#### **F.6.1 Foretriangle Dimensions**

##### (b) FORETRIANGLE HEIGHT

The distance between the intersection of the sheer and the fore side of the mast spar, extended as necessary, ~~and the deck including any superstructure~~, and the **forestay rigging point**.
