NEPAL: 1a Deep Blue, Setting 27, 2nd State, Recut Cliché's.(Circa 1928). Very blurry, worn state, telegraphically used in Birganj. Inverted Cliches - 15, 18, 23, 27, 37, 40, 41, 51, & 64. Cliché 10 has a large cut in the frame, upper left (not found in the early printings of this Setting), Cliché 58 shows a vertical gash in the upper right. This 2nd State printing is the so-called "cleaned lettering state - white borders around the lettering. (Hellrigl states, {The Classic Stamps of Nepal, Page 106}that "only three telegraphically used sheets of this {cleaned letter state} variety are known". Very Scarce Sheet. (Ex. A. Singer)

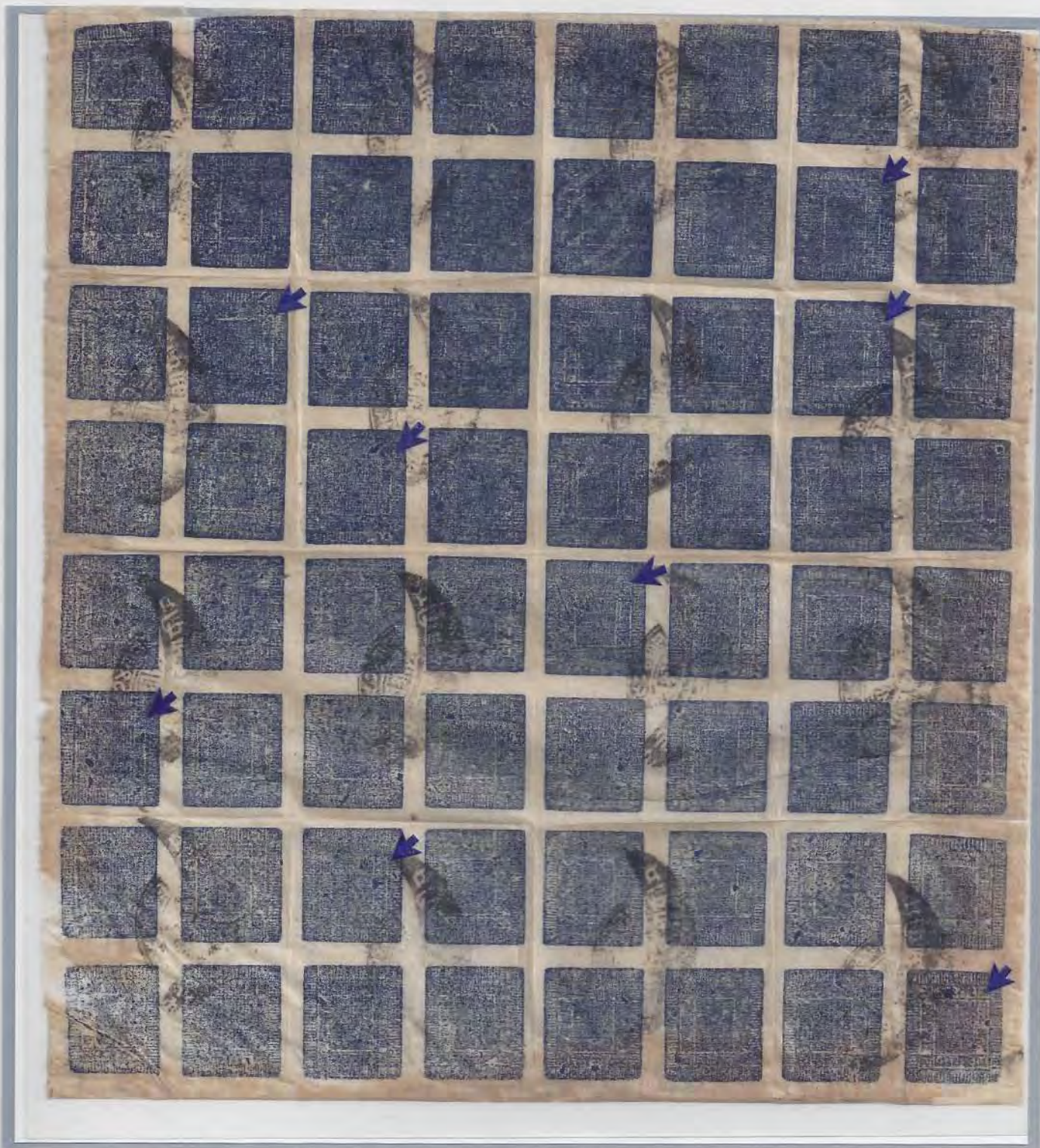

Singer - Illustrated in Singer's Nepal P. 61).

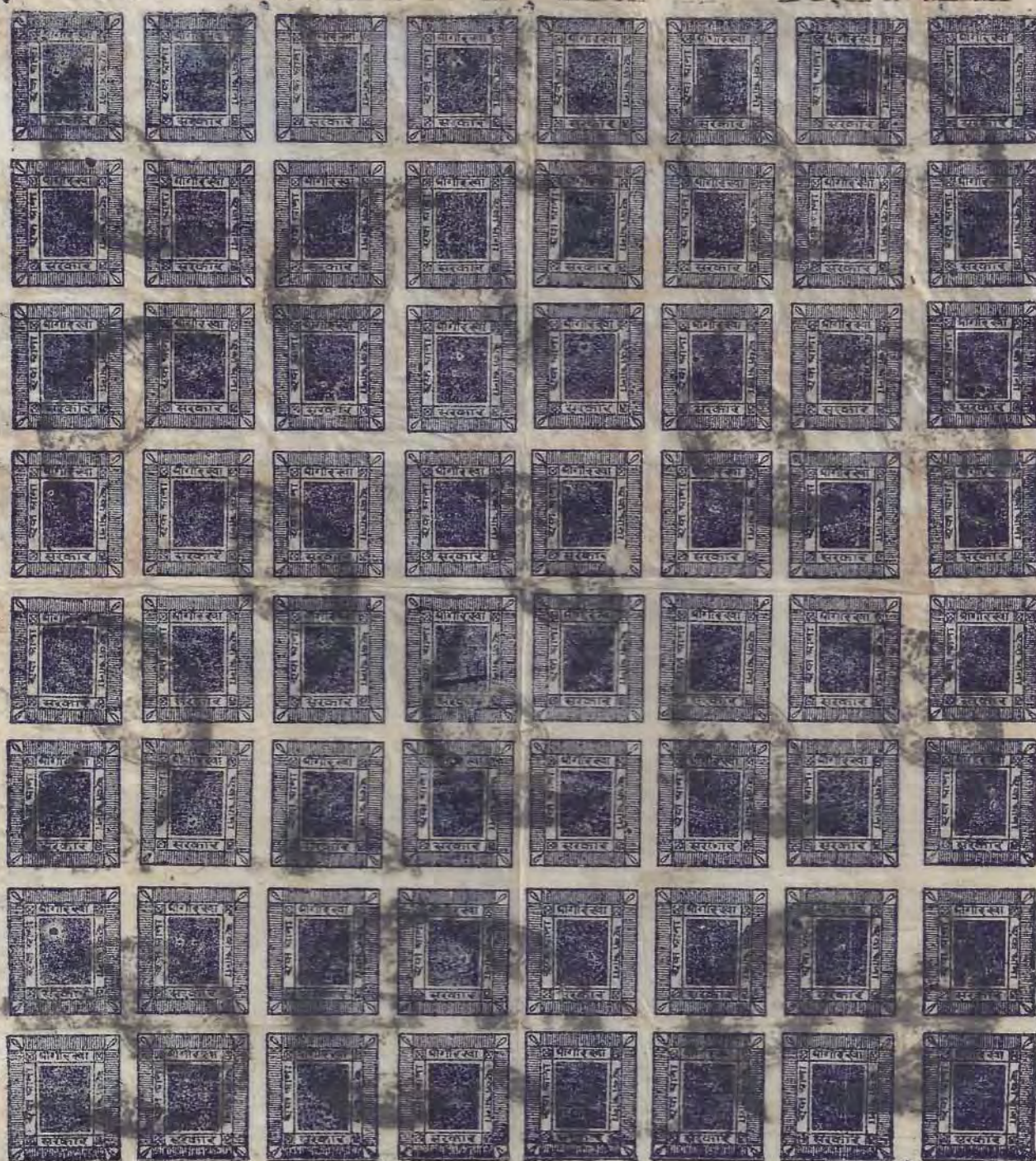

Telegraphically Used sheet – cancelled by CHISAPANI telegraph cancel. Note the frame lines, close the Plate (2.5mm). Hellrigl & Vignola state that there were No Framelines for this new One Anna Plate. (Ex. A. Singer – Illustrated in Singer's Nepal P. 64).

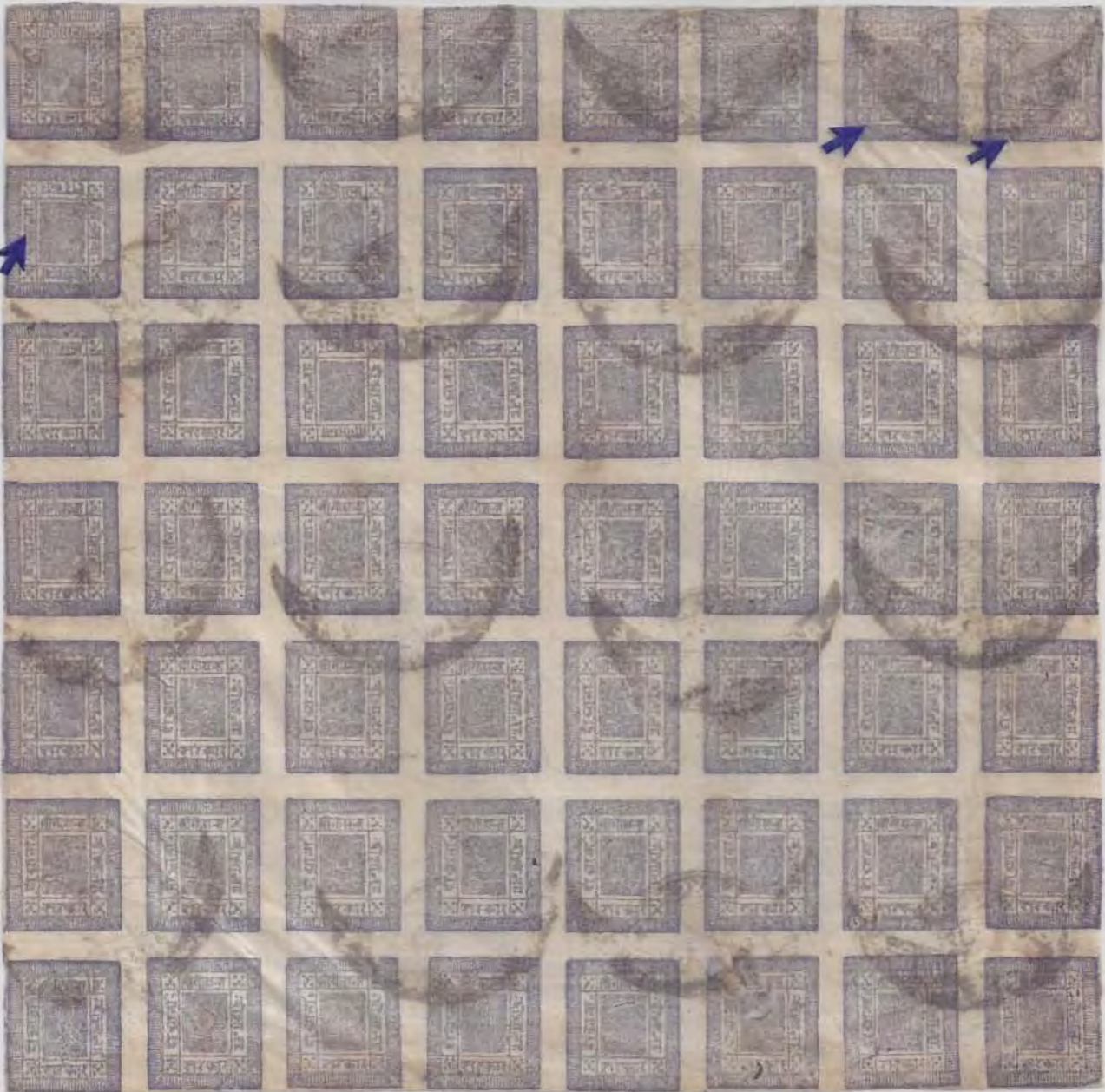

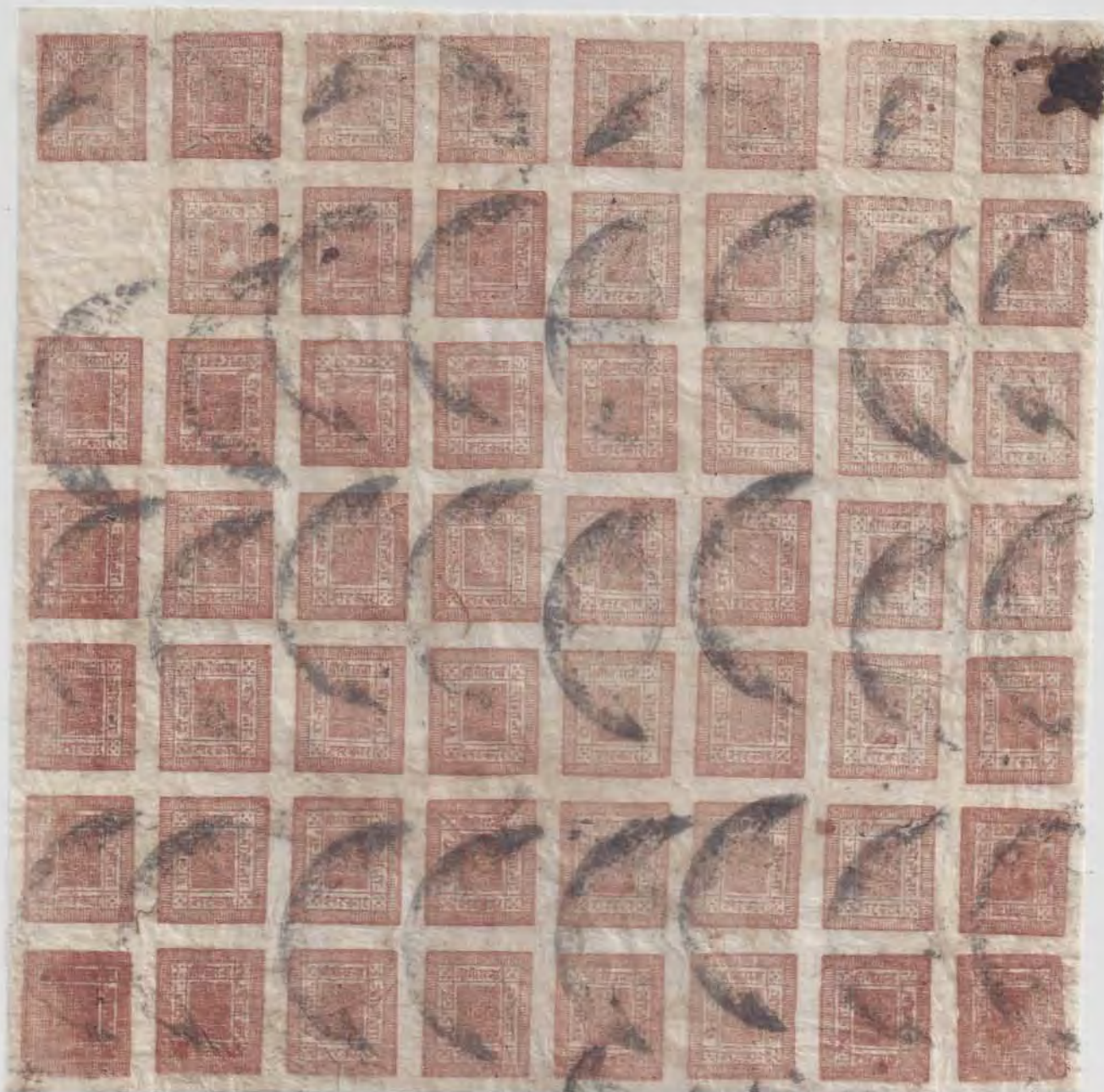
