### F.6.1 Foretriangle Dimensions

### (b) FORETRIANGLE HEIGHT

The distance between the intersection of <u>the sheer and the</u> fore side of the mast **spar**, extended as necessary, <del>and the deck including any superstructure,</del> and the **forestay rigging point**.

### **Current Position**

#### <u>Reason</u>

1. The current ERS foretriangle measurement definitions are not suitable for rating systems and the ISAF Offshore Special Regulations.
