**Approval of the Minutes of the March 16, 2023 and Interim April 17, 2023 Meetings**

Mr. Burnett motioned and Mr. Packard seconded the approval of the minutes of the March 16, 2023 and April 17, 2023 meetings and they were approved unanimously by all Council members in attendance.

**Monthly and Quarterly Reports**

**Securities Division:**

Ms. Black provided the new reports for the Certified Investment Advisers and Certified Broker Dealers, and was in attendance but with no audio. Ms. Pedroza briefly reviewed the reports with the Council and noted that they were for the July 1 renewal period. There are three new Certified Dealers being added along with their agents, and several agents added to existing firms. Several agents were deleted with existing firms. On the Certified Investment Adviser lists there were also deletions and additions of several agents with existing adviser firms, but no new firms. (See lists with minutes for details). Council reviewed the lists briefly.

**Department of Financial Institutions:**

Mr. Bergstedt informed the Council that the reports for March, April and May are in the packet and he then reviewed the May month end report. He informed the Council that there was nothing of note and thanked the Council for holding the interim meeting to approve Fortis Bank. He also informed the Council that there have been additional inquiries into being able to hold public funds in Utah by two other financial institutions that he is working with, however at the time they do not have Utah deposits. Council discussed this briefly.

Mr. Bergstedt then reviewed the quarterly allotment changes for the quarter beginning July 1, 2023 signed by Commissioner Rude. Mr. Bergstedt noted that there were no items of note on

the report. Council reviewed the reports briefly and Mr. Packard moved to accept the allotments, Ms. Forsling seconded and the allotments were approved by all Council members in attendance.

**Deposit and investment report update:**

Ms. Pedroza reviewed the unfiled Deposit and Investment reports with the Council and noted there were fifty-six entities that were delinquent for total reports down from seventy-seven on the last report, and only twenty-four December reports not filed down from thirty-nine in March. Council discussed this briefly.

**Acceptance of Reports:**

It was motioned by Mr. Packard and seconded by Mr. Burnett to accept the reports above. The motion was unanimously approved by all Council members in attendance.

**Other Business**

**Recognize Mr. Elder's service to the Council:**

It was noted the Mr. Elder was retiring from Bountiful City as of July 1. Mr. Cushing recognized Mr. Elder's contribution to the Council noting his diligence in researching the issues that came before the Council and providing other input for the Council to consider. Council talked with Mr. Elder briefly and wished him well.

The Council then scheduled the next quarterly meeting for September 21, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. With no other business before the Council, they adjourned at 3:15 p.m.

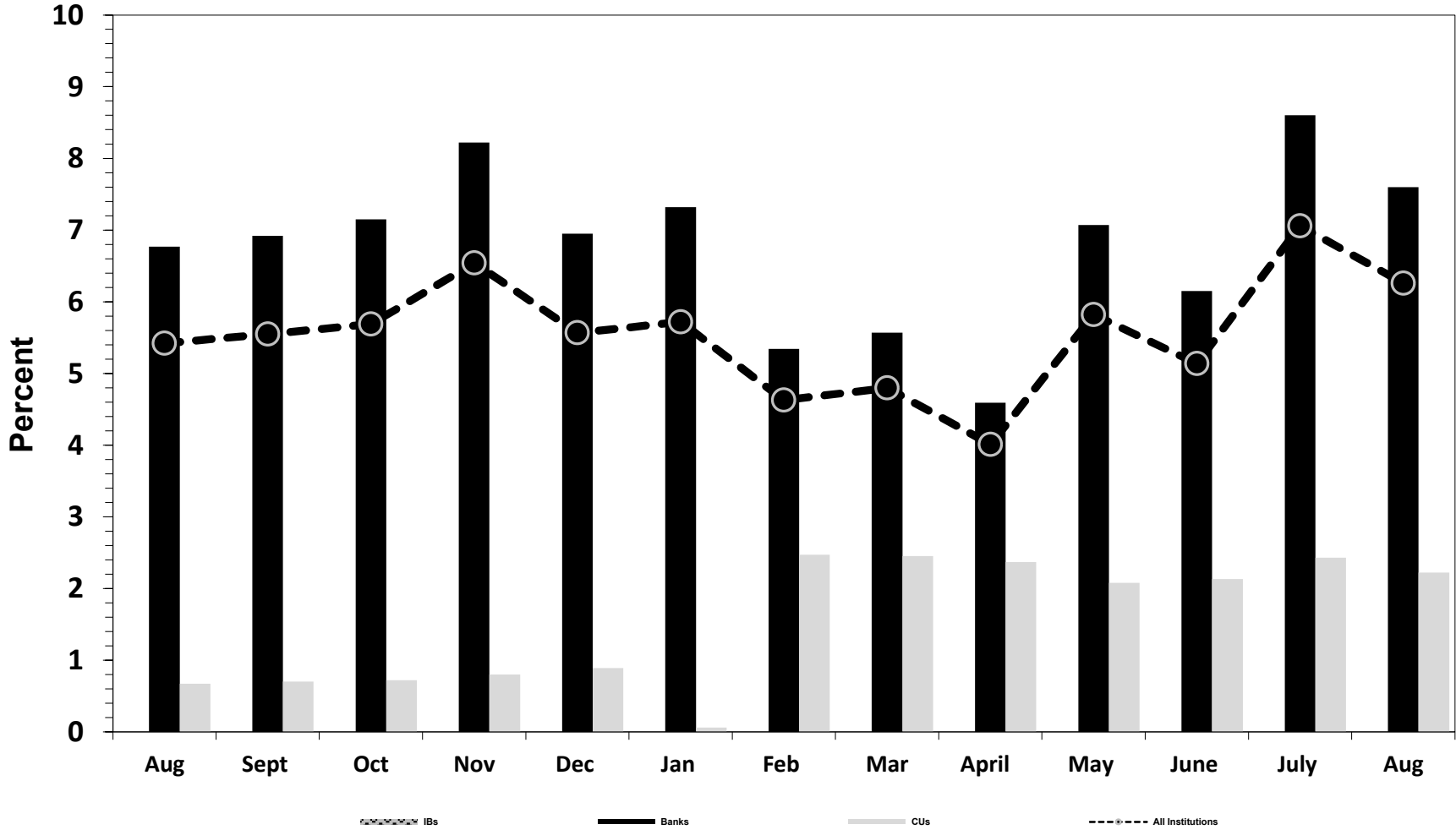

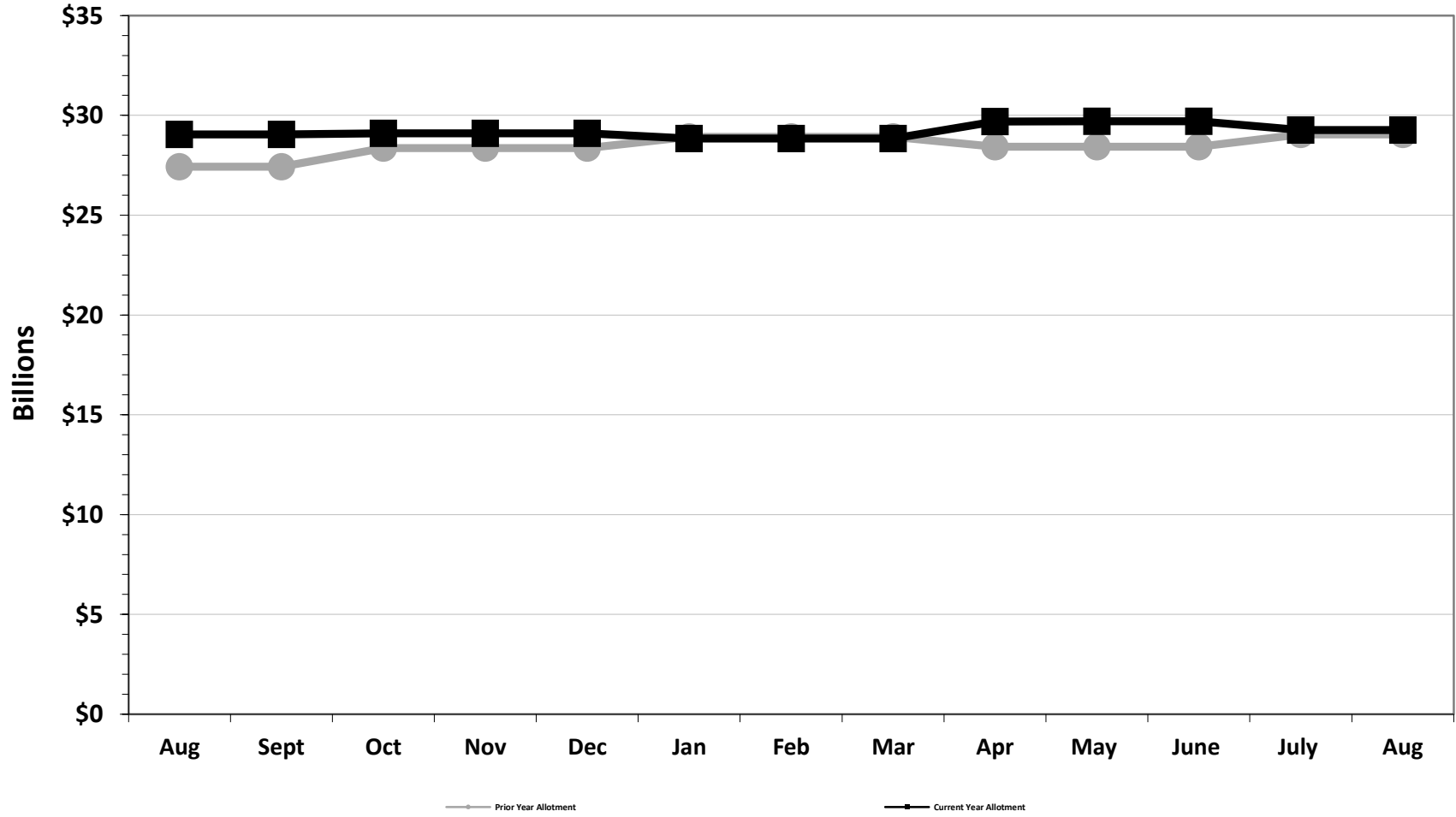

Percentage of Allotment Used



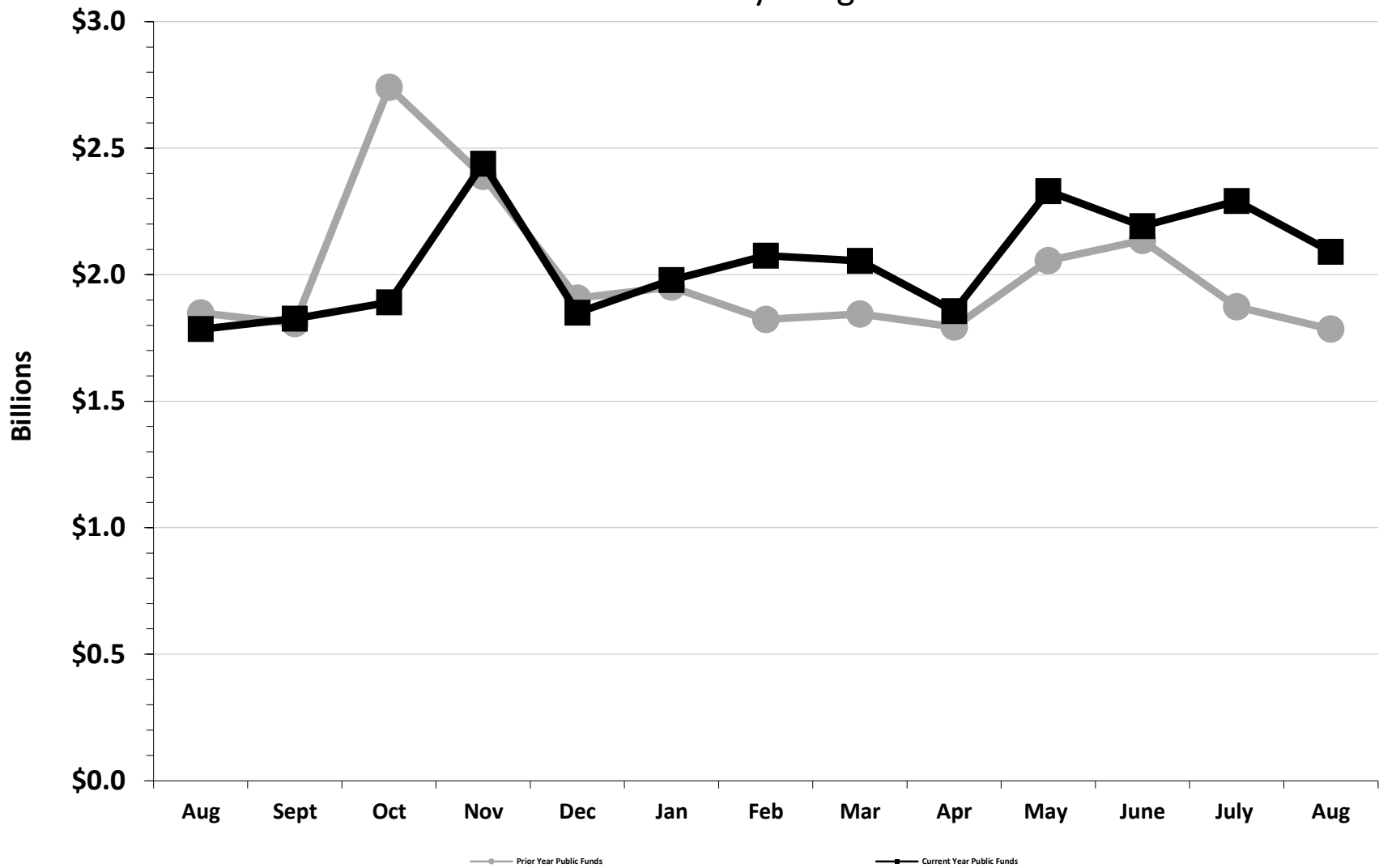
