## **The November 15 Deadline is fast approaching to get licenced.**

Businesses in the stonemason industry will need an engineered stone licence to conduct their business if it involves cutting, grinding and/or abrasively polishing engineered stone by November 15, 2022.

It is vital to the longevity of your business to ensure you are fully licensed and comply with Worksafe Victoria's requests in order to purchase and fabricate engineered stone products such as Stone Ambassador.
