

Come Let Us Reason Together

1. As noted in Lev. 23 this is Yahveh's Feast, not man's. This is not a holiday that was thought up by man for man, but Yahveh, creator of all the universe commanded his believers to keep HIS Feast Days.
2. *Rom 2:28-29* A man is not a Jew if he is only one outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. No, a man is a Jew if he is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a man's praise is not from men, but from Yahveh.
3. **WWYD?** (what would Yahshua do)? Messiah, kept the feasts, as did Paul, Peter. Believers through the centuries kept these feasts even under severe persecution. These Holy Days of Yahveh changed in the 4th century when paganism was accepted into the church and Yahveh's feast days became "against Roman Law" to keep.
4. *Matt 5:18* I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.
5. This is the plan of Yahveh; to rehearse year after year after year what things are to come. The shofar will sound and announce the Triumphant entry of the Kingship of our Messiah. His second coming.

Now let's review what we said the reasons for sounding the Shofar were:

1. the start of festivals, 2. to muster troops, 3. to warn of danger, 4. to assemble the people, 5. in the midst of battles, 6. and for coronations.

After reading these scriptures and many more besides these, can we now see the importance of rehearsing this Holy Feast Day? The sound of the shofar during the entire day of this feast is (1) assembling the people to the feast, (2 & 4) to call the troops of Yahshua to arise with Him at His second coming. (3 & 5) the Shofar will sound during the battle. And (6) it will sound loud and strong to announce His coming. He will be crowned King of Kings and we who are faithful will reign with Him.

Rev 14:11-12 This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey Yahveh's commandments and remain faithful to Yahshua.

An interesting fact about this feast. It is the only feast that takes place on the night of a new moon. Have you ever tried to judge when there will be a new moon? Our calendars do & they are regularly wrong. *Matt 24:42 "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Savior will come."*

I believe Yahshua gave us a clue as to the

Yom Teruah Feast of Trumpets



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The Beginning

Lev 23:23-25

Yahveh said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites: 'On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts. Do no regular work, but present an offering made to Yahveh by fire.'"

You say, "yes, but that was for the Israelites".

Ask yourself right now.....Whose Feasts are these? The Israelites? NO, They are Yahveh's!

Lev 23:1-2

Yahveh said to Moses, "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'These are MY appointed feasts, the appointed feasts of Yahveh, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies.'"

Lev 23:4

"These are Yahveh's appointed feasts, the sacred assemblies you are to proclaim at their appointed times:

The "Believers" were to hold a holy convocation of blowing the trumpets on this feast. (Num. 29:1)"

During this Feast, the Trumpets used were ram's horns called Shofars. The uses of this instrument were: to announce the beginning of festivals, to

muster troops, to warn of danger, to assemble the people, in the midst of battles, and for coronations. (there is one place where the Word calls for silver trumpets in Numbers 10)

The word "Teruah" (as in Yom Teruah) means Day of the awakening blast. If ever the "church" needed to be awake it is now. Eph. 5:14-17.

All the Feasts, including Trumpets, are a prophetic picture of something in the future. In this case the fulfillment is yet to come. But, just as all the spring feasts have been fulfilled by the coming of the Messiah, so too the fall feasts will be fulfilled.

The Prophecy

Joel 2:1-2

Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of Yahveh is coming. It is close at hand - a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and blackness. Like dawn spreading across the mountains a large and mighty army comes, such as never was old nor ever will be in ages to come.

Zeph 1:14-16

14 "The great day of Yahveh is near- near and coming quickly. Listen! The cry on the day of Yahveh will be bitter, the shouting of the warrior there. That day will be a day of wrath, a day of distress and anguish, a day of trouble and ruin, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and blackness,

a day of trumpet and battle cry against the fortified cities and against the corner towers.

Matt 24:31

And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

1 Cor 15:52

in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

1 Thess 4:16-17

For Yahshua himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of Yahveh, and the dead in Messiah will rise first.

Rev 10:7

But in the days when the seventh angel is about to sound his trumpet, the mystery of Yahveh will be accomplished, just as he announced to his servants the prophets."

Rev 11:15

The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of Yahveh and of His Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever."
