



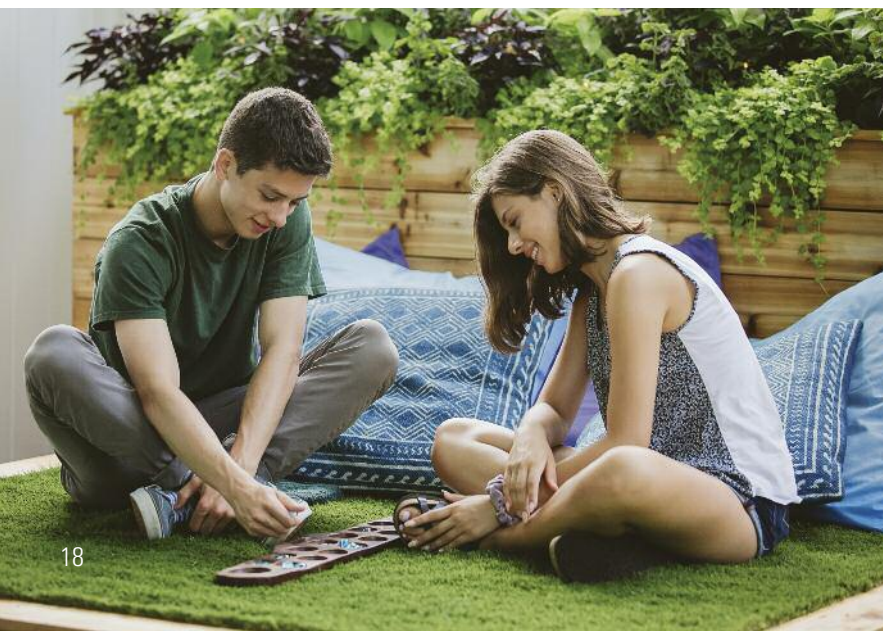


# SWEET SANCTUARY
