Our thanks to all our trade supporters of these valuable and much appreciated competitions, which are already up and running for 2008.

I am sure readers will be fascinated to read the replies! It is especially rewarding for Diane Mottram's Polish Lowland Sheepdog kennel "Mybeards", that she is Top Breeder overall in 2007. A dream come true, I should imagine for this stalwart breeder of the "Nizziny". But close on her heels, are Stephen and Patsy Hollings, of the world famous Gunalt Weimaraners. Runners up this year, after consistently being at the top of this competition, I should say, "Watch out Diane they will be wanting their crown back!"

Watch out Diane they win be waiting their crown back:

Sh Ch & Aust Ch Hungargunn Bear It'n Mind, was Best in Show at Manchester Ch show in January, picking up his 12th such award. Top Sire overall and Top Dog of 2006 and 2007. Handled by both Murray Armstrong and John Thirwell, owned in partnership by Murray's wife, Kathryn and his breeder Naomi Cragg, this record-breaking Hungarian Vizsla, an Australian import, has had an outstanding career in the UK, culminating in Naomi picking up the Top Breeder title. With 16 points to his credit, Top Puppy overall for 2007 is Serena Parker and Graham Steven's, Beagle, Ch Serenaker Devil In Disguise, who was the recent overall winner of the 2007 Purina Pro Plan 'Pup of the Year' competition.

Top Rare Breed winner with 34 points came from the Working Group. Alex Sutton and Tan Nagrecha's Tibetan Mastiff, Group winning Sierras Yogananda, who was bred in the United States. Three puppies share the Top Rare Breed spot in the Anatolian Shepherd Dog owned by Mr & Mrs V Miles, Kurtkir Kademli, Trish Dean's Estrela Mountain Dog, Asterel Mouse and Mr & Mrs Dickson's Finnish Lapphund Bernavia Taika Kipina. Looking at the Import breeds the Bergamasco from the Pastoral Group has won the Top Imported Register title for the third time. Bautastenen's Elve for Es-

sandsee is owned by Stuart Band and Cindy McCarthy and was bred in Sweden from Italian parents. Top Puppy in this category goes to Smith's Fernwood Diodor, the Russian Black Terrier who ended the year with 11 points.

OP BREEDER overall for 2007 was Diane Mottram with her "Mybeards" Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. A tremendous achievement when you consider there were only fifteen sets of tickets on offer for the breed in 2007.

A modest individual and a real dog lover, Diane started in the breed in 1988, purchasing, along with many other individuals, her foundation stock from the original importer of the Polski Owczarek Nizinny, Megan Irwing, (later Butler). From this firm foundation, Diane bred in her first litter the aptly name Mybeards Pioneer who was the breed's Top Winning Dog in 1992 and 1993. When the breed gained CC status in 1997, he was the first UK Champion, winning a group along the way. Diane has the distinction of owning and campaigning the first Polish champion in the breed, Ch Panicz with Mybeards and to date 26 UK Champions have been bred by this successful kennel.

A tireless and active campaigner for the breed, over the years, she has not been afraid to let "novices" campaign her stock, a policy that has brought dividends to the kennel, as so many have taken top honours. She is honest and forthright in her views, passionate about her breed and optimistic for her the future of her breed. Diane is the official Rescue Co-ordinator for the Polish Lowland Sheepdog in

Q. Diane, before you encountered PLS, were you successful in another breed?

A. I lightly campaigned Beardies prior to PLS and wasn't very successful, however, I always sat watching them in the ring and learnt as much as I could over the years, admiring winning dogs and enjoying my hobby.



Q. What drew you towards the PLS?

A. Following the arrival of the PLS into the UK, I saw a photo of them in the dog press and was immediately attracted to the 'shaggy' look. I then visited National Working Breeds Show where they made their debut

Q. Tell us about your foundation stock and how the bloodlines began to work for you. Why do you think your kennel has been so successful when others who started out at the same time have not been so triumphant.

not been so triumphant.

A. In 1988 I was fortunate to be able to choose from the third litter born in the UK. After deliberating the whole day and listening to Megan Irwing (Megflocks) and Ruth Scott's advice, I decided on Megsflocks Candlelit Flirt, aptly named by Lucy my daughter, as 'Zinny'. Then I spent days comparing her to the interim standard. 'Zinny' was successful from being 10 month old. A black boy, Megsflocks Pied Piper joined us in 1990; he was just the most adorable character and was to become one of the most influential sires in the breed, in the same year Mybeards Pioneer was born. Two 'Ramberhay' bitches from Ruth Scott's Fama Z Kordergardy in Megsflocks, who was an outstanding import, then came to live with us and Megsflocks Saucy Sue, another superb foundation bitch. Over the years I acquired many different bloodlines and I did not have to look round for suitable stud dogs. Being involved in a breed in its infancy has many advantages as one is able to concentrate on the fundamentals without title distraction and then by breeding only from healthy Pons with sound temperaments and construction, as

well as being very critical when selecting show potential puppies, not only for myself, but for those who had approached me, is why I consider my kennel has been so successful. Everyone had the same opportunity when the breed was introduced, and it is strange that in those 23 years no kennel has become as successful as mine. Maybe some people do not have the ability, or prefer to focus on self promotion as the way forward. Sadly, often newcomers are not encouraged to watch and learn but are overshadowed by politics. Other than breeding typical, sound, healthy dogs, I had no goals set and the only reason I became involved with dog showing and breeding was the basic love of dogs.

Q. Did you feel at the beginning that your kennel would be-

come significant within the breed thus breaking records/making history?

A. No, not at all, I bought my first PLS because I really fell in love with them and campaigned because it was a hobby I thoroughly enjoyed. As a family we happened to move to an old farmhouse in the countryside with acres of land which gave the perfect setting for me to have additional dogs. As I became more involved with the breed, it also gave me opportunity to complete another of my am-Q. What imports have you brought in and from where and why?

A. Due to having almost all the bloodlines that had been imported to the UK there was no need to rush and import for the sake of it. Hovahalls Freya of Mybeards (dam of Pioneer) was a Norwegian import of established Polish lines. I continued to study the breed in Poland and Europe, and I was impressed with the temperament and construction of the 'chocolates' and had a litter born in quarantine in 1997. From that litter Panicz with Mybeards became the first Polish import to become a UK Champion. I imported Edi Goral Z Banciarni a very impressive male and more recently a striking male Galant Z Gangu Dlugich from very successful kennels in Poland. There seems to be a trend within some breeds today that if they import, it has to be different, unfortunately many dog folk cannot dif-ferentiate between bloodlines and affixes.

Q. As well as being successful in the showring, "Mybeard" PLS have excelled in other disciplines, for example, obedience, agility, pat dogs etc., Please tell us about these dogs.

A. Most of the puppies I breed go to super 'pet' homes and are not bred from. There are many who do basic obedience and the KC Good Citizen Scheme. However, three spring to mind that show how versatile the breed can be (a) Keith and Sue Brown's Ch Mybeards Treaty of Delphinia, current breed record holder and Ch Group winner, 'Ryker' has not only competed and been placed in beginners and advanced agility competition but also working cart course and (b) Mybeards Digby who has been regularly featured, not only in various dog magazines, but on TV and many other events, with his owner Carolyn Mentieth 'Digby' over the years has won the hearts of many (c) Gina Challoners youngster Mybeards Angel at Renollach will be at the regional S.M.I.R.A conference which is the National Society for the Study of Mutism and 'Angel' will be demonstrating techniques that help selective mute children to begin to speak in public – a very rewarding achievement for both Gina & Angel.

Q. Do you have help with your dogs or do you "do it alone?! A. Working only two days a week I usually 'do it alone' but when

A. Working only two days a week rusuany do it atolic but when needed my family and friends help out. Also Lucy, my daughter, is very capable at taking charge if I am away. She has grown up with the dogs and has now taken over most of the handling at shows.

Q. How do you hope the future unfolds for the "Mybeards"

kennel?

A. This being the 20th year for 'Mybeards' Polish Lowlands, I feel proud to have played a big part in establishing a new breed to the UK. I am very grateful to the owners who waited patiently for show prospects and campaigned them so successfully and the judges who have admired and awarded so many accolades. So, as the breed continues to develop, I hope 'Mybeards' will continue to play a significant part. After exporting only two abroad for showing (both became International Ch), perhaps now is the time to export, as over the years I have been inundated with requests for my lines. Also it will be interesting to develop the bob-tailed and very short tailed lines I have established that will now be more sought after for the show ring. I have two outstanding youngsters, Ch Mybeards Nizinny the youngest to be crowned at 16 month, a Candlelit Flirt great granddaughter who is without doubt one of the best bitches I have bred and Mybeards Domination a puppy who fulfils all the attributes of his famous sire Ch Mybeards Dynamite and is line bred to Pied Piper, there are also some excellent youngsters owned by others already making an impact...

Q What worries do you have for the breed in general?

A The Pon has been well protected from exploitation for much longer than most new breeds; this has been due to responsible breeders and the use of KC endorsements. Unfortunately and mainly due to the internet, we now see a huge change in puppy advertising and sales. I am convinced our breed will join the unfortunates being advertised on commercial sites and in the ad-mag columns in the not too distant future. The Pon is extremely intelligent and wilful, and can become very dominant; in fact they are not one of the popular choices of pets in Poland. Breeders may not have the required





knowledge and many 'pet' dog owners are not always advised or cannot apply sensible discipline. As official rescue co-ordinator for the breed for many years, I only hope we do not have an influx of

Pons that have been unsuitably homed.

Q. Is there any aspect of the breed standard that, given the

opportunity, you would change and why?

A The breed standard is adequate. The docking ban has created a significant change to the outline of the breed and in the interim I am sure tails will be ignored. With all lengths being equally acceptable perhaps in the future a revision to the standard regarding tail car-

age should be considered.

O. What is the best dog book you have read and why?

A. I have read many dog books, but the most enjoyable and interesting for me is a recent publication 'Hairy Moments with the Potterdale Beardies' depicting so frankly, a young couple beginning their search for an ideal family dog, starting to show, and the road to their phenomenal success.

Q. Finally, Diane, if you were starting out in the breed today where would you go, to which kennel (s) for your foundation

A. If the Mybeards kennel wasn't on the map, and now Megsflocks and Ramberhay kennels are no longer breeding, I would have to choose from some of the established kennels in Poland and Europe and I would also seek the advice of one of the most knowledgeable people in Poland Miroslaw Redlicki.

Q. What a tremendous achievement, Top Dog All Breeds for the second consecutive year. He looks a very easy going type of dog so just what is "Yogi" like to live with and handle in the ring? A. "Yogi" is a very easy going, laid back dog great to handle and

live with.

Q. How did you persuade his breeder, Naomi Cragg in Australia, to part with him and send him to the UK?

A. It took some doing! But fortunately, gradually with a lot of patience and perseverance, we suggested she got his rabies vaccinations done ready for him to travel. Even right up to the day he was

due to leave we were not sure he would be coming to the UK.

Q. Why do you think he has done so much winning and how does Kathryn feel about "Yogi" taking the breed CC record from her Ch Kazval Keats?

A. Without doubt, his outstanding movement. He fits the standard fairly closely and on the move he comes into his own. Kathryn has lived with both dogs so she does not mind that Keats' record has been beaten and she is happy that "Yogi" is doing so much winning.

Q. The plans for Yogi to return to Oz have been shelved for the

UK during 2008?

A. Happily, with 45 CCs under his belt we are limited as to the judges we can show under now. His next show is Southern Counties and we will see how the year unfolds.

Q. As Top Sire of puppies in the breed for 2007, what titled/CC winning progeny has he on the ground at the present time and waiting in the wings?

A. In the UK he has six progeny with tickets, three sons on two tickets and two daughters on two tickets and a daughter on one ticket. He is a relatively young sire and hopefully there will be more to come. He does have Champion progeny in Australia and Naomi

does have a big winning dog by him down there.

Q. When the time does come for him to go back home, just how hard will it be for you all to part with him?

A. Obviously it will be very difficult to part with him and it will be a case of who is taking him to the airport. None of us will want to see him go.

O. Serena & Graham, Great excitement for you, how long have you been in dogs?

A. Serena started in 1980 with her first Beagle as a novice junior

handler, and the affix was granted in September 1986, just after she won her first CC. Graham became part of the kennel in 1992 & finally joined the affix in 2002.

Q. What attracted you to Beagles?

A. They are a big dog in a small jacket. They are great fun to live with – you have to have a sense of humour to be owned by a Bea-

Q. From where did you purchase your foundation stock?

A. My first real show dogs came from Marion Hunt (Bondlea) & Pam Williams (Samwella), in fact Samwella Luther was my first champion. We had long admired the Norcis Beagles of Eleanor & Frank Bothwell, and when we decided to buy a bitch to start our line we were lucky enough to persuade them into parting with a daughter of the fabulous Foxy Lady. Gen is behind every Beagle we have in our small kennel, we lost her in January this year - she has left us a fantastic legacy.

Q. Did success come along quickly?

A. From the start in 1980 to my first champion in 1989 is not too long an apprenticeship, I was not however in a position to breed dogs until 1993. We have had a lot of help from our mentors Eleanor & Frank and more recently Christine Lewis, without them we would not be in the position we are now. To be the proud breeder owners of the Top Beagle 2006 and also to win group 3 at Crufts the same year, then follow on with her son as Top Puppy All Breeds 2007 is wonderful achievement for us.

Q. Did Devil in Disguise stand out as a puppy?

A. It was a very even litter and it was a close run thing between Archie and his brother, but Archie just had the "X-Factor". We were also impressed with a little tri girl in the same litter so "Titchy Witch" stayed too along with a T/W girl. Titchy will be campaigned seriously this year after taking a bit of a back seat to her brother in 2007.



Q. What qualities make him such a top winner?

A. His clean lines, handsome head and expression, good breed type and of course his personality plus. However it is his sound driving movement that captivates most judges. One top all rounder's recent critique says "He just spells a top quality Beagle, a great advertisement for the breed and his front assembly and action are

Q. What plans do you have for 2008 with regards to carrying on campaigning him?

A. He will be campaigned along with his sister at the highest levels in 2008. One thing that would be nice is to win a group with him, that is the one thing that has eluded our small kennel in this country, although his mother Devil Woman did win the group at the IKC's St. Patrick's Day show in 2006.

Q. Do you have a policy when breeding from your stock?. For example do you line breed or out-cross or use a combination?

A. Our lines were closely linebred through Fallowfield Douglas and Norcis Gen to Norcis Murphy's Law. We needed to drop size in our hounds and so opted to use a super sound, lovely sized American Champion dog that had just been imported by Christine Lewis.

Q. What aspects of the breed standard would you change if you were able to and why?

A. More emphasis should be put on quality & soundness, Beagles that move with reach and drive are a joy to behold. Also we are tending to lose that true Beagle expression, the one without wrinkle that should just melt you.

Q. Any advice to pass on?

A. Always start off with the best dog you can, from the bloodlines you admire and be prepared to wait until you can get what you

want. Be honest with your own stock, if your long awaited for litter, the apples of your eye are not as good as their parents then let them go and start again. It is heartbreaking to do, but worth it in the long run. Take advice from the well-respected, elders in your breed, they have a lot of knowledge.

Q. Was your puppy the result of line breeding or is he from an open pedigree?

A. He is sort of line-bred. His dam, Ch Ragus Truly Unruly (Top Brood Bitch in the breed for three years and Top Terrier in '06) is by a US champion. I sent her, in whelp, to Sweden and she came back to me, in whelp to Swedish Ch Cobbys Famous Rebel, al-Swedish Co Tooby's Famous Rebel, athough now an old dog, he has been the Top Sire in the breed in Sweden for many years. He is from "Old English" breeding in the fourth generation are some of my own Ragus dogs.

Q. When was he born and did his quality stand out from the

beginning?

A. He was born on 1st October 2006. Yes it did certainly in terms

of his beautiful head and super expression.

Q. Do you think that CCs attained under 12 months of age should count towards the title of Champion?

A. No, it is not a good idea really but depends upon the breed as some mature quite quickly. For example, with "Rings True", he won his first CC at nine and a half months and he had four CCs under twelve months of age. His crown came at LKA when he was four-teen months old, winning the Group as well.

Q. What is it about your puppy that makes him a winner and is he the best you have bred?

A. He has a beautiful head and true Norwich expression. That is what everyone comments about! What makes it so correct is that he has small, dark eyes, set back in the head. He has general all round good looks, correct conformation and out standing breed type, with a short back and short legs. When he gained his title at LKA last year, under Terrier Specialist, Sue McCourt (Sillhill), her comments said it all really, 'Read the standard, see the dog!' He was Best in Show, at the club show's 75th Anniversary, with the biggest entry, including dogs from abroad. It is especially rewarding that he has a great following in the breed and on his first birthday last year, he actually received six birthday cards! He compares favourably with my Ch Ragus the Devil's Own who won 10 Groups and was three Q. Please tell us a little about your history. For example, how

long have you been in dogs?

A. My father Hugh Bunting kept St Bernards and did breed a champion which was no mean feat in those days, but he gave up

when we children came along. He was an excellent groomer and grounded me in presentation and grooming. I also watched and learnt from other people in other breeds, and when I was about 11 or 12 he told me that he wouldn't be doing the dogs in future as he could not better my presentation and grooming skills! My mother, Marjorie Bunting, (together with her mother Grace Marks,) was the founder of the Ragus kennel of Norfolks, Norwich. She was from a journalistic background, as both her father and her eldest brother had held senior editorial positions. A great personality, a prolific if at times, controversial writer, she was a very good breeder and very good at picking puppies. At five years of age, I had my first Champion (in my own name), handled of course by my mother, a Norwich bitch that was my mother's first champion in the breed. I remember going to Windsor Ch show on my own, about 1964, I would have been about 13, and I won the dog CC and Best of Breed and the reserve bitch CC and Best Puppy. The judge was the late, great Fred Cross, father of Pamela Cross-Stern. Windsor has been a lucky show for me as I have had two Best in Show wins there. My late husband Michael Crawley had bred over 30 Champions in the three breeds, Norwich and Norfolks and Australian Terriers and I often handled his dogs.

Q. Have you anyone to thank for your success or have you done it alone?

A. I have to thank my parents for the excellent overall grounding that they gave me

Q. Finally Lesley, after 109 champions, including best in show

winners and nine group winners, what really motivates you?

A. The challenge of new puppies. Waiting, watching the litter, learning about the puppy etc. I just love exhibiting puppies. I get bored quite easily and like to bring a new puppy out.

Q. Patsy and Stephen your kennel has been enormously influential in the breed, as you not only campaign top quality stock yourselves, but you sell round the ring to other exhibitors. What promoted you to be "so generous" and spread your success around?

A. We are breeding for the breed, our hope is to preserve the breed, we strive for soundness, good temperament, after all most puppies end up in first time owners hands, who want a dog as part of their family, we feel this is a great responsibility to dogdom generally, so we hopefully produce puppies that can enhance the lives of the owner, be it in the ring or pet home. We find it immensely satisfying that novice owners can go in the ring and win.

Q. What is the secret of your success? Have you followed a

Q. What is the secret of your success? Have you followed a polity of line breeding, out crossing, putting like to like regardless of pedigree etc.,

A. We thrash ideas between us, never feel content and always try to improve. We study pedigrees but now more on instinct than on paper, are careful to keep the standard in mind and the health of the breed, one of the reasons for joining the KC Accredited Breeders Scheme, which, OK, is perhaps not perfect but certainly trying and going in the right direction.

Q. You keep a large kennel of dogs, so how do you maintain harmony with them all and how much exercise do they get in a day?

Å. We have a purpose built field just outside the house and through our thought on temperament we manage to have dogs com-



fortable to live together in harmony. Also we, being animal folk, treat our dogs with love and respect and understand that they are ANIMALS not human. We are pack leader. The dogs have free run in the paddock and are taken up through the land here two or three times a day which gives interaction with humans, learning manners various disciplines, i.e. learning to stand whilst all the others are dashing around. This is great to watch movement and confidence, all helping with thoughts on future breeding plans.

Q. Is there any aspect of the breed standard that you would

Q. Is there any aspect of the breed standard that you would change and if so why?

A. We would hope the standard remains as written, not changed by fashion. One needs to remember the wording not try to manipulate it to suit the dogs produced. The words *athletic, sinewy* spring to mind, we as fanciers, should be aware of the breed becoming too cart horse and clumpy, instead of the racehorse.

Q. From a judging perspective, what feature of the breed, most confuses novice judges?

A. This is not the square dog of some of the gundog breeds; he should be longer in rib. Also the standard calls for slightly longer middle toes, not the cat like foot. His head is distinctive and the set of the ear, which determines the fold of the ear. Novices often get hung up on colour, perhaps they should study construction. Because of a good mix of all rounders and specialists we have a soundly constructed breed.

Q. What stock will you be campaigning in 2008 and are you still motivated?

A. We have Sh Ch Gunalt Contradiction, not yet two years and some very promising youngsters both here and in other hands that should be making their mark this year, watch this space!



O. What is the secret of your success and why do you think

your kennel has made such a lasting impression on the breed, not only in this country but all over the world?

A. By starting with the best that we could buy and also being lucky enough to find someone who was honest in her dealings with us. Then by continual line - breeding with the stock that we had. It may not apply to all breeds but Akitas need to be line-bred to produce type. We also have a policy of selling the best we possibly can when exporting and we have built up an excellent reputation for doing this.

Q. What stock are you campaigning for 2008?

A. We will probably still campaign a couple of the champions, but as far as youngsters are concerned, we'll have to wait and see. We never like to rush them, if they're not ready then they won't come out. We don't believe in showing a puppy just because it's six months old, "Heaven Can Wait" was 11 months old before we

showed him and 37 CCs later!!

Q. Do you ever see a time when you will retire from the ring and leave it to other breeders?

A. There are probably quite a few people waiting with baited breath for this answer!! But right now our commitment is just as great as ever and we can all still just about run round the ring, so e're here for a bit yet anyway!

Q. If you were starting up now, from which kennel(s) would you purchase your foundation stock?

A. Ourselves!! Seriously though, it is a very difficult question. All the original serious breeders in the USA have gone and it's very hard to find someone who is honest in their dealings. We have been extremely lucky in that our lines are relatively problem free from health issues and this is of main concern to us. We think this is an area which needs serious consideration by some of the people in the

OUR DOGS Top Breeder Competition winner in the Hound Group 2007 Roberta Hall Saxonmill Afghan Hounds Q. Roberta, for a small kennel you must be delighted with

your 2007 campaign. What are your highlights and what are your plans for 2008?

A. My efforts and dedication to the breed culminated during 2007 achieving Number 1 and 2 Afghans in the UK, BIS at a general Championship show and top brood bitch ALL BREEDS both lifetime achievements. Certainly a year to remember and difficult to follow! Saxonmill Afghans won 21 CCs and numerous Reserve CCs throughout 2007, a new Champion was crowned giving me 15 Champions owned or bred, six consecutive generations of Afghans carrying the Saxonmill affix and multiple CC and Reserve CC winners from just seven litters.

My plans for 2008 are to campaign my current show team and breed with my Champion bitch Ch Star Struck (Top Bitch 2006/07 and UK number 2 Afghan 2007) at the end of 2008.

Q. When planning your matings do you have a policy, i.e. linebreed, out cross etc.

A. My Afghans to date result from line-breeding with outcrosses at the appropriate juncture. Ch Jellicle Jett, the Top Brood Bitch all breeds 2007 is very line-bred and the two litters she has produced were both to outcross males but of a similar phenotype. These litters have been very successful resulting in 44 CCs, around 40 reserve CCs and five Champions to date.

O. Afghans have changed so much in the last couple of

decades, what made you stick firmly with your type and carry

A. Afghans may have changed but the standard has not. I felt mine conformed to the standard and are also of a type I like and have a show temperament too. They have been successful so I saw no reason to change only to build on the points I had and improve wherever possible.

Q. Is there any aspect of the breed standard that you would

change, given the opportunity?A. The breed standard is as it is and my main critiscism is that it lacks in detail of explanation, particularly where fronts and movement are concerned. It leaves too much to open interpretation. The only change recently has been to include a reference to scissoring/clipping and it's a pity that the effort that went into securing this change was not put in to clarify and explain other points rather than focussing on coat alone.

Q. From a judging point of view, what feature of the breed is often misunderstood by novice judges? A. Novice judges do not have as much opportunity to handle a

good number of dogs. Open show entries are dire and Championship show entries are falling. There are few real breeders left so the experience that used to be passed on from our more experienced people is not generally available to the novice. I do very much believe in the training that is now available and try and participate in that as much as I can but there is no substitute to living with good quality dogs and also talking to experienced breeders from all breeds. Shoulders and front assembly have always been a difficulty along with being able to differentiate between correct and 'flashy' move-ment. Also there is often a tendency to focus on individual points rather than viewing the animal as a whole package.

Q. Have you any advice to pass on?

A. My 2007 has not just been for me, it's been for every small dedicated breeder who remains true to themselves and their breed. All I would say is that it may have taken sometime to reach these accolades but it's been worth every minute of it and I feel that my dedication and hard work with my dogs has now been fully recognised.



Q. What attracted you to ETTs in the first place?

A. We were looking for a Toy Dog that would interact well with our Whippets and originally chose Italian Greyhounds. Whilst we enjoyed some success in the show ring we also had a lot of heartache with 'broken legs' with the very dainty Italian Greyhounds and decided they did not fit in well with our particular countryside lifestyle. We decided we needed a hardier breed and Mary & Roy Wilson's famous, Ch Amalek You Has Jazz, became our inspiration to buy our first ETT. Having been attracted to her type and soundness of movement compared to others we had seen we naturally approached the Wilson's for a puppy. In February 2000, Amalek A Fine Romance with Witchstone joined our family and became our first ETT cham-

pion. Q. Have you even surprised yourselves with the success of

your kennel in such a short space of time.

Andrew is the 'brains' behind the breeding programme and would be fair to say there was always a master plan. That said, if we had not been allowed to purchase the best bloodlines in the world we would have not enjoyed such rapid success. We are indebted to Mary & Roy Wilson (Amalek) for sharing their 'magic mating' with us, in particular for allowing Ch Amalek I Got Rhythm, to come to Witchring (16 CCs, 9 Res CCs & Group 4 at Crufts) he is the foundation of our breeding programme. He is probably still the most impressive ETT on the move we have ever seen with a near perfect 'extended trot' and still perfectly sound at nine years of age. The late Garry Freeman (Partytyme) together with Ron & Linda Spooner (Ani-malhouse) also made the history books when they allowed us to purchase and import Ch & Am Ch Animalhouse Partytyme Moe from the USA. We hand-picked Moe from over 120 dogs entered at the three day Toy Manchester Terrier Speciality in held in May 2002. He was just 12 months old and after spending six months in quarantine he became the first USA import to gain his Champion title on both sides of the Atlantic taking his UK title with BOB at Crufts 2004. Before he passed away, Garry Freeman (Partytyme) kindly entrusted us with the detailed research behind his breeding programme and gifted Am Ch Animalhouse Athena to us to support and further develop our UK plans. Ch Amalek I Got Rhythm was the breeds Top Sire in 2003 and 2007 and Ch & Am Ch Animalhouse Partytyme Moe was Top Sire in 2004, 2005 & 2006.

Q. What policy do you adopt when looking to mate a bitch and would you do close matings i.e brother sister, mother to son, father to daughter etc?

A. When choosing a stud dog we look at the bitch and decide what we are trying to improve. We then look at the stud dog and assess his virtues. We then look at the ancestry on both the sire and dam's side of the pedigree.

We most certainly do agree with 'close matings' as you will see from our pedigrees. That said, only when there is a longer term plan and when we are confident that the outcome will improve the breed. We have never taken a 'heads in the sand' approach with regard to health issues and would have potential hereditary health issues at the top of our agenda when considering close matings. The cliché of 'build a house on sand...' certainly applies in dog breeding. The Wilson's had very carefully selected and combined the best bloodlines from the UK, Australia and New Zealand and tested their stock for patella luxation. We were therefore confident that mating 'brother to sister' would work. We produced the 'twins' Ch Witchstone Kickin Up A Storm and Witchstone Storm In A Teacup. This degree of in-breeding under-pinned the foundation already created by the Wilson's and allowed us to outcross completely to the US import to improve type further without losing what had already been reated. It is fair to say that we were surprised to get such 'record breaking' stock in the first generation outcross – Champions Party Politics (Top ETT 2005 & 2006), Changeofheart, Heads or Tails and Telling Tails (Top ETT 2007).

Having out-crossed, we had always planned to line breed back to 'Rhythm'. The first puppies resultant puppies were shown from Summer 2007 and both enjoyed immediate success winning RCC's, BPIS at the Club Ch Show and the Toy Puppy Group at South

Wales. Q. What, if anything, would you change about the breed standard and why?

We judge and breed to the UK breed standard and feel it is fine in most respects; so long as breeders stick to the standard. Our pet hate is that the standard says the head should be long and narrow with a flat skull yet so many are shown and used for breeding with short muzzle, round skull and bulging eyes. Given the size of the breed's gene pool we do believe the best stock should be kept for breeding not the smallest stock which appears to have been the case in years gone by. We also think the breed would benefit greatly from being re-classified in to the Terrier Group alongside its cousin the Man-

Q. Do you wish the breed were more popular with the public?

Q. Do you wish the breed were more popular with the public?

A. I think the breed is already gaining in popularity due to the promotional work the committee has done and the success and profile the breed has enjoyed within the show ring in the highest level. The breed can have one or two health issues which do occur regularly. Our concern would be that if the breed increased rapidly in popularity breeders would 'cash in' - irrespective of the consequences. Thankfully, there have only been four dogs in Breed Rescue in as many years. That said, with diligent breeding and the correct addition and organize support an ETTE can make a furtastic set. correct advice and ongoing support an ETT can make a fantastic pet.

Q. What are your plans for 2008 and what stock are you cam-

paigning?

A. An exciting array of puppies are due to debut in 2008. We have sold a number of puppies to show homes (experienced and newsoid a number of pupples to show nomes (experienced and new-comers) and we will be supporting them with throughout the season. Our show partner, Sian Gordon, has a very exciting young dog, Witchstone Free's A Crowd, who took one CC and two RCCs as a puppy last year and will be campaigned in 2008. We have a number of last year's bitch pupples who we hope will progress toward their titles this year. Sian has two new puppy dogs which we will be

jointly campaigning. We have kept a very exciting bitch puppy ourselves out of Ch Witchstone Telling Tails (sired by Rhythm) who will debut in the summer. Having only been shown seven times in 2007 (with the CC & BOB every time and Top ETT title to her name) it is also likely that Ch Witchstone Telling Tails will make selected appearances throughout the year.

Martin & Jay Horgan Aritaur Dobermanns OUR DOGS/PEDIGREE Top Breeder Competition

Q. How long have you been in the breed?

A. Having grown up with gundogs and hounds at the local hunt, Jay wanted a dog with some 'workability and an ability to concentrate' and bought her first Dobermann 27 years ago. Martin grew up with a Dobermann and various terriers, and from this background came a mutual interest in obedience which we have both continued. Jay qualified as a BIPDT trainer last year and is currently working on her KCAI accreditation. Martin successfully works two dogs in the sport of Schutzhund and is a qualified track layer with the GSDL Working Branch

Q. Where did we purchase our foundation stock?
A. After becoming lightly involved in showing with our founda-A. Arter becoming ingitive involved in showing with our ioundation bitch Crislea Centrefold of Aritaur, we had a litter from her for 'just one more'! Juno was very tightly bred to Ch Holtzburg Mayhem, Top Stud Dog All Breeds in 1993, & Top Dobermann Stud Dog from 1991 – 1993. She was a strong and immensely stylish bitch with great nobility, super character and excellent movement from all angles, so when we bred her, the only difficulty was find-ing a dog good enough.

Q. Have you a policy of line breeding, out crossing or a combination?

A. All three methods have their benefits, although the majority of UK breeders have tended to favour line breeding. After out-crossing already with Crislea Centrefold of Aritaur to Ger VDH Ch Ramonburg's Valdo to produce Aritaur Dominatrix (Top Brood Working Group 2007), few could understand why we then made a further outcross with Dominatrix to the Russian Multi Ch Tamerlan iz Slavnoi Stai. Due to the success of the 'H' litter, he became Top Stud Dog in the breed 2007.

Our initial evaluation is for phenotype combinations, for any improvements we may require, and then review the genotype for ancestry considerations. As a young kennel with just ten years breeding, and an average of two litters a year, we have brought fresh genes to blend with British angulation, American elegance and the substance and heads of the Europeans. It has certainly worked well

Q. Do you have any worries about the breed at the present

In comparison with dogs around the world, the UK Dobermann is in a very healthy state. The overall character of our breed is good, and with the influx in recent years of good European blood, backs are stronger, and there are fewer broken top-lines and high withers. Heads are greatly improved with good fill in under the eye, longer muzzles and stronger under-jaws. The 'British' Dobermann has always excelled in angulation but the overdone fore-chests causing wide front movement are becoming less acceptable.

Q. Do you keep a large kennel or are you limited in what stock ou can have? We are currently at 11 dogs, which is far too many, but we don't

move on our old dogs once they are finished breeding or showing, and we are both at home most of the time, so the dogs get plenty of individual time and exercise.

Q. What is the best dog book you have ever read and please

explain why?

We focus on the Volhard training philosophy and recommend 'Dog Training for Dummies' by Jack & Wendy Volhard for a fundamental understanding of 'drives' and what motivates dog behaviorals in Translation by Temple iour. I would also sneak in - Animals in Translation by Temple Grandin and Cesar Millan's new book, Cesar's Way.

Since 1999, Julia, with her husband John, have bred 8 UK Champions, two of which are Swedish Champions. One of those Champions, Ch Swanndale Lord of the Rings, is now also an International Champion. Her first Heeler was bred by the late Norman Johnston (Doddsline) this dog being Doddsline Lord of Swanndale. He is a producer of Champions and produced a litter for Julia consisting of three dogs. All three of these Heelers became Champions, Ch Swanndale Black Tulip and Swe Ch Swanndale Black Baroness of Limebroke - this is the first time that a full litter of Heelers has become Champions.

Julia is passed to awards CCs in Lancashire Heelers and also her first breed, corgies, in which she had the breed under her then prefix Ken-peth. She has been involved in the breeding and showing of dogs for

over forty years.

'I have judged the breed at Crufts in 2003, I have also judged the Swedish Club ch show with a record entry and I am also on the judging list for corgies in America,' she tells me.

Breed record holder

Julie currently owns and has bred the UK Breed Record Holder, Ch Swanndale Man In Black – Cash (Ch Jestikka Glenord ex Ch Swanndale Black Orchid), with an amazing 23 CCs. Cash's grandmother Ch Foxthyme Material Girl, held the Breed Record previously with 19 CCs. Swanndale dogs have gained 65 CCs and as Julie explains, 'Being a minority breed, people would think that it is easy to achieve what we have. I strive to promote the love of the breed and I have given many seminars on the breed, for the general interest for enthusiasts. All that I aim to do, is to continue supporting the breed and be a respected breeder'. Talking to Julia, surrounded by all the Lancashire Heeler models, paintings and awards, I asked her if there was anything she would like to achieve in showing dogs that she hasn't already done. 'There is only one thing that I would love to achieve and that would be to win a Group 1 at a Ch Show. My own Ch Swanndale Man In Black has been pulled out eight times in the group and is yet to be placed, however, three of my other dogs have achieved a Group, 2, 3 and 4. Cash is by far the best Lancashire Heeler that I have bred. We have also won the double at Ch Shows on eight occasions!

This month, Julia is expecting a litter from Night Sky, and this will be Julia & John's 5th/6th generation of Swanndale Lancashire Heelers.

Q. Why do you think your Mindlen Kennel has been so successful?

We feel we have been very lucky, this past year because we have been able to produce for the show ring a number of dogs which judges thought were worthy of top honours.

We try to be very honest about the dogs we have and to know their faults and strive to improve them.

In our breeding programme we only breed with stock which we consider to be able to pass on good quality puppies and as a small kennel we tend only to breed when we are looking to keep something for ourselves.

In the show ring we always try to have our dogs presented to their wn advantage and work hard to teach them their job.

Q. What has been the most difficult feature to get right in the

Two characteristics come to mind firstly getting the size and balance correct for the breed and secondly temperament. As all our dogs come into the house and live as part of the family it is essential they are amenable with each other. Although we do not want to loose the true terrier temperament they must be able to live with each other.

Q. If there were anything you could change in the breed standard what would it be and why? We would change the size clause which was added to our standard

several years ago the standard reads - 'Most importantly a working terrier should be capable of being spanned behind the shoulders by average sized hands. Ideal height at withers: dogs 36 cms (14 ins.), bitches 33 cms (13 ins.) It is recognised that smaller terriers are required for work in certain areas and lower heights are therefore quite acceptable provided that soundness and balance are maintained.

We feel the last sentence has caused a lot of confusion in our breed just at a point when we were establishing a certain type and size was more uniform we find it is very difficult of get a smaller dog with the same balance and breed type. Although I do agree some are getting on the tall side any thing smaller than 12" is not a Parson.

Q. What advice would you give to a newcomer in your breed?

Look into the breed and be sure that this is the breed for you not all families can cope with a lively terrier. It is essential go to shows an fairnines can cope with a fivery terrier. It is essential go to shows to see what lines and type you prefer; then be prepared to wait for the right dog for you. Not many breeders have ready made show dogs or puppies with show potential available, straight away.

When you get your puppy make sure you socialise it well and take it to ring craft classes. Present it as best you can and don't be put off

if you are not winning firsts every time. Be honest about your dog, listen to constructive criticism and don't be afraid to ask for ad-

dog, insen to constructive criticism and don't be airfaid to ask for advice - the perfect dog is yet to be born.

Q. What are your plans for 2008?

We have just imported a dog from the USA and will be campaigning him this year. Am Ch Posey Canyon Jim Dandy is the first US import to appear in the ring he will be making his debut at

Q. What is the best dog book you have ever read and why?

There are two books which we like the first is Sheila Atters Jack Russells Today. I think it is packed with lots of information for the Parene when its theory was read and why the propose of the property of the prop

A. Sinbad comes from a particularly strong bitch line including three of our homebred champions. This enables him to pass on a distinctive type and a wonderful people-loving temperament, a must in Rottweilers

Q. Does he have any Champion progeny in the ring?

A. Sinbad at only three is still young in stud dog terms, a son and daughter each won their first tickets in 2007 both whilst under two and he has many young winning progeny waiting in the wings.



Q. Did "Careless Spirit" or "Troy as he is called, stand out as

a puppy and what age was he exported to Holland?

Q. Sue, you made the transition from a very successful Skye Terrier kennel to Australian Terriers with apparent ease. Where did you start for your foundation stock?

A.Through my dear friend Richard Allen, who had a new client with Australian Terriers this client was Miss Sheila Stoddart. Sheila and I became friends, I started to become interested in the breed and of course I had known Paul Eardley and his mum Sheila for a long while. When Sheila (Millvalley) had an eight month red bitch who was quite shy she asked me if I would take her and try to get her to show. We have more training classes here than in Berwick, I agreed. Sheila registered her in our joint names, and than gave her to me as a gift, which I can never thank her enough for as Rosie is my constant companion. This foundation bitch is Champion Millvalley Monopoly at Silhill she won 13 CCs a group 1 and a group 2 the first red bitch to win a group she was top Australian Terrier for two years and is the dam of Silhill Tufty a POTY qualifier, Silhill Scruples and Silhill Solitaire at Bethane who have all won Best Puppy awards at championship shows during 2007. When it became time for me to find a suitable dog to mate her to, the only dog I really liked was her sire so I had to look further a field. Paul had given me a book about Aussies in Australia and I knew that the type of dog I wanted for Monopoly was from the Tahee lines. These where owned by Mrs Pam McDougal who no longer bred dogs. Out of the blue Paul was offered a dog from our friend in Finland Marjo Ahola of the famous Bluepepper kennel this young dog was a Tahee son. He came over to the UK and Rosie came into season one week later. I felt that the gods where smiling on me, I do believe in fate. That mating produced Silhill Red Hot Poker and Silhill Limited Edition at Wyeavon. Poker became top puppy the following year and Limited edition has one CC to his credit so far.

Q. Which aspects of the breed have you found hardest to fix,

for example, heads, tails, coat, movement etc.

A. Since I have only been in this breed six years I would not presume to say I had altered anything, I am however VERY concerned about health issues. There is a small amount of epilepsy and diabetes in the breed, so far none of my stock has shown any signs. of developing any of these illnesses. If we are honest as a breed and admit when we have a problem and do not breed from that dog or bitch we can stand up with our heads held high. That is my aim to breed to type but also healthy, happy Aussies.

Q. Did Ch Silhill Red Rock at Sherex stand out as a puppy?

Are you suprised at just how much winning he has done

A. Red Rock, Ayers as he is known here, was one of 10 puppies A. Red Rock, Ayers as he is known here, was one of 10 pupples nine survived and for the first four weeks where like peas in a pod. As the pups grew this fat red dog puppy just stood out. He had at six weeks such a stance he drew my eye to him and as he got older he just got better, he was however a bit different to the other puppies, certainly in his expression. I do not think that at eight weeks old you can say with certainty that a puppy is destined to be a champion but you can hope Ayers dam Ch Millvalley Styled in Red for Silhill was a gift to me from Paul Eardley and I had always promised him a puppy when she was mated. When Paul and his mother came to see blue and tan dog. I still preferred Ayers. When it came to see the litter which they did at regular intervals they had their eye on a blue and tan dog. I still preferred Ayers. When it came to the time to let some of the pups go they still liked the blue and tan dog so I explained that they could have which ever pup they wanted but if they did not take this red dog puppy I would keep him myself but that would mean showing him against their choice. Paul said I was so adamant about Ayers he gave in and chose him. As he grew I just had this feeling that he was special he could never stand wrong he had attitude, he carried himself well and moved so soundly. I also kept 2 of his sisters One Ch Silhill Glitzn'Glamour became a Ch before Ayers and the other Silhill Sweet Pea is sitting on two CCs. A very nice litter indeed. I am still amazed at what a wonderful year Red Rock has had and to win such top honours under such well respected judges, I am so very proud of him. As I write this I am looking out at him and his sister playing in the paddock quite unaware that he is a history maker for the breed. Thank you so much to ALL of the judges who havethought so highly of him and to Richard Allen for making sure He always looks perfect and correcting any mistakes might make with the knife and to Paul for his wonderful handling of this special dog.



Q. His success has been tremendous. Best in Show at SKC in 2007 and BIS at National Terrier 2007and sixth overall inthe Top Dog All Breeds competition for the year, what is it about him that makes him such a super specimen?

A. He is a real show dog, he has ring presence, always shows him self of to his best advantage, never lets you down and he seems to raise his game as he progresses from breed class to BOB then onto the group and then into the final 7. He fits the breed standard so well and moves with drive and enthusiasm and although it is hard work I roll his coat so he has never been out of coat, In fact we had such bad weather prior to Manchester I got up at 6-ooam to wash his furnishings and boy did it pay off. If Ayers was a person he would be

your best friend.
Q. What plans have you for 2008 and who will you be campaigning?

A. Well we have had a wonderful start to the year with Silhill Tufty with Sherex being shortlisted in the last 10 at the POTY competition, first time for an aussie. Then of course Reserve best in show at Manchester under the very well respected Mr Ellis Hulme what better start could we ask for.

I will be campaigning Ayers children this year especially Silhill Tufty with Sherex and his sister Silhill Scruples and also Ayers sister is still chasing that elusive third cc
Q. Do you miss your Skye Terriers and what is the difference,

besides the obvious ones of course, between the two breeds?

A. How could I not miss the Heavenly Breed I gave thirty- odd years of my life to them. a good well presented Skye still makes my heart flutter. When I was in Finland judging them last year at the club show I fell in love with a young cream bitch and did tentatively ask if she was for sale perhaps it was fate that the owner wanted to keep her as I know only to well that it takes two and a half hours to prepare one and with all the wet weather we have had this year, I ask myself could I have coped? The main difference I notice about the two breeds is that the Skye is very discerning about who it will choose as it's friend Aussie are an intelligent dog but will normally greet most people with a warm welcome and Boy they are a lot lighter to lift. They do need constant grooming to keep them in top class show condition but they have captured my heart and I just know that my late husband Will would have been so proud of the success that the Silhill Aussies have enjoyed during 2007.

Q. Fiona, another cracking year for the Kanix Bouviers, who will you be campaigning in 2008?

will you be campaigning in 2008?

A. In 2008 we will continue to campaign Freya as she is only two years old. Unfortunately there are quite a few judges this year she has already had a ticket from, for the Bouvier Judges' List is far too small, resulting in the same people judging year after year. We will also still campaign her sire, Ch/NL Ch Quiche's Douglas at Kanix (imp) who is three years old. I have imported two pups from Canada, Quiche's Gulliver's Travels to Kanix and Quiche's GoGo Girl (12 months) and they along with Kanix Maverick (18 months) should keep us busy though out the year!

Q. What policy do you usually adopt when planning a mat-

ing, e.g. line breed or out cross?

A. When planning a litter we look for a dog which compliments the bitch and is not too closely bred. Historically, most Kanix litters are outcrosses.

Q. Is there any aspect of the standard that you would want to change given the opportunity?

A. There is nothing wrong with our standard only with the inter-

A. I here is nothing wrong with our standard only with the interpretation of it by some who set themselves up as experts to educate others when they themselves need educating. For example the standard says - Gait: Powerful, driving, free and easy. So why therefore are dogs with the bicycling rear movement with rear limbs moving up and down like pistons, chosen to represent the standard? The other misnomer from the same experts is 'the bigger the head the better'. The standard states - Head and Skull: In proportion to build and stature. Ours is not a bullbreed and it is the coat on the head which should give the impression of massiveness. which should give the impression of massiveness

Q. Just how much work is involved keeping a top winning Bouvier in tip top condition for the ring?

A. Keeping a Bouvier in tip top condition for shows where they are judged at the highest level is a full time commitment. We have worked and worked our coats to obtain the correct harshness. What you see ringside is our dogs' body shape and has nothing cleverly camouflaged with a bouffant hairstyle. Each dog is worked on for about four hours before every show but if they have been idle for a few weeks then a lot more time is allocated. When you think this is in fact a working dog and not a Poodle or Bichon you can appreciate time is not spent scissoring and styling the coat it is actually stripping the coat to obtain the dry, crisp coat which is required by the Bouvier standard.

Our dogs are able to run free in our paddocks for exercise but are also toned on a 'horse-walker' to keep them in tip top condition, each day – time consuming but worth it.

Q. Have you any particular worries about the breed at pres-

A. Worries about the breed? I still wish breeders would be more open about health issues in their lines, but by far our main problem, which has not changed over the years, is the inability of some exhibitors to let new people in the breed find out for themselves who they like and respect and who they don't. Too many new exhibitors go by the wayside for they are dragged into 'camps' with all the associated bitterness and back-biting and this in not conducive to a friendly day out with their new pup – their pride and joy. Look out for it – "Reaching for the Stars".

A. Luiz is special to me and his fans because of his outgoing personality and attitude. His overall balance, conformation and move-


ment are his attributes along with his ring presence as he thinks everyone has come to see him!!



Our original stock came from this kennel and we have worked together for many years striving to breed sound health Lhasa Apsos that fit the breed standard.

Q. Congratulations on Shocka's winning the top Pastoral group for the second consecutive year. What plans do you have for him for 2008?

A: The plans is to selectively show him in 2008, he has progeny due out in the ring this year.

Q: What persuaded his breeders Alan and Cathy McCorkle to

send him to the UK?

A: Alan McCorkle, let Shocka go as there was no use for him in his breeding programme.

Q. With all the winning he has done including two BIS and multiple group placings last year how do you maintain his coat and condition for the ring?

A. We are lucky enough to have seven acres of land where he and his Aussie buddies hang out and chase around and have fun, he also has a large hydro pool to keep his muscles toned and he eats a good balanced diet which suits his condition

Q:What are your feelings about the 'tail issue'?

A: The tail issue was not thought out properly on a breed by breed basis, it was a blanket decision not allowing for the deformities that we get in our breed.

Q. Are you the breeder of the puppy or was it bought in? If it was a home bred puppy was it a result of a line-breeding pol-

icy or was it completely out-crossed?

A. 'Rush' was bought in from breeders Janice and Roger Clifford A. Rushi was bought in 10th Detects Jainte and Roger Christia as I prefer to keep males and made the decision some years ago not to breed. He is the result of a third repeat mating of the outstanding producers Fr Ch Rival de la Fureur du Crepuscule x Ch Ebontide Lady In Black. This mating is an outcross although Rival is loosely

Q. Did his quality stand out from the beginning?

A. As I already own a male from the first of these matings who has had much success I didn't think I would be quite so lucky a second time. However I was pleasantly surprised when I saw the litter and for me he stood out immediately.

Q. Do you think that CCs attained under 12 months of ago

should count towards the title of Champion?

I can see no valid argument against as I personally have owned

four dogs who have gained CCs from puppy – three of which went on to be multiple CC winners. If the judge truly believes a puppy is of such quality that it meets the breed standard more closely than the older exhibits then they should judge honestly and award the puppy the CC. Judges are not in the ring to judge age and if the dogs development is correct for its age then why are they penalised? It never ceases to amaze me the amount of times I read in a puppy class critique that the exhibit needs to mature!! It's a puppy!! Why would you want it to look as though it were two years old. If anything overmaturity should be penalised not immaturity all things being equal.
Q. What is it about your puppy that makes him/her a winner?

A. Apart from his exceptional breed type Rush has that elusive - call it style, presence, attitude or whatever - he oozes Belanality gian Shepherd.

Q. Please tell us a little about your history. For example how long have you been in dogs?

A. I've owned Groenendael, and more recently Tervueren, for 20 years and have been exceptionally lucky in my choice of dogs owning four champions, CC and RCC winners from the small number of dogs I have owned. I have the honour of awarding CCs at home and abroad. I have been heavily involved in one of our breed clubs, being over the years, Acting Chair, Show Sec, Judge's List Co-Ordinator and general all round 'dogsbody'. Apart from that I live pretty much the same as everyone else – work, dogs, and friends – what else is there.

Q. Have you anyone to thank for your success or have you done it alone?

A. Of course there are people to thank. Without the breeders who are willing to let me choose and take away their very best I wouldn't have these beautiful and successful dogs. Also there are the true friends who are willing to share not only the dogs but also their knowledge, those who support and encourage through your good and bad days, and not least those judges who appreciate the dogs I show!

OUR DOGS/ Pedigree Top Puppy Joint winner Pastoral Group Linda Godefroid's Briard Hartswelin Lorelei JW

Q. Are you the breeder of the puppy or was it bought in? If it was a home bred puppy was it a result of a line breeding policy or was it completely out-crossed?

A. "Starry" is home bred. As my champion bitch is line-bred I could afford to use an outcross in her sire.

Q. Did her quality stand out from the beginning?

A. I thought so. I select my pups at six weeks old and as soon as I stood her on the table I knew. She had all the angles I look for and a lovely temperament to go with it. She was BPIS at her first show Crystal Palace CA April 2007 when only six months and one week old under all rounder Dagmar Kenis-Fordham. She finished her puppy career at a breed club championship show in September 2007 with BPIS under breed specialist Ann Webb. In her first junior class again at Crystal Palace November 2007 she gained her final point for her JW.

Q. Do you think that CCs attained under 12 months of age

should count towards the title of Champion?

A. Yes, I gained a CC with my home bred fawn dog when he was 10 ½ months old, the first Briard to do so. This was in 1980 when there were fewer sets of CCs. He went on to win 11 CCs and was one of three champions in this litter, another first in the breed, and a record that stood for some considerable time.

Q. What is it about your puppy that makes her a winner? A. You would need to ask the judges, but for me it is her superb front angulation and effortless ground covering movement, although sometimes her enthusiasm sees her covering too much too quickly!

Q. Please tell us a little about your history. For example how long have you been in dogs?

A. I have had my kennel name 'Hartswelin' since 1968 when I bred my first litter of Irish Setters. I have bred a champion and res CC winners in this my first breed. I have owned Briards since 1975 and bred my first litter in 1977. I have bred champions in both colours and both sexes. My black dog Ch Hartswelin Meteor JW



was top Briard 2006 and top male 2007, he is Starry's half brother. I give CCs in both the above breeds and was honoured to judge Briards at Crufts in their Centenary year 1991 with an entry of 138. I have also bred and shown Border Terriers for the last eleven years as I hope to continue to be part of the 'world of dogs' even when I can no longer keep up with by Briards!

Q. Have you anyone to thank for your success or have you done it alone?

All my dogs have always lived indoors and this has a bearing on numbers. I have only formally bred when I am in a position to keep a puppy, so I have to try my best to get it right by making informed decisions based on research, experience and formerly, asking questions of my elders.

Q. Are you the breeder of the puppy or was it bought in? If it was a home bred puppy was it a result of a line breeding policy or was it completely out-crossed?

A. Foxrush Ovaltine was line-bred by me out of Sh Ch Foxrush Giselle and is the eigth generation of my bitch line.

Q. Did his/her quality stand out from the beginning?A. She was in a litter of 11, but at ten weeks she had style and ersonality which attracted your eye to her

Q. Do you think CCs attained under 12 months of age should count towards the title of Champion?

A. Yes Q. What is it about your puppy that makes him/her a winner? A. She has ring presence and that extra touch of quality, also charisma when she moves around the ring. She has the correct double coat and otter tail which are a distinctive feature of the labrador.

Q. Please tell us about your history. For example how long have you been in dogs?

A. I started in Labradors 35 years ago and awarded CCs for the first time in 1982. I have judged all over the world and judged labrador bitches at Crufts in 1997.

Q. Have you anyone to thank for your success or have you done it alone?

A. I am a 'one man band', so all the planning of litters, mating, whelping, exercising etc., I do it all!!

Q. Did you breed the puppy or was it bought in? If homebred was he the result of a line breeding policy or completely outcrossed?

A. Lireva's Short Black An Sides was bred by my mother Averil Cawthera and is part of an on-going breeding programme which dates back to our first Poms over 30 years ago. Q. Did his quality stand out from the beginning?

A. At birth I happily told my partner Sean Gwynne that this ludging. Having to



win at least one of the CCs after 12 months ensures that the puppy

His write-ups have consistently praised type and movement and many, whose opinion I value highly have also added to this his head quality and overall body shape. He also has the true temperament of our breed - fearless and out to enjoy himself and so he is never totally reliable as he is always doing it his way rather than mine. I'm lucky that he is a bit of a poser and so I can use his way to my advantage most of the time! He has since his first appearnace had a fan club both in and out of the breed and I always take this as a pointer to that ellusive something extra that some dogs just seem to have.

Q. How long have being breeding poms?

A. Our kennel Lireva, was started by my parents in the early 70s with their breed Samoyeds when I was a child. When I became interested in junior handling myself the 'Sams' were too strong and so eventually Mum and Dad gave in and let me have my own breed and the first pom arrived, they stayed and have taken over as our main breed although we always have two or three Sammies at home as well and show both breeds. We have campaigned 14 Poms to their titles and seven Sams winning over 150 CCs just with our

Poms, six of whom have been TG winners and two Ch BIS winners, probably the most famous still is Ch Lireva's Shooting Star, campainged in the early 80s to be Top Toy '83 and RBIS at Crufts in '84, but we can't forget either Ch Thelbern Mardi Gras, the current breed record holder with 39 CCs. RC has given us a 1st though as, although Sean handled one of the Sams to win a CC as a puppy, RC is the first Pom we have had who has done so and it was the first time I have ever handled a puppy to a CC and BOB. It was totally unexpected for that reason alone. He took his second CC at 14 months along with BIS at the SoE PC Ch Show. I'm proud that two breed specialists have thought so highly of him as to give him these awards so young.

$\mathbf{Q}.$ Have you anyone to thank for your success or have you done it alone?

A. We have for many years used the slogan - The Show Team. Thanks to Team Work and that is so true. Yes, we bred both RC and his sire and dam but we always both acknowledge and thank those breeders and exhibitors who have worked with us over the years and shared both their expertise and their bloodlines. Foremost of these would have to be Thelma Alsford, who 25 years ago asked to use Shooting Star. The mating produced one puppy but more importantly started a friendship that has resulted in both our kennels prospering in the intervening decades. RC is a great grandson of Mardi, whom Thelma bred and allowed me to have to campaign. That she also let me both campaign and keep her only progeny T Black to the Future for L is the reason we were able to breed on to produce RC and his CC winning litter sister. For their outcross sire thanks are due to Louisa & Bob Elliston, who allowed me to have and camare due to Louisa & Bob Eliston, who anowed me to have and campaign to his his title Ch Bowlou Phileas Fogg who is RCs paternal grand sire. We would also like to thank all the many judges who in the last 10 months have given RC the awards to give him both this honour and also more than enough points for his JW and ShCM and especially Astrid Ogilvie for his first CC and Rodney Russell for his

HAVING THE distinction of being the first Basenji to be Top Hound of the year, Dee Hardy and Trish Hallam's American import was imported to the UK as a puppy. She is the breed's bitch CC record holder and was Best in Show at the first Boston Championship Show in 2007. She also has group wins to her credit.

Q. What prompted her breeders Sue Kite and Jeff Gillespie to send her to the UK?

A.We approached Sue after visiting the American Basenji National in 2004 and seeing Klassic's Rooty Toot Toot take Best in Show. We had a successful dog Ch Akmar Akhetaten at Tokaji at home with 19CCs and group wins and placings and were looking for something to follow him in the breed. We had thought that we couldn't expect to be so lucky again and therefore decided to go for something completely different. After some time, when apparently Sue has asked a Basenji exhibitor in England about us, she sent an email photo of a yet un-named puppy and the terms of us having her. This included her being shown to her title in the USA in joint ownership of the 4 of us and then coming to the UK in the same ownership and continuing, hopefully, to her British title. Jeff now tells us he was quite reluctant to let her come as she made a sensational start in the USA with a group win and several Best of Breed and group placings from the non-champion classes.

Q. Often top winning puppies do not always progress to take

top awards as adults. How confident were you that the puppy you imported would turn out to be 'out of the top drawer'?

She has gone beyond all expectations, although she did well in America we were very nervous about what we had bought when we travelled to St Louis in 2005 to attend the Basenji National and meet her to bring her home. We met Sue as she arrived at the hotel and opened the van door to be met by the face of Millie as she peered out of her crate. Trish and I immediately turned to each other with broad smiles and said 'she'll do'. Although she was successful immediately ately in the UK winning her day of the Champion Stakes at Driffield aged 10 months we believe she has improved with age and maturity and is continuing to look ever better.

Q. How long have you been in the breed and what were your

Trish received her first Basenii as a 21st birthday present (we on't say how long ago that was) but she had only moderate success in the show-ring with them. I (Dee) had English Setters and we formed our partnership buying our first Hungarian Vizsla 20 years ago this year. The Basenjis and English Setters died off and seven years ago after meeting Paula Steele who lived locally to us we decided to buy another Basenji into the partnership, this was Nile (Ch Akmar Akhetaten of Tokaji). We have champion vizslas 1 of which Sh Ch Bournehouse Red Rhapsody of Tokaji was a group winner and Basenjis were going to be a small sideline interest. Nile then

won a RCC, Best Puppy in Breed and was placed in the Puppy Stakes at his first show at six months and three days and everything

Q. What plans have you for campaigning her in 2008? A. Millie will be campaigned through 2008 until she comes into season (due October, Basenjis only have I season a year) when she will be mated, hopefully, to our new acquisition due here from America in late March.

Q. Do you subscribe to the theory 'Never put a red card (or green and white for that matter!) before a bitch's breeding career?

A. Whilst we have never bred many litters we firmly believe that true recognition comes if you can combine success in the show-ring with producing happy, healthy stock. Therefore, in consultation with Sue and Jeff we have bought Am Ch Kazors Make Way for Riley a son of Millie's brother to mate to her and, hopefully, to provide the basis for our own ongoing line. Riley will be campaigned with Millie this year before she takes her 'maternity leave' but, of course, we will hope to return her to the ring next year with our own 'Tokaji
