This information will help the police identify the respondent if he or she disobeys the restraining order. Be sure to identify the respondent accurately. The race, sex, and date of birth are required for law enforcement to enter an order on the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN).
- (C) Write in the name(s) and address(es) of the respondent's parent(s), guardian(s), or custodian(s).
