Characters: (Based on single anterior fragment)

1. Four eyes in a transverse row

- 2. Notosetae present on first setiger (few)
- 3. Branchiae from setiger 2, fused completely to the lamellae
- 4. No occipital antenna (a rise or hump only)
- 5. Hooks from setiger 16
- 6. Hooks clearly tridentate with the primary tooth acute to the shaft [=Scolelepis (Parascolelepis)]

Related Species & Other Comments:

This specimen keys to *Scolelepis squamata* in the Lovell and Pasko 1993 unpublished key for the non-Polydorid Spionidae. It differs from *S. squamata* which has hooks from the 25-40th setiger, branchiae only partly fused to the lamellae at the base (a neuropodial notch is present), and the primary tooth of hooded hooks is obtuse to the shaft [=*Scolelepis* (*Scolelepis*)].

This specimen differs from the species listed in the tables of Maciolek, 1987 and from all species previously described or listed locally by SCAMIT for Southern California.
