Wisconsin Circuit Court Access

Access to the public records of the Wisconsin circuit courts

This website (WCCA) provides access to certain public records of the Wisconsin circuit courts. The information displayed is an exact copy of the case information entered into the circuit court case management system by court staff in the counties where the case files are located. The court record summaries viewed here are all public records under Wisconsin open records law.

Please read this agreement prior to using the WCCA website:

The data available on the WCCA website is limited in the following ways:

- 1. Case information is uploaded to the WCCA website hourly unless periodic maintenance is being performed or the site is experiencing technical problems. The WCCA website information is accurate as of those updates. The WCCA program may be down for maintenance every night from 3:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m. Central Time.
- 2. Each county began using the circuit court case management system at different times and made independent decisions about the conversion or backloading of old cases. Converted cases may display less information.
- Records not open to public inspection are not displayed on the WCCA website. Confidential court records include adoptions, juvenile delinquency, child protection, termination of parental rights, guardianship, and civil commitments.
- 4. The official judgment and lien docket is located in the office of the clerk of circuit court for each county. Although WCCA is not the official judgment and lien docket, it does accurately reflect the information entered into the circuit court case management system for that purpose.

WCCA overview

1a. What is WCCA?

The Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) website provides access to certain public records of the Wisconsin Circuit Courts. It was designed and made available to the public in accord with Wisconsin's Open Records Law and public policy toward providing greater public access to government activities.

1b. What is the Wisconsin Open Records Law?

The public policy of Wisconsin state government is that all persons are entitled to the greatest possible information regarding the affairs of government and its official acts. Wis. Statute 19.31. Circuit court records are open for public inspection, Wis. Stats. 59.20(3), unless closed by a statute, a common law limitation, or a specific court order.

1c. What changes went into effect on March 30, 2018, for how cases are displayed on WCCA?

The Director of State Courts, acting on recommendations by the WCCA Oversight Committee, determined that the following cases will be

Civil cases (CV) not small claims - 20 years, with the following exception:

 Injunctions under Chapter 813, Wis. Stats., for domestic abuse, child abuse, individual at risk, and harassment that are denied or dismissed, are displayed for 2 years.

Commitment of an inmate cases (CI) - 75 years

Complex forfeiture cases (CX) - 20 years

Criminal traffic cases (CT) - 20 years, with the following exception:

 Criminal traffic cases with a disposition of acquittal or a disposition of dismissed, including dismissals resulting from deferred agreements, are displayed for 2 years.

Docketed judgments - 20 years

Family cases (FA) - 30 years, with the following exception:

· Dismissed divorce and annulment/legal separation cases are retained for 5 years.

Felony class A cases (CF) - 75 years, with the following exception:

 Felony cases with a disposition of acquittal or a disposition of dismissed, including dismissals resulting from deferred agreements, are displayed for 2 years.

Felony class B - I cases (CF) - 50 years, with the following exception:

 Felony cases with a disposition of acquittal or a disposition of dismissed, including dismissals resulting from deferred agreements, are displayed for 2 years.

Foreign judgment cases (FJ) - 20 years

Forfeiture (non-traffic ordinance violation) cases (FO) - 5 years, with the following exception:

 Forfeiture cases with a disposition of acquittal or a disposition of dismissed, including dismissals resulting from deferred agreements, are displayed for 2 years.

Incarcerated person cases (IP) - 5 years

John Doe cases - 75 years (JD, with class code 34001) for proceedings under §968.26, Wis. Stats.

Misdemeanor cases (CM) - 20 years, with the following exception:

Misdemeanor cases with a disposition of acquittal or a disposition of dismissed, including dismissals resulting from deferred.

Criminal Records

- No "national criminal records" search available to the public
- WCCA does not search arrest records
- Cases may result in a conviction or dismissed
- Forfeiture, Misdemeanor, Felony

Criminal Records - CCAP

- Scope
- Felony Records
 - —class A 75 years
 - —class B 50 years
- Misdemeanors & Criminal Traffic 20 years
- Circuit court only no federal court actions
- Dismissed or acquitted cases removed from WCCA 2 years after the final order





Liens and WCCA

- Types of Liens on <u>CCAP</u>
 - Money Judgments when judgment has been docketed
 - Tax Warrants
 - Unemployment Compensation Warrants
 - Constructions Liens
 - Condominium Liens
 - And more...
- Judgment and Lien Search
 - Liens prior to early 1990s most likely in paper format
 - Official docket is located in the office of the clerk of circuit court for each county



Lifespan of a Lien

- Lien for 10 years from the date of entry onto the judgment/lien docket
- Creditor can have lien re-docketed for a second 10year period
- Satisfaction of liens will be entered into the judgment/lien docket
 - Entered in the county where first filed and any other jurisdiction where the transcript of judgment may have been filed

Foreclosures

Foreclosure judgments not part of the judgment/lien docket

 If a deficiency judgment is entered, the deficiency judgment will be placed on the judgment/lien docket

Involuntary Liens that are Not Required to be Filed or Recorded

- Mechanic's Liens
- Motor vehicle towing & storage
- Keepers of hotels, stables, garages, marinas, and pastures
- Jewelers
- Factors & brokers
- Prepaid maintenance contracts


