OLD BUSINESS

Pending Motion(s): Motion # 09-10-02

Motion: To change Area meeting to Saturdays earlier in the day at 11:00am as long as facility is available with the same amount of rent.

Intent: To not conflict with various Sunday activities such as Church and football. More people say they would attend.

Motion Results: FAILED / 5 votes in favor / 24 votes opposed / 1 abstention

Tabled Motions: Motion # 12-10-01 (*Motion tabled until January*)

Motion: To create a shared service with the "Unity Is A Must" Area of NA, by adding the following policy to the Meeting List Chairperson:
"Duties # 7: Coordinate with the "Unity Is A Must" Meeting List Chairperson to keep meeting list up to date with meetings from both areas."
 And page 37 under meeting list bullets: The "South Jersey Area" and the "Unity Is A Must Area" will allow each others meetings on their respective meeting list, since they share geographical boundaries."

Intent: To better serve the newcomer by making the process of finding the nearest meeting easier, regardless of which ASC the group chooses to attend.

NEW BUSINESS (30 GSRs present at the start of New Business)

Per Motion #05-10-06, all motions voted on at Area and motions that need to go back to the groups for a vote will be re-typed by Secretary and the actual motion forms submitted will not be included in the minutes. All motions will be typed as written.

A hard copy of the original motion form will be kept on file and available at the SJASC for anyone to review upon request.

MOTIONS SENT BACK TO THE GROUPS TO VOTE:

12-10-01

Motion: To change our policy as follows: on page 31 under Operational Guidelines, Section 111, Parts 1 and 2, delete "of the GSRs present" and replace it with "of GSRs voting yes or no."

And to add a Part 5, under Section 111 stating: "5. Abstention – to "abstain" means to not vote at all."

Intent: To make it so abstentions do not count as a yes or no vote. Under our current policy they are counted as a "no" vote.

For example, a policy changing motion with 23 yes votes, 9 no votes and 6 abstain fails under our current policy would need 2/3rds of 38 total votes which is 26. Under the new policy 2/3rd of only the yes and no votes (32) would be 22, and the motion would pass.

MOTIONS VOTED ON AT THIS MONTH'S ASC:

12-10-02

Motion: To allow the "Unity Is A Must Area" of NA to print a temporary meeting list that includes meetings that belong to the "South Jersey Area" of NA for a period of 2 months.

Intent: So that the newcomer attending a meeting in one area will be given an opportunity to see all the meetings in the geographical area and to promote NA unity.

Results: PASSED / 17 votes in favor / 1 vote opposed / 3 abstentions

WEBSITE CHAIR – Pat

South Jersey Area Website Sub Committee Report – December 12, 2010

Good afternoon Family!

We are happy to announce that the South Jersey Area website is up and running well and updates were provided to the best of our ability. To let this Area body know what impact the SouthJerseyNA.Org website has on recovering addicts, I'll provide you with the following statistics: In following our Eleventh Tradition, the SouthJerseyNA.Org website is not promoted on the web, there has been no extraordinary search engine optimization coding done; the web site is simply there. Despite this anonymous presence on the web, since May of 2009; a total of 12,697 addicts, people seeking recovery or information about recovery have visited the site. That is an average of 668 visitors per month! Over this course of time, the number of new visitors is 59.49% of all traffic. The average amount of pages viewed is 4 per visit and the rate at which visitors leave the site in under a minute is only 25% - These anonymously gathered statistics would make any commercial site owner jealous and a testament to our Tradition of "Attraction rather than promotion."

Some closing business to wrap up my term as Web Chair:

-The domain name SouthJerseyNA.Org is set to expire on 1/3/2010 – The yearly renewal fee for the domain name is \$10.00 – A formal invoice will be generated by the hosting company 14 days before the expiration date, and as of this date have only sent the notice. Since this will expire before Area meets in January, I am submitting the renewal notice in lieu of an invoice, so this may be handled by the new Web Chair and the Area Treasurer in accordance with Area Policy for the Web Committee budget.

-The SJNA Website Committee met at its scheduled time, and place on November 27th 2010 with only the Web Chair in attendance. The newly elected web chair did leave voice mail with me, indicating that he would not be in attendance for the November Web Committee meeting, but would be in contact before today to discuss practice, policy, procedure and transitioning the care of the South Jersey Area website to him. To this date, no contact with the new web chair has been established despite numerous voicemail attempts.

-In accordance with Area Policy, I will provide the newly elected Area Chair and Web Chair with the complete login access information for southjerseyna.org hosting, FTP, billing and email server accounts.

-It has truly been an honor and privilege to serve this body and Narcotics Anonymous for the past two years as Web Chair. This blessing of being in service has helped me get yet another day clean. It is this addict's intention to live in the spirit of "Never Alone" and continue to serve this Area and support the new Web Chair well beyond the post-election transition of the website.

RCM Report

This will be my last report as your RCM and I am, and will always be grateful for this gift of service. Since my ability to type is very limited due to ongoing problems with my right arm, I thought it might be useful for you to know what info we typically bring to Region as your trusted representatives. Lou E. and I attended the Nov. Region meeting and the report I provided is noted below. I wish each of you and your families a beautiful holiday season and a healthy, happy New Year!

South Jersey Area RCM Report - November 20, 2010

After two years of attending Region as a representative of the South Jersey Area, first as the RCM-A and then as the RCM, I am sad that today will be my last Region meeting serving in this capacity. It has been a great privilege to serve and I am pleased to report that our Area will be well represented by our newly elected RCM, Lou E. and newly elected RCM-A, Jennifer T.

The SJASC continues to hold our Area meetings the second Sunday of each month except for May when the meeting is moved up a week so it doesn't conflict with Mother's Day. The meeting is held at the Stratford Senior Center at 1 pm and has met twice since the last Region meeting. The Area currently has 66 active Home Groups (those regularly attending Area) and another 9 inactive Home Groups (those who have current meetings but don't attend Area). On an average, approximately 56-60% of the Home Groups regularly attend Area Service and we usually have at least one new homegroup join SJASC each month. The number of Home Groups may change as a result of a decision by some groups to establish a new Area so an unknown number of groups will be leaving the SJASC to join this newly established Area.

Trusted servant position elections are held every November so at our November 7th meeting, all but one of the trusted servant positions was filled with a newly elected individual. These newly elected trusted servants will assume their new positions at the January ASC meeting. All Subcommittee Chairs continue to be urged to participate in the Regional Committees. The RCM regularly announces the open Regional positions to let addicts know how they can be of service at the Regional level.

Our Area's Activities Subcommittee continues to hold a variety of great events. The recently held Halloween Dance was well attended and we're planning a Thanksgiving Day speaker meeting and dinner as well as a New Year's Eve event.

I am happy to report that the SJASC operating budget is back on track due to several successful expense reduction strategies and today we have brought two checks from SJASC; a \$100 phone line donation as well as a \$1,400.00 Region donation.

Thanks for allowing me to serve and I know that I'll be seeing you again since I know how important service work is to my recovery.

Public Information
Sub Committee of South Jersey Area NA
Policy Outline
9/8/10

A. Purpose

- i. To open and maintain lines of communication between the public and Narcotics Anonymous so that the message of recovery is readily available to all addicts.
- ii. To carry the message in accordance with the Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts of Narcotics Anonymous.

B. Functions and Responsibilities

- i. To act as a resource and coordinating body for the South Jersey Area PI efforts.
- ii. To maintain a close working relationship with the Regional PI.
- iii. To educate and inform the local fellowship of ongoing PI activities, including presentations, learning days, forums, and conferences.
- iv. Carry the message of recovery through billboards, bumper sticker, posters, radio and TV PSA's.
- v. To hold helpline workshops annually.
- vi. To hold PI workshop annually.

C. Description of PI Sub Committee of South Jersey Area

- i. This Committee shall consist of two groups, the Administrative committee and the general members. The Administrative committee will include the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, and other elected or appointed Committee Coordinators or reps as deemed necessary by the Committee.
- ii. The General membership of this committee will consist of any individual who attends two consecutive PI sub Committee meetings.

D. Administrative Committee Election Procedure

- i. The chairperson will be selected upon the retirement of the previous chairperson by either the Vice chairperson assuming the role or electing a new chair person through a nomination and qualification process. However, any non. Member may also run for the position at Area.
- ii. The vice chair person will be selected upon the retirement of the previous chair person by either the Secretary assuming the role or electing a new chair person through a nomination and qualification process. However, any non. Member may also run for the position at Area.
- iii. The secretary will be selected upon the retirement of the previous secretary by electing a new secretary through a nomination and qualification process. However, any non. Member may also run for the position at Area.

E. Voting Requirements

- i. All Administrative Committee members are eligible to vote. Absentness from two consecutive meetings, without a communication with another member, will result in the loss of voting eligibility and they may be asked to step down from their commitment at the digression of the committee.
- ii. Any PI committee member shall be deemed eligible to vote after attending two consecutive meetings. Upon unexplained absence from two consecutive meetings they will be deemed ineligible to vote.

F. Voting Procedures

- i. All Matters before this Sub committee shall be decided by a majority of the voting participants of the Sub Committee, with exception of a change in policy. For any issues relating to a change in the policy a 2/3 majority of voting members in attendance is required.
- ii. In the event of ties the vote cast by the chairperson will be counted as two separate votes in order to break the tie.

G. Requirements and Duties for Administrative Personnel

1. Chairperson (Two Calendar Year Position with a midterm continuance approval required by area)

Requirements:

- i. 18 months Clean Time*
- ii. Previous Service Experience, Preferably PI
- iii. Ability to organize and give the committee direction and motivation
- iv. Willingness, Desire and availability to serve in the position.
- v. Understanding and practical experience of the 12 Steps, 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts of Narcotics Anonymous.
- vi. Working with an NA sponsor and being a member of an NA home group.
- vii. Abstinence from the use of drug replacement and maintenance programs. Maintenance of personal clean time throughout the term of office, loss of clean time requires immediate resignation.

Duties:

- i. Arrange time for meetings*
- ii. Initiates all necessary correspondence, including communication with Area Service Committee, and Region.
- iii. Keeps Area Service Committee and Region informed of all ongoing PI activities and events and vice versa.
- iv. Is ultimately responsible for files, records and overall function of Committee.
- v. Hold key to SJASC post office box.

2. Vice Chair (One Year Position)

Requirements:

- i. One Year Clean Time
- ii. Previous service experience, preferably PI
- iv. Ability to assume responsibility in the Chairpersons absence

Duties:

- i. To work closely with and assist in all the duties of the Committee
- ii. To carry out responsibilities delegated by the Chair and/or the Committee

3. Secretary (One Year Position)

Requirements:

- i. 1 Year Clean Time
- ii. Prior service experience, preferably with secretarial skills
- iv. Ability to develop written material in a clear, concise manner

Duties:

- i. Record minutes of each meeting
- ii. Distribute copies of those minutes to committee members prior to next PI meeting
- iii. Handle all correspondence as directed by the chair and/or the committee.
- iv. Maintain files and records of communications, including list of activities and commitments to be passed on to subsequent committee members
- v. Maintain attendance records

Note:

Until such time as the South Jersey Area PI Sub Committee's growth and effectiveness increases all duties related to future sub committees ie Educational committee, community committee, law enforcement committee and medical committee will be *handled by the existing PI Committee as a whole.*

H. Contingency Plan

1. Chain of Communication

- i. Requests for Information can come through our Help Line, Website or are referred by our H&I Sub Committee. Requests can also be made while presenting in public or an NA Convention or Committee.

- ii. All inquiries must go through the PI Sub Committee as a whole or through the PI Chair.
- iii. Any inquiries from the Public or within NA must be responded to with a phone call within 48 Hours of receipt.

I. Presentations

1. Requests

- i. Presentations should be discussed in advance at the Public Information meeting.
- ii. Administrative Committee can and will decline requests to do presentations if our Traditions and or Concepts are in jeopardy.
- iii. The Committee will decide how they should go about approaching it.
- iv. If the Committee cannot commit to a presentation with enough experienced members, it is the responsibility of the Chair, Vice Chair or Secretary to reschedule, and ask for Regional or neighboring PI support or decline the request.

- v. If the Presentation cannot be announced at the monthly subcommittee meeting, the Chair, Vice Chair, or Secretary is responsible to call (via phone) the entire committee for suggestions and support.

2. Requirements to be Presenter

- i. Future presenters must go on one presentation as an observer before they are allowed to speak or present at ANY presentation. Attendance at a mock presentation shall suffice as one presentation.

- ii. In order to give a presentation, Presenters that are not PI members must be accompanied by a minimum of two PI members to present at all approved presentations.

- iii. No one under one year clean is to lead a presentation, regardless of situation.

- iv. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES is anyone to do a presentation alone.

3. Materials

- i. PI Secretary handles and maintains all PI Presentation Materials

4. Format

i. All presentations will be in power point format created and reviewed by the PI Committee prior to any given presentation. "Once created these presentations will act as standardize presentations for any given presentation."

ii. The Power Point Presentation is to be printed legibly, distributed to those attending the presentations. The presenter(s) will lead a discussion and subsequent question and answer session with all those attending after the delivery of his or her power point presentation.

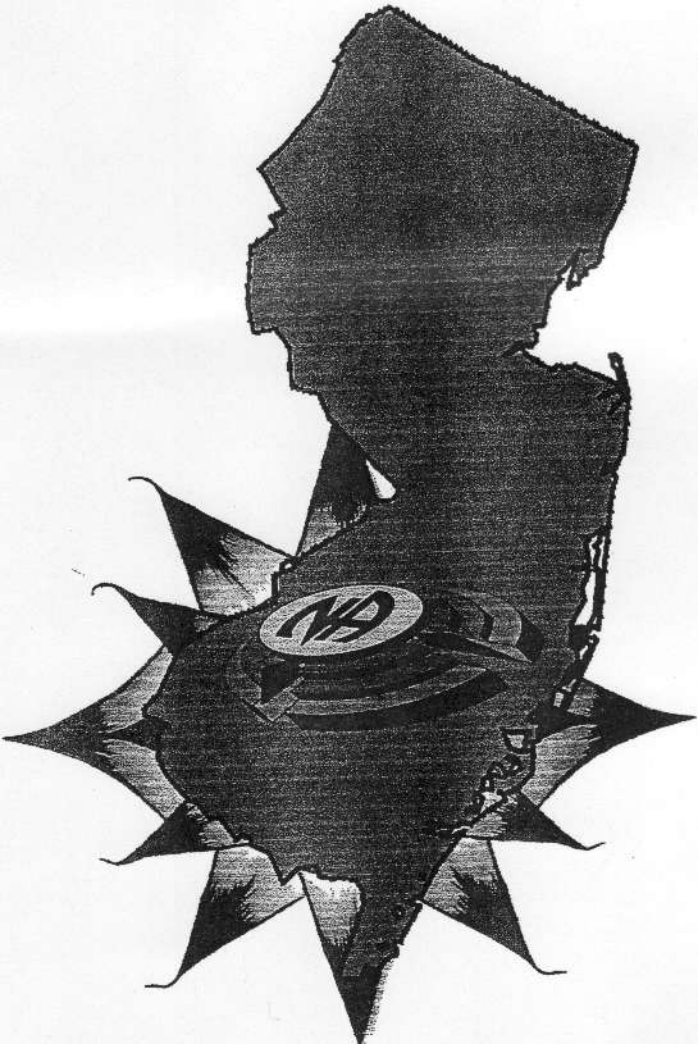

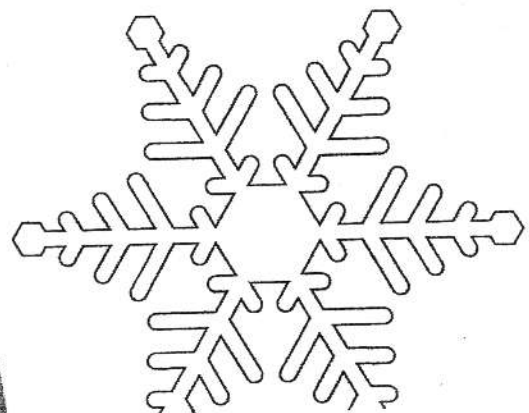
