

Once registered, names and classifications may be changed only with the agreement of the International Cultivar Registration Authority, upon application to the International Registrar.

NOTES ON CLASSIFICATION AND DESCRIPTION

Note 1 - on classification

The combination of division and colour code assigned here (or as amended in any future Supplement) is the registered classification, to be observed, for example, when schedules require cultivars to be shown "as registered". The registered classification is not altered by any note of variable measurement or colour. (See pp26–27 for any notes of variability in previous registrations).

Note 2 – on colour coding

Guidelines on colour coding, including those on distinguishing between Yellow and Orange and between Orange and Red appear in the Register and on registration forms. It is at the registrant's discretion to distinguish White from Yellow or Green, Yellow from Green, or Pink from the paler tones of Orange or Red.

In addition:

- Green at corona base

The green at the base of a corona, whether in the tube or in the corona itself, may be included in the colour code if it is prominent and plain to see. Registrants are advised to include it only if it is consistent from year to year.

- Non-concentric colours

When coding colours in perianth or corona that appear in radial rather than concentric bands, or in a flare from the base, or in flecks or splashes: start with a letter for the predominant colour; proceed with an oblique line; follow with the letter(s) (in any order) for the non-predominant colour(s).

For example, a yellow flower with a white streak along the midrib of the perianth segments would be Y/W-Y; a white flower with radial bands of orange and yellow on the corona segments would be W-W/OY.

Note 3 – on colour terms

Colour Chart numbers in registered descriptions, e.g. 13B in 'Abache', are from the *RHS Colour Chart* (1966, 1986, 1995, 2001, 2007). Colour names followed by Chart numbers without brackets are equivalents adopted by the RHS for all its international registers. They are taken from the Universal Colour Language in the Inter-Society Color Council-National Bureau of Standards colourname system. Colour names followed by Chart numbers with brackets or by no numbers at all are those supplied by the registrant.

Note 4 – on description

Registered descriptions are drawn up from application forms and, whenever possible, from photographs and actual specimens too. The Registrar would welcome readers' comments on the accuracy of all descriptions.

Illustrations of descriptive terms appear on p28.

Note 5 – on height

Stem heights in registered descriptions may be taken to be Standard (325–675 mm) unless otherwise stated, when they will be described as Dwarf (less than 325 mm) or Tall (more than 675 mm).

Note 6 - on Standards

The Standard noted at the end of some descriptions is the designated herbarium specimen or illustration forming a permanent record of the distinguishing characteristics of the cultivar and fixing the cultivar name.

REGISTRATIONS 2013–2014

The following cultivar names were registered between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014 by The Royal Horticultural Society, International Cultivar Registration Authority for the genus *Narcissus*.

The seed parent is given before the pollen parent.

'Abache' 1 W-Y

(Jackson's Daffodils, 2004) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Parentage unknown; sdlg no. 31/04 Fl. 110mm wide; perianth segments 48mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, slightly mucronate, greenish white 155C, spreading, plane or with margins a little wavy, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base, less prominently mucronate; corona 48mm long, cylindrical, smooth, brilliant yellow 13B, mouth expanded and lightly frilled, with rim flanged and dentate. Mid-season.

'Aidensfield' 2 O-O

(Gordon Coombes, 2008) Gordon Coombes, 2014 'Torridon' × 'Omeomy'; sdlg no. G8-08 Fl. 98mm wide; perianth segments 40mm long, roundish in outline, mucronate, orange, flushed yellow, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, smooth and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base; corona 16mm long, bowl-shaped, angled, orange, mouth straight, ribbed and lightly frilled, with rim crenate and narrowly flanged. Strongly scented. Mid-season.

'Albyn Lass' 6 W-OPP

(D.Ć.MacArthur, 2009) D.C.MacArthur, 2014 'Foundling' open pollinated; sdlg no. ED4411 Fl. 79mm wide, facing slightly downwards; perianth segments 34mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, mucronate, greenish white 157D, reflexed, convex, creased, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base, less prominently mucronate, margins a little wavy; corona 19mm long, cup-shaped, irregularly ribbed, pink (179D), with a darker tone (179C) towards rim, and pale orange (24D) at base, mouth straight and wavy, with rim crenate. Dwarf. Mid-season.

'Alexis Beauty' 2 YYW-WPO

(K.van der Veek) W.van Lierop & Sons, 2014 Parentage unknown; sdlg no. KV50 Fl. 95mm wide; perianth segments 40mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, brilliant greenish yellow 6C, with a band of white at base and a slight white mucro, spreading, plane or with margins slightly incurling, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base, scarcely mucronate; corona 30mm long, funnel-shaped, angled, pale orange-pink (19C), with a narrow band of yellow-orange (20A) at rim and paling to white at base, mouth expanded, narrowly ribbed, wavy and lobed, with lobes overlapping, with rim flanged and minutely dentate. Dwarf. Sweetly scented. Mid-season.

'Aloof' 2 Y-O

(Jackson's Daffodils, 1998) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Sdlg 251/91 × sdlg 101/91; sdlg no. 245/98 Fl. rounded, 98mm wide; perianth segments 42mm long, roundish in outline, truncate at apex, slightly mucronate, brilliant yellow 13B, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, less prominently mucronate; corona 24mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, strong orange 25A, mouth straight and wavy, with rim entire. Mid-season.

'Amazing Sky' 11a W-YYP

(Colin Crotty) Colin Crotty, 2014 'Chernobyl' × 'Pink Sparkler'; sdlg no. 23-04 Fl. forming a double triangle, 111mm wide; perianth segments 45mm long, broadly ovate, truncate, mucronate, white, slightly reflexed, plane or with margins a little incurved, smooth and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, spreading, shouldered at base, less prominently mucronate; corona 25mm long, split to more than half its length, the six segments each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an outer and an inner whorl of three, almost as broad as the inner perianth segments, bi-lobed, with lobes overlapping, pinkish yellow, with a broad band of light pink at rim, lightly ribbed and frilled. Strongly scented. Sunproof. Mid-season to late. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126220)

'American Falls' 2 Y-P

(R.& E.Havens) R.& E.Havens, 2014 'Acumen' × 'American Dream'; sdlg no. OH4/24 Perianth segments broadly ovate, blunt, deep lemon yellow, with slight white mucro, a little reflexed, plane or with margins slightly incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, more nearly spreading, scarcely mucronate; corona funnel-shaped, smooth, mid-pink, with a deeper tone towards rim, frilled and irregularly lobed, with rim narrowly flanged. Mid-season.

'Arctic Angel' 1 W-W

(Gordon Coombes, 2006) Gordon Coombes, 2014 'Blanco Sol' × 'White Ermine'; sdlg no. G3-06 Fl. forming a double triangle, 95mm wide; perianth segments 38mm long, ovate, blunt, scarcely mucronate, spreading to a little reflexed, plane, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, more nearly spreading, acute at apex; corona 41mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, mouth straight, narrowly ribbed and a little wavy, six-lobed, with rim flanged and crenate. Strongly scented. Mid-season.

'Art Perfume' 4 Y-Y

(J.de Winter) M.H.van der Zon & Sons, 2014 Parentage unknown

Fl. rounded, 95mm wide, facing upwards; perianth segments in two whorls; the outer whorl 35mm long, roundish, very broad, light yellow (4D), with darker yellow (5C) at base and along margins and slight white mucro, a little reflexed, concave or with margins incurved, creased, of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner whorl shouldered at base, scarcely mucronate, light greenish yellow 4C, with midrib light yellow (4D), with orange-yellow (13B) towards base of midrib; corona 25mm long, orangeyellow (13B), sometimes with white (NN155A) at apex and along margins, either entire and filled with segments or split open with segments successively shorter and more inflexed towards centre, folded along midrib, crumpled and lightly frilled. Strongly scented. Mid-season.

'Autumn Surprise' 8 W-O

(Lawrence Trevanion, 2006) Lawrence Trevanion, 2014

N. tazetta subsp. lacticolor × N. elegans; sdlg no. 06_03T Fls 6 per stem; perianth segments ovate to roundish in outline, blunt at apex, mucronate, reflexed, plane or with margins slightly incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; corona cupshaped, smooth, mouth even, with rim entire and rolled slightly inwards. Moderately scented. Dwarf. Autumn.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126253)

'Babar' 7 W-W

(Robert Spotts, 1997) Robert Spotts, 2014 'Amber Castle' × *N. jonquilla* Fls 1–3 per stem, forming a double triangle, 70mm wide; perianth segments 30mm long, ovate, truncate, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; corona 17mm long, funnel-shaped, slightly ribbed, mouth wavy, with rim crenate. Late.

'Balfour' 1 W-P

(P.J.Radcliff, 2007) P.J.Radcliff, 2014
'Pink Belladonna' × 'Pink Silk'; sdlg no. 19/07
Fl. 105mm wide; perianth segments 35mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, slightly mucronate, yellowish white 155B, slightly reflexed, plane or with margins a little recurved, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments, narrower, scarcely mucronate, more nearly plane; corona 40mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, strong yellowish pink 37B, mouth wavy and narrowly ribbed, with rim flanged and crenate. Early.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126212)
Etymology: Named for an old mining town in Tasmania

'Barroco' 11a W-P

(Colin Crotty) Colin Crotty, 2014 ('Perlax' × 'Colin's Joy') × 'Pure Magic'; sdlg no. 24-04 Fl. 112mm wide; perianth segments 43mm long, very broadly ovate, truncate, scarcely mucronate, white, slightly reflexed, plane or with margins a little incurved, smooth and of membranaceous substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, spreading; corona 26mm long, split to more than half its length, the six segments each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an outer and an inner whorl of three, the same width as the perianth segments, bi-lobed, lightly creased, deep pink, touched greenish yellow at base, heavily frilled. Strongly scented. Sunproof. Mid-season to late. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0125221)

'Bedevil' 11a W-P

(Jackson's Daffodils, 2002) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Sdlg 251/91 × sdlg 101/91; sdlg no. 56/02 Fl. 98mm wide; perianth segments 42mm long, roundish in outline, truncate at apex, mucronate, yellowish white 155B, spreading, plane, a little creased at margins, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base; corona 24mm long, split to base, the six segments each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an outer and an inner whorl of three, orange pink (25A), bi-lobed, with lobes overlapping, ribbed, notched and lightly frilled. Early.

'Blithe' 4 W-W

(Jackson's Daffodils, 1999) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 'Lioness' [4W-W] × 'Shykoski'; sdlg no. 316/99 Fl. 98mm wide; perianth and other petaloid segments in three or more whorls, greenish white 155C; the

outer whorls 39mm long, very broadly ovate, blunt, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner whorls successively shorter and more strongly inflexed towards centre, concave; corona segments 23mm long, interspersed among the petaloid segments and clustered at centre, opening yellow, becoming creamy white (11D), lightly frilled. Late.

'Brush Fire' 2 Y-R

(Brian S.Duncan, 2007) Brian S.Duncan, 2014 'Lennymore' × 'Colourful'; sdlg no. 3410 Early to mid-season.

'Bubf' 10 W-W

(Lawrence Trevanion, 2008) Lawrence Trevanion, 2014

Sdlg 00_39B open pollinated; sdlg no. 08_77B Fl. 26mm wide, facing upwards, whitish; perianth segments 11mm long, lanceolate in outline, acute at apex, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, separated; the inner segments narrower; corona 14mm long, cup-shaped, broadly ribbed, mouth straight and a little wavy, with rim entire. Dwarf. Very early. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126245)

'Burr Oak' 2 W-R

(John R.Reed) John R.Reed, 2014 Parentage unknown Corona cup-shaped, dark red.

'Camilla Clara Kate' 3 W-GYR

(Brian S.Duncan, 2005) Brian S.Duncan, 2014 Sdlg 2318 ('Clouds Rest' × 'June Lake') × 'Volcanic Rim'; sdlg no. 3207

Fl. 100mm wide; perianth segments 40mm long, very broadly ovate in outline, rounded at apex, slightly mucronate, white, spreading, plane or with margins a little incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower, a little inflexed, shouldered at base, scarcely mucronate; corona 13mm long, bowl-shaped, ribbed, yellow, with green at base and a broad band of red at rim, mouth expanded and lightly frilled, with rim crenate. Mid-season to late.

'Cariad Tevita' 2 W-W

(R.A.Scamp, 1991) R.A.Scamp, 2014
'Pitchroy' × 'White Star'; sdlg no. 468
Fl. forming a double triangle, 98mm wide; perianth segments 40mm long, very broadly ovate, blunt, mucronate, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base, less prominently mucronate; corona 39mm long, funnel-shaped, smooth, mouth expanded, wavy, very lightly ribbed and irregularly lobed, with rim flanged and crenate. Mid-season to late.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126284)

Etymology: Cariad = Welsh for 'darling'. Tevita = Fijian word

'Carl Sandburg' 9 W-YYR

(John R.Reed) John R.Reed, 2014 'Tino Pai' × unknown *N. poeticus* ?hybrid; sdlg no. 2003-30-1

Fl. rounded, <25mm wide; perianth segments roundish in outline, smooth. Etymology: Named to honour Carl Sandburg, author of the poem 'Chicago'

'Carrot Nose' 1 W-O

(John R.Reed) John R.Reed, 2014 'Lutana' × 'Scott Joplin'; sdlg no. 2003-40-1 Perianth segments narrow, overlapping a little; corona narrow, with rim rolled and even.

'Castlewood' 2 W-P

(Gordon Coombes, 2007) Gordon Coombes, 2014 'Neon Blaze' × 'Ivory Glow'; sdlg no. G1-07 Fl. 96mm wide; perianth segments 39mm long, roundish in outline, mucronate, white, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments ovate in outline, shouldered at base; corona 22mm long, cup-shaped, angled, yellowish pink, with a broad band of a deeper tone at rim, mouth straight and wavy, with rim dentate. Strongly scented. Mid-season.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126229)

'Catspaw' 4 W-W

(Jackson's Daffodils, 1999) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Parentage unknown; sdlg no. 292/99 Fl. 92mm wide, greenish white 155A; perianth and other petaloid segments in several whorls; the outer whorls 35mm long, roundish in outline, blunt at apex, scarcely mucronate, spreading, plane or with margins a little incurved, smooth and of heavy substance; the inner whorls narrower, successively shorter and more inflexed towards centre, concave and folded inwards from midrib; corona segments two-thirds the length of and interspersed among the petaloid segments successively shorter and clustered towards centre, frilled to a little crumpled. Mid-season.

'Chaco Canyon' 2 W-YOO

(Robert Spotts, 2001) Robert Spotts, 2014 'Random Event' × 'Conestoga'; sdlg no. 2-333-14 Fl. rounded, 87mm wide; perianth segments 32mm long, broadly ovate, blunt, prominently mucronate, white, spreading, plane, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half; the inner segments narrower; corona 15mm long, bowl-shaped, smooth, deep orange, with a band of bright yellow at base, mouth flared, frilled and irregularly lobed, with rim entire. Mid-season.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by B. Blake (WSY0126277)

'Chagrin' 4 Y-Y

(Jackson's Daffodils, 1997) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Parentage unknown; sdlg no. 225/97 Fl. 84mm wide; perianth and other petaloid segments in three or more whorls, brilliant yellow 13C; the outer whorls 27mm long, roundish in outline, blunt at apex, spreading, plane to a little concave; the inner whorls narrower, successively shorter and more inflexed towards centre, folded inwards from midrib; corona segments two-thirds the length of and interspersed among the petaloid segments and clustered at centre, vivid yellow 14A, frilled to a little crumpled. Mid-season.

'Chambersburg' 2 Y-P

(Dr. William Bender) John R.Reed, 2014 Sdlg no. 88-4-13

Perianth segments light yellow, overlapping; corona cup-shaped, even.

Etymology: Named for Dr William Bender who lived in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania

'Chivy' 2 YYW-P

(Jackson's Daffodils, 2002) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Parentage unknown; sdlg no. 25A/02 Fl. 100mm wide; perianth segments 42mm long, very broadly ovate, blunt, slightly mucronate, brilliant yellow 12B, with greenish white 155C at base, spreading, plane or with margins incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, shouldered at base, scarcely mucronate; corona 37mm long, cylindrical, smooth, strong yellowish pink 32D, mouth expanded, ribbed and a little wavy, with rim dentate and widely flanged. Early.

'Christelle' 4 W-P

(R.A.Scamp, 1996) R.A.Scamp, 2014 'Spaniards Inn' × 'Pol Dornie'; sdlg no. 943-1004A Fl. rounded, 98mm wide; perianth and other petaloid segments in three or more whorls, white; the outer whorls 40mm long, roundish, very broad, truncate, slightly mucronate, spreading, plane or with margins incurling, with midrib showing, of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner whorls shorter, more strongly inflexed, folded inwards from midrib; corona segments 16mm long, interspersed among the inner whorls of petaloid segments and clustered at centre, sometimes bi-lobed, pink, with a narrow band of a slightly darker tone at rim, frilled at centre. Midseason to late.

Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126282)

'Christine Berriman' 11a W-P

(R.A.Scamp, 1996) R.A.Scamp, 2014 'Quiet Day' × 'Phantom'; sdlg no. 864 Fl. rounded, 100mm wide; perianth segments 40mm long, roundish, very broad, truncate, mucronate, white, plane or with margins incurling, creased, of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower, with midrib showing, margins wavy, less prominently mucronate, a little inflexed; corona 29mm long, split to base, the six segments each closely overlying a perianth segment, forming an outer and an inner whorl three, a little narrower than the perianth segments, bi-lobed, with lobes overlapping, opening pink with yellow tones at centre, shading to pink at maturity, frilled. Mid-season. Nomenclatural Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY0126285)

Etymology: Named at the request of the Berriman family

'Compulsion' 2 Y-O

(Jackson's Daffodils, 1999) Jackson's Daffodils, 2014 Sdlg 145/89 × sdlg 101/92; sdlg no. 321/99 Fl. 106mm wide; perianth segments 46mm long, roundish in outline, blunt at apex, slightly mucronate, vivid yellow 9A, spreading, plane or with margins a little incurved, smooth and of heavy substance, overlapping half or more; the inner segments narrower; corona 30mm long, cylindrical, smooth, strong orange 25A, mouth straight, ribbed and a little wavy, with rim entire. Late.

'Cool Lady' 2 W-W

(P.D.K.Ramsay, 2010) P.D.K.Ramsay, 2014


