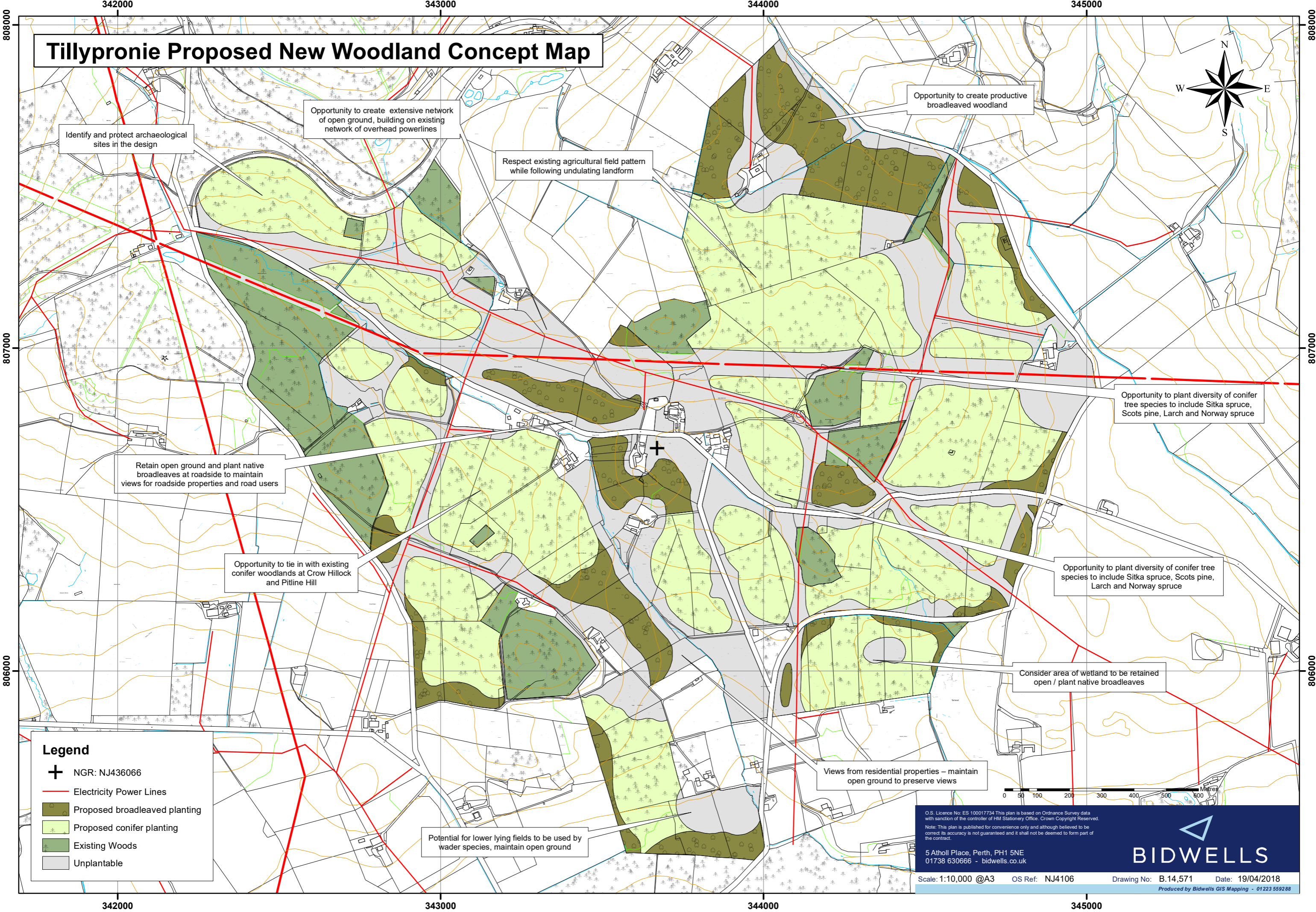


# Tillypronie Proposed New Woodland Concept Map



Identify and protect archaeological sites in the design

Opportunity to create extensive network of open ground, building on existing network of overhead powerlines

Respect existing agricultural field pattern while following undulating landform

Opportunity to create productive broadleaved woodland

Opportunity to plant diversity of conifer tree species to include Sitka spruce, Scots pine, Larch and Norway spruce

Retain open ground and plant native broadleaves at roadside to maintain views for roadside properties and road users

Opportunity to tie in with existing conifer woodlands at Crow Hillock and Pitline Hill

Opportunity to plant diversity of conifer tree species to include Sitka spruce, Scots pine, Larch and Norway spruce

Consider area of wetland to be retained open / plant native broadleaves

Views from residential properties – maintain open ground to preserve views

Potential for lower lying fields to be used by wader species, maintain open ground
