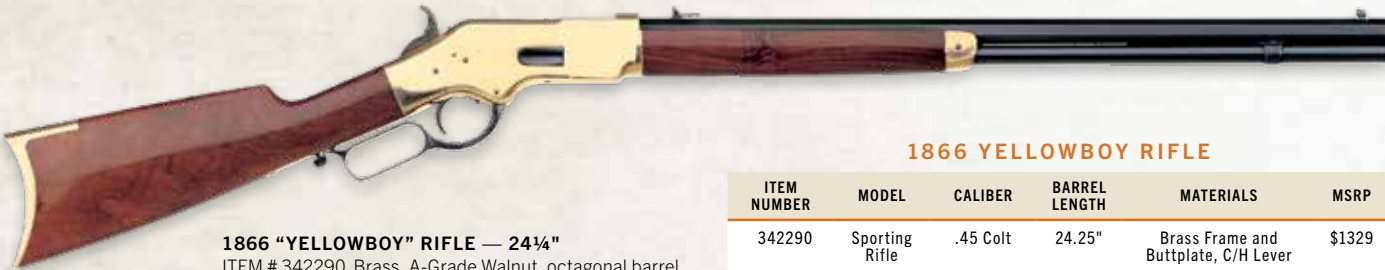

The Dragons were the first Colt revolvers to feature a latch at the muzzle for the loading lever. This prevented the loading lever from falling during firing.



The Walker and all Dragoon models have integrated loading cut-outs for easy and secure seating of the percussion caps.



Modern machinery and improved materials result in a stronger and more precise metal-to-metal fit on Uberti's replica firearms.

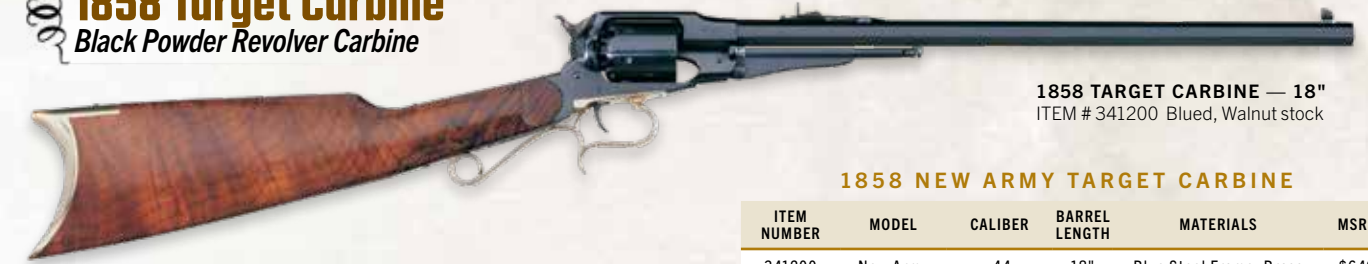

### Colt Single-Action Army Revolver of 1873

By Dan Carlson

Arguably the most famous handgun in U.S. history, the Colt Single-Action Army (SAA) Model 1873 Revolver is an iconic weapon associated with the "Wild West" and the American cowboy. Hundreds of Western-themed movies and TV shows feature rugged men and brave women on both sides of the law toting the legendary "Colt 45." Though highly sought in civilian versions, the impetus for this iconic firearm's creation came from the U.S. military.

The U.S. government in 1872 held trials for a new military service revolver to replace Colt's 1860 Army cap-and-ball revolver. Colt's design was favored and served as the primary military service revolver from 1873 until 1892 when it was phased out in favor of the new double-action .38-caliber Colt with a swing-out cylinder. But even then some American military personnel continued to use the SAA Colt well into the 20th century. Famous U.S. Army General George S. Patton carried a custom-made SAA Colt with ivory grips.

As popular as the SAA revolver was with the military, it was perhaps even more so with American civilians blazing new trails across the West. Colt introduced a version chambered in .44-40 Winchester, the same round used in the legendary Winchester 1873 lever-action rifle. Having a side arm and rifle chambered in the same round was exactly what the marketplace wanted and sales of both the revolver and rifle soared to cement their place in history by being used in some of the West's most famous conflicts, including the gunfight at the O.K. Corral.

Known for its reliability, Colt's SAA 1873 model saw constant modifications involving barrel lengths, grip shape and material, finish and calibers. Dozens of versions and variations are known to exist, including more than 20 offered by Uberti alone in calibers ranging from .22 rimfire to .44 Magnum in addition to the renowned .45 Long Colt. And all of Uberti's faithful recreations are protected with a five-year warranty.

**1875 Top-Break Revolver**  
By Dan Carlson

Competition between American firearm manufacturers was fierce in the years following the Civil War. The conflict had spurred firearm innovation and new designs were constantly appearing as the age of cap-and-ball firearms gave way to models using metallic cartridges. In the early 1870s, Colt and Smith & Wesson both introduced new revolvers intended for military use that went on to be popular in the civilian marketplace.

Smith & Wesson contracted with Russia in 1871 to supply 41,000 of its highly innovative Top-Break Revolvers to the Imperial Russian Army. But the Russians reverse-engineered the design, started making their own copies, and reneged on the deal, nearly bankrupting Smith & Wesson. Fortunately, the U.S. Army had adopted the Top-Break chambered in .45 S&W the previous year, which became the first standard-issue cartridge-firing revolver in US military service.

U.S. Army Major George W. Schofield proposed improvements and in 1875 the Top-Break Model 3 was adopted for use by the military. The revolver was favored by cavalry soldiers because it could be unloaded using one hand. The Army had asked for the gun to be made to fire the .45 Colt cartridge then in use with the famous Colt Single-Action Army 1873 Revolver, but Smith & Wesson instead made them to shoot the shorter .45 Schofield round. Ammunition incompatibility between the two revolvers in the field is thought to be one reason the military eventually dropped the Model 3 Top-Break in favor of the Colt.

Smith & Wesson shifted gears in 1877 by discontinuing previous versions to make the New Model Number Three. The guns were produced in several calibers, including the .44-40, which was also the chambering for the popular Winchester 1873 lever-action rifle. Ability to carry a rifle and revolver chambered for the same ammunition made both guns popular on the expanding American frontier. Among the more famous, or infamous, personalities known to carry the Smith & Wesson Top-Break were notorious gunfighter John Wesley Hardin (see page 13), Jesse James (who was also killed with one wielded by Bob Ford), Virgil and Wyatt Earp, and Pat Garrett. Wells Fargo and Company outfitted its road agents with Top-Breaks that had barrels shortened to 5 inches to aid in concealed carry.

Uberti offers several versions of the Smith & Wesson Top-Break Revolver in two different calibers. Faithful to the original design, these fully functional replicas are backed by Uberti's five-year warranty.

The only "poetic license" we took is caliber selection, since the Henry's original .44 rimfire is long obsolete.

### 1860 Henry Rifle

Benjamin Tyler Henry patented his new lever-action rifle in 1860, and it immediately became one of the most sought-after firearms of his time. With a sixteen-round tubular magazine beneath the barrel, it afforded users an unmatched rate of fire in battle. But as is often the case, traditionalists in the military raised objections to the gun. They were concerned soldiers able to shoot so quickly might waste ammunition, and bean counters pointed out the cost of a .44-caliber rimfire cartridge for the Henry was four times that of a round for a single-shot rifled musket. The gun itself took a comparatively long time to make, and was also costly at \$40 to \$50 per rifle. Adjusted for inflation, that's \$1,250-\$1,500 in 2020 U.S. dollars. Even so, many Union volunteers scraped together enough to buy a Henry and bring it with them into service. Though comparatively few saw action, those that did made a big impression. Infamous Confederate Colonel John Mosby, a notorious raider of

Union positions, called the Henry "that damned Yankee rifle that can be loaded on Sunday and fired all week." The moniker stuck, and the Henry rifle played a decisive role in the catastrophic defeat for the Confederacy in The Battle of Franklin in 1864. It also contributed to the defeat of Gen. Custer at The Battle of Little Bighorn where more than 170 Native American warriors were armed with Henry and Winchester repeaters and U.S. Army troops had very few. Though the Henry Rifle of 1860 lacked the range and knockdown power of many contemporary long guns, it more than made up for that after the war as a short-range defensive and hunting weapon able to deliver more than 10 shots a minute into multiple targets.

Uberti has faithfully reconstructed the 1860 Henry and offers both steel- and brass-receiver versions. Since the .44 rimfire rounds used in the original Henry rifles are obsolete, our fully functional replicas come in your choice of .44/40 or .45 Long Colt chamberings with handsome Walnut rear stocks and 24.5" barrels. We also offer a Henry Trapper carbine version with an 18.5" barrel.

These changes led to the creation of the "Yellowboy," the earliest version of the quintessential cowboy rifle whose lines and basic functioning survive to this day.

One last thing: however beautiful, these premium Uberti guns are not designed to be safe-queens! They do just as well at the range or in the field as they do on the coffee-table as you show them off to your friends.



Because the receiver of the 1866 is a “closed top” design—save for the ejector port—our engravers were able to use that space to further embellish this model with a floral design.



This beautiful short rifle features a classically-inspired engraving faithfully copied from an original. The design shows a timeless acanthus-leaf motif on both sides. The left side of the receiver contains a medallion-shaped frame surrounding a bugling elk, while the right side has an escutcheon that may be left blank or engraved with the owner's initials. 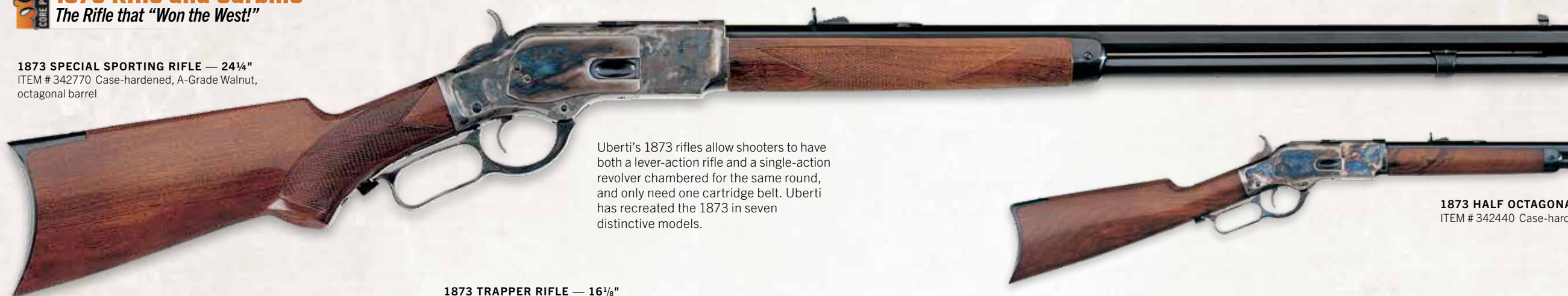

**1873 Lever-action Rifle**

Arguably the most famous American-made rifle in history, the 1873 Winchester lever-action rifle was successfully marketed as "The Gun That Won the West". So popular was this firearm that it remained in production until 1923, years after newer lever-action designs were available. In all, more than 720,000 1873 rifles were produced over a period of 50 years.

Winchester initiated a special promotion for the rifle in 1875. Barrels were test-fired by Winchester and those producing the best groupings out of 1,000 barrels were fitted to rifles with set triggers and a special finish. These celebrated rifles were marked "One of One Thousand" and sold at a premium price that, adjusted for inflation, would cost about \$2,310 today. It's believed 136 of these rifles were made. The classic Western movie "Winchester '73" starring Jimmy Stewart is a story about one of these prized "One of a Thousand" rifles, and the 1873 Winchester has appeared in dozens of other movies and TV shows over the last 100 years.

A big reason for the popularity of the 1873 Winchester was its chambering in the .44-40 Winchester cartridge, which originally had a 200-grain bullet over 40 grains of black powder. Both Colt and Smith & Wesson started making revolvers in .44-40 and legends were born. Lawmen, outlaws, ranchers and settlers saw great value in having rifles and side arms able to shoot the same ammunition. With ballistic performance comparable to today's .44 Magnum, the 1873 Winchester in .44-40 proved to be a great hunting rifle for big game out to 150 yards and it's estimated only the Winchester .30-30 has taken more deer in the U.S. Ironically, the time-tested .45 Colt was never chambered in the originals, since the early version of the cartridge had too small of a rim for reliable extraction.

Uberti offers 16 versions of the iconic 1873 Winchester in different barrel lengths, finishes and chamberings that include .44-40, .357 Magnum, and .45 Long Colt. Take advantage of your opportunity to own a treasured piece of American history.

## 1885 High-Wall Rifle By Dan Carlson

Shooting exhibitions and marksmanship contests grew rapidly in popularity and participation in the years following the American Civil War. From the 1870s until 1920, competitive shooting was as popular with Americans as golf is today. By 1882 American rifle manufacturers such as Remington, Sharps and Stevens had all made firearms specifically for use in competitions. In 1883 Winchester began work on a single-shot rifle for use in shooting matches. John Moses Browning collaborated with Winchester engineers to develop two rifles – the High-Wall and Low-Wall Model 1885.

The Low-Wall Winchester Model 1885 had an exposed hammer and was made to accommodate relatively small, less powerful cartridges such as the .22 Short, .32-20 WCF and .38-40 WCF. The High-Wall Model 1885 was built to handle larger and more powerful calibers such as the .45-70, .45-90 and .50-90, and its hammer was partially covered by the gun's steel frame. The Model 1885's action was so strong the gun served as a platform for future

testing and development of new high-powered rifle cartridges. Not only was the Model 1885 highly successful as a competition firearm, but it soon earned a reputation for rugged reliability. Famed hunter, shooter and writer Ned Roberts (inventor of the .257 Roberts cartridge) once described the Model 1885 as, "the most reliable, strongest, and altogether best single shot rifle ever produced."

Uberti's 1885 High-Wall Rifles are perfect for hunters and shooters who relish the challenge of hitting the mark with a single-shot rifle. 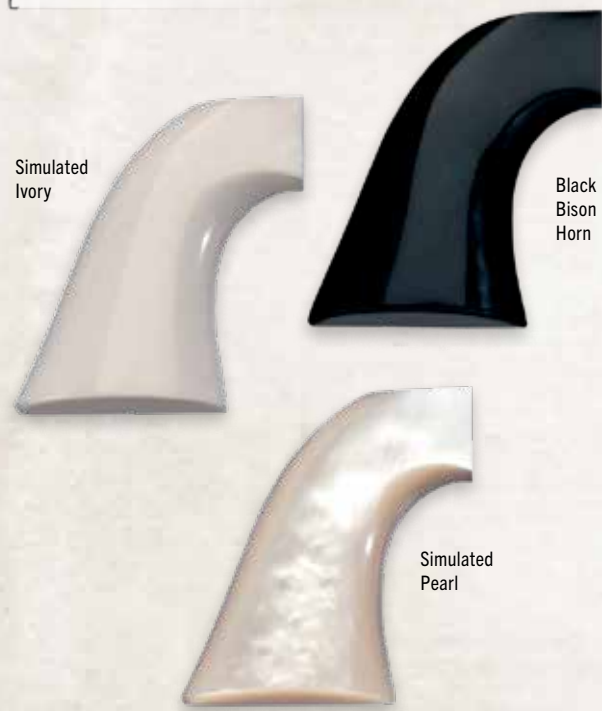

### Sights Creedmoor Rear Tang Sights and Globe Tunnel Front

The Creedmoor tang sights used on Sharps rifles were of three heights, depending on the yardage. The lowest, short-range sight was good to 300 yards, the mid-range to about 600 yards and long-range to 1,200 yards and beyond.

At very long range, with the rear sight elevated nearly to its limit, it was important to keep the rifle completely level to maintain accuracy. Consequently, front globe sights were often fitted with a spirit level so that the shooter could see that the bubble was centered and the gun was level before he touched the trigger.

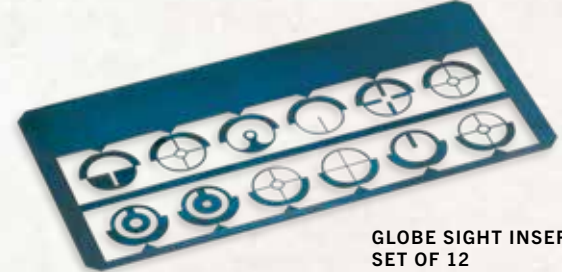

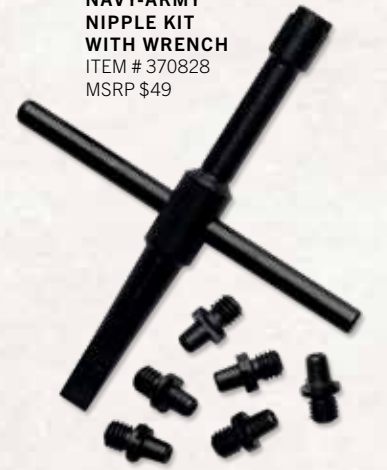

## 1847 Walker .44-Caliber Revolver

By Dan Carlson

Samuel Colt's Paterson revolver played a decisive role during battles between Texas Rangers and Comanche Indians in the mid-1800s. Texas Ranger Capt. Samuel Walker was so impressed by the performance of Colt's first production revolver in the tide-turning Battle of Bandera Pass that he met with Colt to collaborate on what would be the biggest and heaviest black powder revolver Colt ever produced – the .44-caliber 1847 Walker.

The goal was to make large-caliber six-shot revolver powerful enough to take down an enemy soldier or horse with a single hit. The result was a 4.5-lbs. gun that carried nearly twice the powder charge of other revolvers of the time. The weight made using a belt holster impractical, so the new Walker was primarily carried in a saddle holster. Though intended for use at 50 yards or less, there are stories about Walkers hitting targets as far away as 100 yards. It fired .454" round balls weighing approximately 140 grains at muzzle velocities in excess of 1,100 fps, and from the time it was introduced in 1847 until the .357 Magnum hit the market in the 1930s Colt's .44-caliber Walker was the most powerful revolver in the world – a title it held for more than 80 years!

The power, size and weight of the Walker did bring some challenges. The gun was cumbersome to wield and required considerable time to reload. Recoil was stout and occasionally caused the loading lever to drop from its stowed position. But Uberti's modern reproductions of this firearm do not exhibit these problems when used in accordance with the instruction manual.

The 1847 Walker has made a number of notable appearances in movies on the big screen. In "The Outlaw Josey Wales" Clint Eastwood carried two Walkers converted to shoot metallic cartridge blanks for safety reasons on the set. At more than 4 lbs. each, that was a lot of hardware for the actor to carry on his belt. Kim Darby shot a Walker revolver in her role as Mattie Ross in "True Grit." And Robert Duvall's character Gus in the miniseries "Lonesome Dove" carried a Walker.

It's estimated that 1,100 1847 Walkers were originally produced. It was the father of the next generation of Colt revolvers, the Dragoon series of 1848. Today an original Walker in good condition is extremely valuable to collectors. Now you can own a Walker replica from Uberti. Shooting competitions and matches became wildly popular in the U.S. and several other nations during the late 1800s. The Colt Single-Action Army revolver was already wildly popular when Colt released a special version for competition shooters participating in the British Commonwealth Championship Match in Bisley, England, in 1874.

Handgun competitions then involved shooters standing ramrod straight, the firearm held straight out with one arm. This one-hand shooting technique presented challenges for shooters attempting to control reaction to recoil. To help, Colt's Bisley offered a modified handle that would allow the shooter

to "roll" the revolver in the hand. As recoil-induced muzzle rise lifted the front of the barrel, the shape of the handle let shooters "roll" the gun's handle backward so the thumb could catch the hammer and re-cock the revolver as the barrel was brought down to aim a second shot. Skilled Bisley-equipped shooters could turn this process into an almost effortlessly smooth fire, cock, fire again sequence using just one hand.

Uberti offers a fully functional replica of the 1873 Bisley with a case-hardened frame and 5.5" barrel. **Overall length:** 12.7". **Weight:** 2.5 lbs.

### 1866 Yellowboy Rifle

When Benjamin Taylor Henry's Repeating Rifle came on the scene in 1860 it marked a major leap forward in personal firearm technology. The gun's ability to put sixteen consecutive rounds into multiple targets without reloading at the rate of 10 or more shots per minute was a game changer both in battle and on the American frontier.

In 1866, Nelson King introduced a major improvement to the original Henry by adding a spring-loaded gate on the right side of the receiver through which cartridges could be inserted to load the rifle. Not only did this addition make loading and reloading far faster and easier, but it also allowed for the addition

of a wooden forend stock. The forend made the Henry easier to hold, added durability, and also offered protection for the shooter's supporting hand from a hot barrel. Called the Yellowboy for its shiny brass frame, forend stock endcap and butt plate, the 1866 Henry's distinctive and handsome appearance made it highly desired.

Uberti offers striking recreations of the 1866 Yellowboy with polished Walnut stocks, beautiful brass receivers and blued octagonal barrels. We chambered them for the readily available .38 Special and .45 Long Colt cartridges in place of the obsolescent .44 Rimfire, and offer them with 19", 20" and 24.25" barrels.

### 1874 Sharps

Few rifles are so renowned for accuracy that those who use them literally define accurate shooting, but the series of rifles first introduced by Christian Sharps in 1848 were so good, the word "sharpshooter" came to define not only those who wielded Sharps rifles, but fine marksmen in general. Sharps rifles saw extensive use by both sides in the American Civil War because their breech-loading actions permitted loading while prone, sitting or riding a horse, and skilled sharpshooters could make up to 10 accurate shots per minute.

Civilian use of Sharps rifles hit its stride in the years following the civil war when the firearms were made in a number of chamberings for large-caliber metallic cartridges. Of these, the .45-70 (a .458-caliber bullet over 70 grains of black powder) introduced in 1873 became wildly popular with sportsmen. Teamed with special tang-mounted adjustable sights, such as the Creedmoor, the .45-70 Sharps became a hard-hitting long-range weapon capable of accurately striking targets up to 1,000 yards downrange. That made the 1874 Sharps ideal for hunting buffalo and other large game.

The 1874 Sharps was such an iconic part of the American West that it was featured prominently in several Hollywood films. Clint Eastwood used one in "The Good, the Bad and the Ugly," Glen Campbell carried one in "True Grit," and Kevin Costner had one in "Wyatt Earp." But the most famous film role for the 1874 Sharps was in "Quigley Down Under" where a special long-range version chambered in .45-110 was used extensively by Tom Selleck in the starring role. The movie is credited with starting a resurgence of interest in Sharps rifles that continues to this day. There's even a special tournament for Sharps rifle shooters held in eastern Montana every year. The Matthew Quigley Buffalo Rifle Match is a two-day event that brings hundreds of competitors from around the world to compete shooting metal targets up to 1,000 yards away.

Uberty offers four beautiful recreations of the legendary 1874 Sharps in .45-70 caliber, including the "Down Under" model patterned after the rifle in the famous film. The Special Sharps model is just like the ones used by the American Rifle Team to win the first international long-range rifle match at Creedmoor, Long Island, New York. All models sport handsome bluing and splendid Walnut stocks.
