<p><b>Blue River</b> Unusual violet blue flowers cover this plant with up to 17 per truss. Foliage is glossy green.</p>	Mid Season	1.5m
<p><b>Blue Peter</b> Pale lavender-blue with a prominent flare of crimson purple. Tight frilled trusses.</p>	Late October	2m
<p><b>Blurettia</b> Flowers with rich purple wavy margins and pale centres. Compact plant.</p>	October	50cm

<p><b>Bumblebee</b> Deep purple flowers with large black eye, in large conical trusses. Erect grower. A favorite.</p>	Mid/Late season	2m
<p><b>Butter Brickle</b> Long lasting flowers owe yellow with buttercup edges. A small cardinal red blotch in each flower.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Caroline Allbrook</b> Very pale purple blooms lightly flushed darker, centre of dorsal lobe cream with brilliant greenish-yellow spotting. Broadly funnel-shaped, wavy-edged, held in ball shaped truss of 16-20 flowers.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Cary Ann</b> Flowers coral red, trumpet shaped on large conical trusses. Attractive dark green foilage.</p>	October	1m

<p><b>College Pink</b> Profuse rose coloured buds open to pink frilled flowers in a rounded truss. It becomes more wide than tall.</p>	Mid Season	1.5m
<p><b>Colonel Cohen</b> Big dark purple buds open to magnificent deep purple blooms, with dark spots in fully domed truss. A medium sized shrub with large dark green leaves.</p>	Oct-Nov	2m
<p><b>Cornubia</b> Very striking bright red flowers. Upright habit.</p>	September	2.5m
<p><b>Cornubia Variegated</b> Very striking bright red flowers with handsome variegated leaves.</p>	September	2.5m
<p><b>Cosmopolitan</b> A good hardy Rhodo with attractive glossy green foliage. Pink flowers with a deep red blotch.</p>	October	1.5m

<p><b>Fragrantissimum</b> This highly fragrant rhodo has funnel shaped flowers that open from carmine flushed buds to pearl white. An old favourite.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Gandy Dancer</b> Large Heads of lemon yellow flowers and nice foilage.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Gartendirektor Reiger</b> Cream flowers with a red spot.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Gold Flimmer</b> Soft mauve flowers, variegated leaves A very tough hardy plant</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Golden Torch</b> Salmon pink in bud opening to pale yellow. Compact plant.</p>	November

<p><b>Hawaiian Sunset</b> Large high truss of wide funnel shaped frilly flowers of sunset orange.</p>	October	1.3m
<p><b>Helene Schiffner</b> Dark buds open to white flowers, tinged lilac with a faint yellow marking in the throat, held in tight ball truss.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>High Society</b> Pink and cream flowers on a compact bush. Attractive silver grey new growth.</p>	Late October	1m
<p><b>Honey Butter</b> Yellow-orange flowers edged with pink</p>	October	1m

<p><b>Impi</b> Black red flowers are held in a loose truss. The foilage is a deep ruddy green with red stems and petioles.</p>	Very Late Season	1.5m
<p><b>Irene Bain</b> A semi dwarf, compact plant with creamy white flowers edged pink.</p>	October	50cm
<p><b>J.P Lade</b> Soft lavender blue flowers on a hardy bushy plant.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Jingle Bells</b> Orange flowers fading to yellow with the throat retained. Low growing with dense foilage.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Jodi King</b> Palest lavender pink flowers in rounded trusses on a strong very compact plant.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Jonathan Shaw</b> Vivid purple flowers, shading to strong purplish- red in the centre with prominent black flares on the upper lobes.</p>	Late Season	1m
<p><b>Kalinka</b> Rose pink flowers with a deeper rim and shading to yellow-green in the centre. Dense neat bushy plant.</p>	Mid Season	1m

<p><b>Kings Cream</b> Large open trusses of rich cream flowers. Hardy.</p>	October	2m
<p><b>Kings Ride</b> Compacted yak hybrid with cream flowers opening from pink buds. Lovely cream new growth.</p>	Mid Season	1m
<p><b>Lady in Red</b> Bright red clusters of flowers on this compact bushy grower.</p>	Sept-Oct	1.2m
<p><b>Lalique</b> A NZ hybrid. White frilled flowers, tinged delicate pink and lilac held in conical trusses.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Lee's Dark Purple</b>                      <b>New 09</b> Dark purple flowers and attractive wavy leaves. Reliable and heat tolerant</p>	Mid / Late Season	2m
<p><b>Lemon Marmalade</b> Clear yellow flowers on this semi dwarf grower.</p>	November	1m
<p><b>Lems Burgundy</b>                      <b>New 12</b> Lovely burgundy red flowers with large trusses</p>	Mid Season	1.5m

<p><b>Lems Monarch</b> Huge showy trusses are pink. Large attractive foliage. Will grow into a strong stemmed full plant.</p>	Mid Season	2m
<p><b>Lems Stormcloud</b> Superb variety with tight large trusses of burgundy-red flowers, paler in the centre to near white.</p>	Mid-Late Season	1.5m
<p><b>Little Angel</b> Spreading growth habit that is wider than tall. Deepgreen leaves that have brown indumentum, with new growth white-tomentose (Fluff on the top of the leaf). Mauve pink buds open to white flowers.</p>	October	75cm
<p><b>Loderi Pink Diamond</b></p>	Mid Season	2m
<p><b>Markeetas Prize</b> Upright grower with large bright scarlet red pink flowers.</p>	October	2m
<p><b>Marquis of Lothian</b> Pink heads of flowers. A mature specimen develops beautiful cinnamon bark. Likes shelter from wind. NZ first rhodo hybrid before 1880.</p>	Early October	2m
<p><b>Michael's Pride</b> Lime green buds open to creamy yellow, fragrant tubular flowers. New leaves an attractive bronze colour.</p>	Mid season	2m

<p><b>Mount Everest</b> White buds open to faintly scented conical flower trusses of pure white with brownish red markings.</p>	September	1.5m
<p><b>Mrs A T De La Mere</b> Slightly fragrant flowers of white with a green spot to form a large dome shaped truss.</p>	Mid Seson	1.5m
<p><b>Mrs G W Leak</b> Light pink flowers with a burgundy blotch are held in compact trusses.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Mrs Tom Lowinsky</b> Rounded compact plant. Flowers blush to white with striking orange brown flare in rounded trusses.</p>	Late October	2m
<p><b>Mt Loma Prieta</b> Large trusses of soft apricot pink, slightly darker towards the edges. Good dark foilage.</p>	Late October	2m
<p><b>Mystique</b> Flowers are ruffled salmon pink/cream with a deep red throat. Compact with shiny mid green foilage.</p>	Sept - October	1m
<p><b>Nancy Evans</b> Orange red buds open to ball shaped trusses amber yellow, orange on outsides and reverse when open.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Naselle</b> The ruffled petals have wide melon colored borders surrounding interiors that are shaded the colour of custard with red flecks at the base for bee guides. Definitely a showey evergreen shrub in springtime!</p>	October	1m

<p><b>Pawhuska</b> Beautiful snow white flowers on a neat bushy shrub.</p>	November	1.5m

<p><b>Saffron Queen</b> Saffron yellow to sulphur yellow trumpet shaped florets in lax trusses.</p>	Mid Season	1.5m
<p><b>Sappho</b> Flowers are white and have a very conspicuous very dark purplish black blotch. Compact rounded trusses. Open growth habit.</p>	Mid Season	2m
<p><b>Sapporo</b> The flowers open pale purple and quickly turn white with a strong blotch of deep purplish red. A more compact form of the very popular Sappho</p>	<b>New 09</b> Mid Season	1.5m
<p><b>Scarlett Wonder</b> A compact small bush covered in red flowers.</p>	Mid Season	50cm
<p><b>Schneekrone</b> Masses of pink to pale pink flowers. This plant is one of the best compact yaks, forming a dense plant.</p>	November	1m

<p><b>Silberwolke syn Silver Cloud</b> Light pink flowers.</p>	November	1m
<p><b>Simona</b> Filly light pink flowers with spotting on the upper lobe.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Spotlight</b> Pale pink flowers on a compact bush.</p>	October	1.5m
<p><b>Taurus</b> Deep red buds open to cherry red flowers.</p>	September	2m
<p><b>Titian Beauty</b> Plant has a neat habit with turkey red flowers.</p>	November	1m
<p><b>Tornado</b> Current red flowers darker in the centre. A compact bush forming a well rounded plant with mid green foliage. One of the best reds.</p>	Late October	1.8m
<p><b>Trude Webster</b> Gigantic clear deepish pink flowers.</p>	Mid Season	2m
<p><b>Unique</b> Pink buds opening cream on a nice compact bush. A must for your garden.</p>	October	1.5m

<p><b>Virginia Richards</b> Deep pink buds open to pale yellow salmon with a crimson flare in throat.</p>	Mid Season	1.2m
<p><b>White Linen</b> Buds open to soft peach fading to white. Very Hardy and fragrant. Excellent foilage. Similar to Uniquie.</p>	October	1m
<p><b>Winnie Hayes</b> Glossy foilage on a neat bush smothered in spring with ball trussesof large funnel shaped amber flowers</p>	Mid Season	1.5m
<p><b>Winsome</b> Rosy red in bud opening cerise pink, funnel shaped wavy edged flower, compact vigorous grower.</p>	Mid Season	1m
<p><b>Yaku Angel</b> Yakushmanum Yaku Angel. Flower openly campanulate. White with faint brown dorsal spotting. Held in ball-shaped trusses of 13-17 flowers. Deep green leaves with tan indumentum, retained for 3 years. New growth white tomentose. Grows wider than tall.</p>	October	90cm
<p><b>Yakushmanum FCC</b> Pink buds open to dainty pink rounded truss, fading slowly to white when fully open. Available in standard plant</p>	October
