipes to the United States of America) by prohibiting the export of the scheduled steel products to any destination in the United States of America or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.

Certain steel products are already subject to control to those destinations under Article 2(viii) of the 1981 Order and Group C of Part I of Schedule 1 thereto (which Group was added by S.I. 1982/1556 and revised by S.I. 1983/1266). The present Order adds further steel products to Group C. It also amends Article 2A of the 1981 Order (added by S.I. 1982/1556) so as not to apply the export prohibition on these further products to an exportation which is in accordance with a European Community export licence issued by the competent authority of a member State in conformity with the provisions of Commission Regulation (EEC) No. 61/85. In the United Kingdom the competent authority is the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry.
