KEY TO THE PANDALIDAE OF CALIFORNIA

D. B. Cadien CSDLAC - 7 Dec 1994 (modified from Burukovskii 1974, Wicksten 1978, and Butler 1980)

1.	Rostrum articulated to front of carapace
2.	Third maxilliped with an exopod
3.	Second legs markedly unequal in length
4.	Rostrum with 2-8 dorsal spines; with a slight upcurve in the distal ten percent of it's length
5.	Discoid widening of inner margin of ischium of 1st leg prominent
6.	Third abdominal segment carinated dorsally, carina forms a lobe in the posterior margin of the segment
7.	Dorsal spines confined to anterior half of carapace
8.	Sixth abdominal somite length ≥2X width
