

Lake whitefish gill raker counts (from CC Lindsey) from Dragon Lake (green) and 7 other BC lakes (blue). Coloured ovals represent low (left) and high (right) model counts for samples from some sympatric pairs in the Yukon River drainage. The Dragon Lake “pair”, therefore, show the lowest difference in modal counts (25 - 27). They also show the lowest total gill raker counts of the samples from BC. By contrast, Dezadeash Lake shows the greatest difference (23 -33).
