

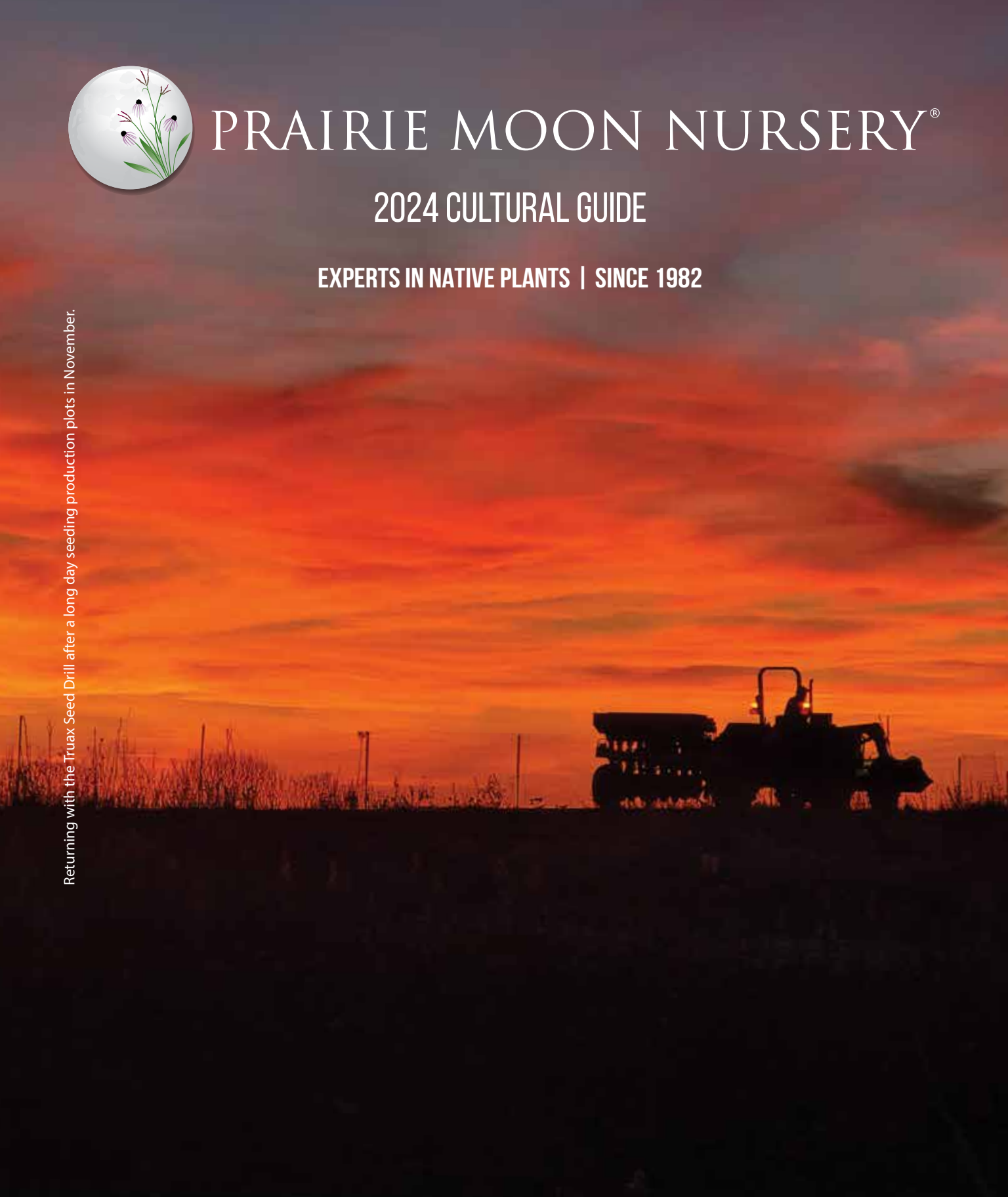

### SOIL MOISTURE

☀️ ☀️ ☀️ ☀️	<b>WET</b>	Soggy or marshy most of the year.
☀️ ☀️ ☀️ ☀️	<b>WET-MESIC</b>	Excessively wet in winter, spring and after heavy rain but often dries in summer.
☀️ ☀️ ☀️ ☀️	<b>MESIC</b>	Medium. Water soaks in with no run-off.
☀️ ☀️ ☀️ ☀️	<b>DRY-MESIC</b>	Well drained. Water is removed from soil readily but not rapidly.
☀️ ☀️ ☀️ ☀️	<b>DRY</b>	Excessively drained.

Approximate plant height (HT) is given with standard foot (') and inch (") abbreviations. Height is for mature full-grown plants in flower. Actual height will vary considerably due to competition, sun exposure, soil conditions, and weather. In young native plantings (less than 10 years) plant heights may be greater than in older plantings when competition reduces height.

### COMMENTS

<b>ANNUAL</b>	Completes its life cycle during one season
<b>BIENNIAL</b>	Grows vegetatively during the first year, completes its life cycle during the second
<b>CALCAREOUS</b>	Needs alkaline soil with a pH of 7 to 8
<b>ACIDIC</b>	Needs acid soil with a pH of 4 to 6
<b>HEMIPARASITIC</b>	Requires a host plant species. See Germ Code K
<b>SAND</b>	Thrive particularly well in sandy or well-drained soils
<b>COOL</b>	Actively grows during the spring and fall when soil temperatures are cool
<b>WARM</b>	Actively grows during the summer when soil temperatures are warm
<b>AGGRESSIVE</b>	May not be suited for small landscape plantings
<b>RHIZOMATOUS</b>	Fast-spreading root system
<b>NEW!</b>	New species in seed or plant for 2024
	Deer Resistant: (attn: deer may browse on any plant if food is scarce)
	Pollinator Favorites
	Bird Favorites
	Highly recommended for home landscaping
	Recommended for home landscaping, but potentially aggressive. Could overwhelm small landscapes

### SUN EXPOSURE

	<b>FULL SUN</b>	Plants require 6 or more hours of sun during the growing season.
	<b>PART SHADE</b>	Plants need 3-6 hours of direct sun. Sun reaches ground level at woodland edges or through openings between trees. Prairie species will often grow in larger openings, with shade-tolerant species growing under trees.
	<b>SHADE</b>	Plants require less than 3 hours of sunlight.
